CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

Department Goal:

The goal of the Cultural and Recreational Services Department for the 1995-2000 Capital Improvement Program is to provide improved recreational opportunities and enhanced library and information services to all segments of the community, and to raise and protect the water quality of local streams. The Department's budget represents input from individual citizens, neighborhood associations, community councils, the Parks and Recreation Commission, Library Advisory Board, Eagle River Parks and Recreation Board of Supervisors, Girdwood Board of Supervisors, and staff.

Library:

The 1995-2000 Capital Improvement Program for the Library focuses on projects designed to support and enhance the delivery of library and information services while enriching the educational, cultural and economic climate of the community.

Acquisition and upgrade of equipment and software is required to effectively access the Library's collections in electronic format from multiple simultaneous sites within and outside library facilities. The conversion of print to electronic resources, as available, will enhance patron and staff access to information services.

The replacement of library shelving which does not meet current earthquake-resistant standards is a high priority for the safety of library patrons and staff. Furniture, fixtures and equipment in Loussac and branch libraries must be regularly replaced to maintain safety and effectiveness.

The library advocates access to a broad range of information available in electronic format throughout the city. A community electronic network will enable access to the vast array of information sources as well as provide electronic mail for network users.

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

Museum:

The Museum needs compact, earthquake-resistant shelving to securely store various items of the collection and technical equipment and to better utilize floor space.

Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Trails:

The 1995-2000 Capital Improvement Program for Eagle River/Chugiak includes continued upgrading and development of existing parks and development of Loretta French Park, Schroeder Park, Peters Creek Safety Trail and Peters Creek Park.

Girdwood Parks and Trails:

The 1995-2000 Capital Improvement Program for Girdwood fills includes improvements to recreation facilities within Forest Fair park area, soccer field and Town Square Park.

Anchorage Parks and Trails Development:

This program provides major emphasis on park and trail rehabilitation, reduction of maintenance costs and completion of existing projects currently under construction throughout the community. Major reconstruction or improvements are planned for Anchorage Sports Complex, Coastal Trail, Kosinski Ballfields, Delaney Park, Campbell Creek Trail, Chester Creek Trail, Far North Bicentennial Park, Ruth Arcand Park/Abbott-O-Rabbit Ballfields, Valley of the Moon Park, Kincaid Park, Storck Park, Russian Jack Springs Park, Town Square Park, Centennial Park and others. Maximum use will be made of volunteers, donations, and other fund-raising efforts to increase community involvement and reduce public expenditures.

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

There is to be considerable effort to upgrade and rehabilitate the present parks and trails, including reduction of access barriers for the disabled, and a focus on neighborhood needs. Linkage between major trails will be completed to expand the role of the areawide trails system as a major element of both the transportation and recreation system. Neighborhood parks will be improved where needed and additional sports fields for organized athletics will be developed to meet expanding program needs.

Park Acquisition:

This program will continue to fill out existing greenbelts, emphasizing water quality improvement and public access, as well as new neighborhood parks. Acquisition will be funded primarily through State grants and management transfers with the Heritage Land Bank, supplemented by private donations.

Greenbelt Acquisition:

Acquire land along Fish Creek, Little Rabbit Creek, Rabbit Creek and Potter Creek and designated wetlands as budget and community priorities direct, sufficient to protect local creeks, creek banks, and the immediate upland area along these creeks from human and domestic animal contamination and encroachment by structures and other development which would otherwise threaten the water quality. The designated wetlands which are included in the Greenbelt Acquisition program should be reserved because of habitat and hydrological values. These wetland areas selected for acquisition have been chosen because of documented high resource value.






