Department Goal:

The goal of the library for the 1989-1994 CIP is to acquire and provide an expanded collection of library materials in partial fulfillment of professionally established national standards which will meet the informational, cultural, and recreational needs of the residents of the Municipality through all the libraries in the system.

Program Statement:

This program will enhance the currently underdeveloped collection of the Anchorage Municipal Libraries. American Library Association standards recommend collections of 2 to 4 books per capita for public libraries. The per capita national average for libraries serving populations of over 100,000 is 2.0 volumes. The 1984 Areawide Library Plan established a local goal of 3.5 volumes per capita for Anchorage. This plan was developed by the Municipal Planning Department in cooperation with the Library Advisory Board and the Library Department, reviewed in public hearing, and adopted by the Municipal Assembly. The rapid population growth of the last decade has left the library system far short of these goals with a current 1.5 volumes per capita. This program will raise the per capita holdings by .3 and greatly increase the information resources available for residents of Anchorage, Municipal and other governmental agencies, and library users in Southcentral Alaska under the state plan for cooperative library development, "Library Service for ALL Alaskans".

General Projects:

Occupational health and safety agencies have determined that many asbestos building products used prior to the early 1970's can break down and contaminate the workplace, significantly affecting the health and life span of people using the facility. The Department has surveyed and identified the presence or absence of asbestos in facilities either leased or owned by the Municipality. We are now in the process of engineering and accomplishing asbestos abatement processes. It is anticipated that these projects will be on-going for the next two to three years. The Department has planned major repair and rehabilitation of various municipal buildings to improve energy efficiencies and correct building code discrepancies.


In addition, it is the goal of the Department to remove the Hollywood Vista Apartment Complex and the Willow Park Apartment complex from the Anchorage rental market as both are substandard units. Both are also past their economic useful lives, contain large amounts of asbestos, and should be demolished for health and safety reasons.



Department: Parks and Recreation

Department Goal:

The goal of the Parks and Recreation Department for the 1989-1994 Capital Improvement Program is to provide a wide range of recreational opportunities to all segments of the community. Use will be made of publicly owned space, marginal lands and geological hazard areas for park purposes. Special efforts will be made to enlist public participation (donations of labor, money, materials) to upgrade present parks and trails, complete current park projects, and develop facilities in those areas where parkland deficiencies require additional parks and recreational areas. Land acquisition will continue at a slower pace in areas most deficient. Input was obtained from individual citizens, neighborhood associations, public meetings, community councils, Parks and Recreation Commission and staff.

Land Acquisition:

This program will secure new greenbelts along Peters Creek, Little Rabbit Creek and Potter Creek and will fill out existing greenbelts emphasizing water quality improvement and public access. It will secure an average of three new neighborhood parks each year. Acquisition will be funded primarily through the Heritage Land Bank, supplemented by private donations and formation of park improvement districts.

Major neighborhood park projects for 1989 will be acquisition in the Midtown, South Anchorage, and Government Hill areas.

Parks and Trails Development

This program provides major emphasis on park and trail rehabilitation and completion of existing projects currently under design or construction throughout the community. Major new construction is planned for Campbell Creek Greenbelt, Valley of the Moon Park, Town Square, Storck, and other parks. Maximum use will be made of park improvement districts, volunteers, and other fund raising efforts to increase community involvement and reduce public expenditures.

There is to be considerable effort to repair and rehabilitate the present parks and trails and to focus on close to home neighborhood needs.

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE NEIGHBORHOOD/COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS CAPITAL PROGRAM Department: Parks and Recreation

Linkages between major trails will be completed to expand the role of the areawide trails system and become a major element of both the transportation and recreation systems. Some ski and bike trails will be maintained for use by runners year-round.

Neighborhood parks will be improved and expanded where needed and additional sports fields for organized athletics will be developed to meet expanding program needs.

Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation:

The 1989-1994 Capital Improvement Program for Eagle River/Chugiak includes development of land for greenbelts and neighborhood parks and development of Schroeder Airstrip, Loretta French, Beach Lake, Peters Creek, and Town Square parks, as well as the general upgrading of the area's parks.

Projects were reviewed by the Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation Service Area Board of Supervisors.


Girdwood Parks and Recreation:


The 1989-1994 Capital Improvement Program for Girdwood Parks and Recreation fills community needs for extension of pathways and improvements to the Town Square area.

The Capital Improvement Program was approved by the Girdwood Board of Supervisors.


