Department: Fire

Department Goal:

The goal of the Fire Department of the 1987-1992 CIP is to provide effective and efficient emergency operations, fire suppression, and emergency medical capability through replacement of older fire apparatus and medic units, establishment of an improved emergency telecommunications network, and the addition of a fully operational fire station in the Eagle River Valley area.

Anchorage Fire:

The \$6,985,000 in requested general obligation bond funds for the 1987-1992 CIP will provide for necessary replacement of aged fire apparatus, equip the new emergency telecommunications network, provide emergency generators for fire stations, and construct/equip a fire station in Eagle River Valley. The age of most first line pumper/tanker vehicles will be at or under a maximum age of 12 years.

Chugiak Fire:

Requested general obligation bond funding of \$803,000 and local funding of \$163,000 will provide necessary replacement of aged equipment.

Emergency Medical Services:

The \$831,000 in general obligation bond funds in the 1987-1992 CIP will provide replacement of medic units to sustain emergency medical services capability.

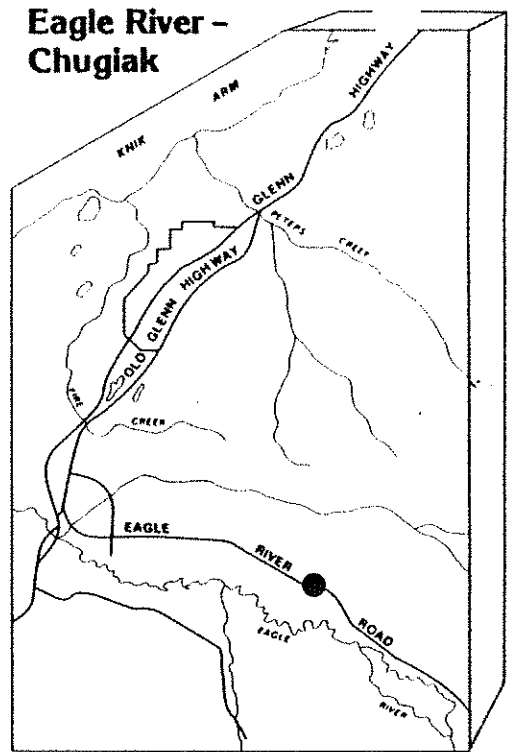
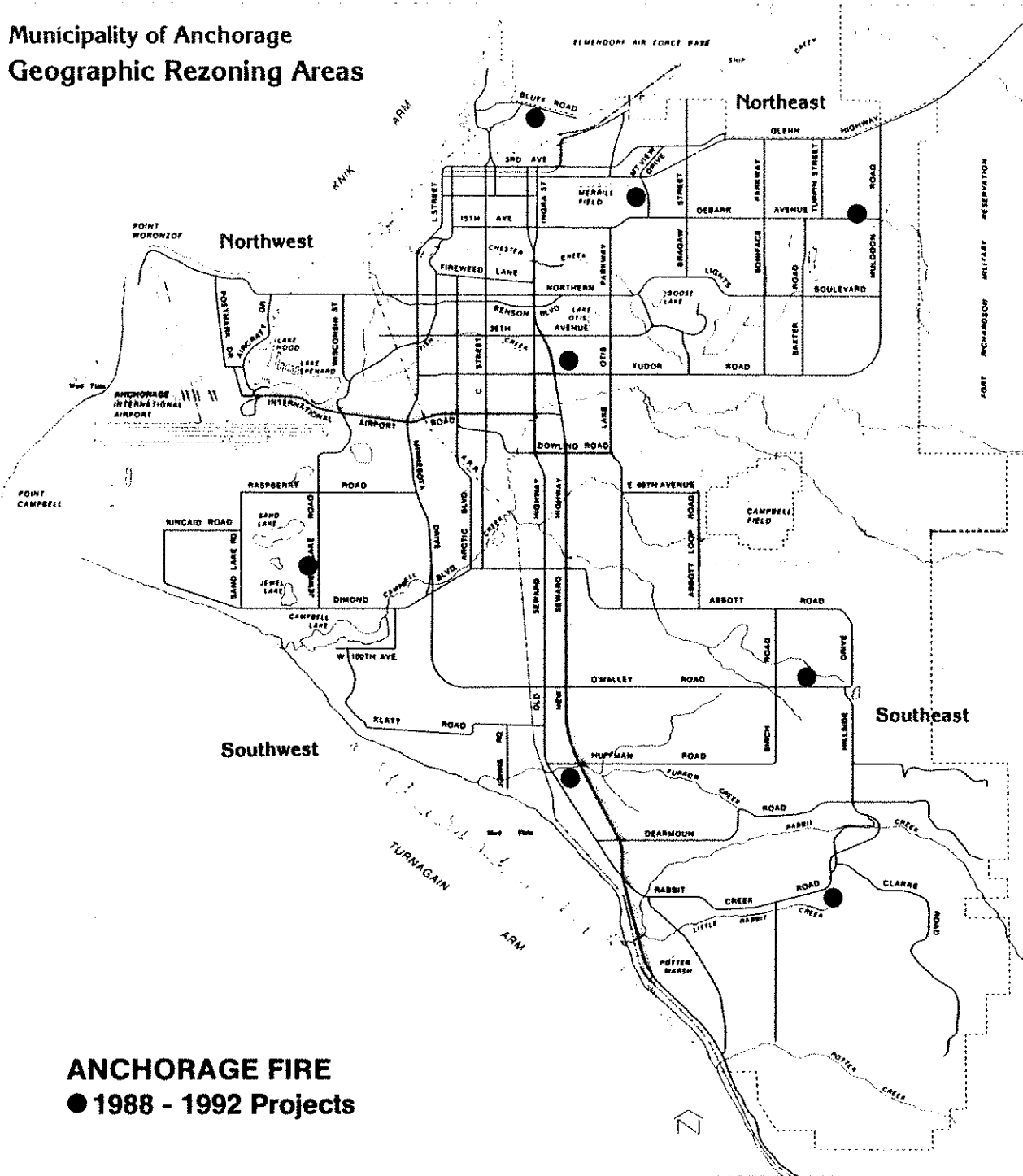

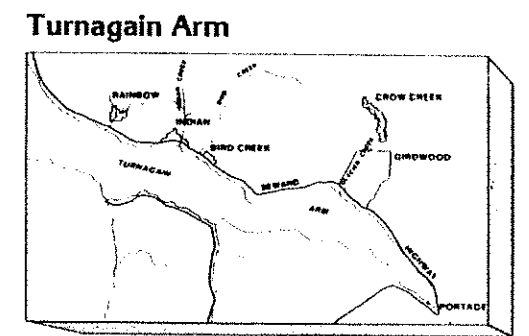
