CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

Department Goal:

The goal of the Cultural and Recreational Services Department for the 1998-2003 Capital Improvement Budget/Program is to:

- provide improved cultural, educational and recreational opportunities for the benefit of the community,
- increase recreational options, particularly for youth, through design and construction of sports and recreation facilities,
- emphasize an overall priority to 1) improve the condition of existing cultural and recreational facilities and trails, 2) complete trails which form missing links in existing trail systems and 3) add facilities in areas deficient in parks or facilities.

The Department's capital budget/program represents input from individual citizens, neighborhood associations, community councils, Anchorage Parks and Recreation Commission, the Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation and Girdwood Valley Service Area Boards of Supervisors, Library Advisory Board and the Anchorage Historical and Fine Arts Commission.

Anchorage Sports and Recreation Facilities:

This program provides major emphasis on sports facilities improvement and expansion. Planned improvements include development of new sports fields and sports field irrigation improvements throughout the Anchorage bowl and improvements to Kincaid Outdoor Center and Russian Jack Springs Park.

Anchorage Parks and Trails Development:

The program provides major emphasis on rehabilitation of existing trails and trail connections. Significant improvements are planned for the Coastal Trail, Chester Creek Trail and Fish Creek Trail. Linkage between major trails will be completed to expand the role of the areawide trails system as a major element of both the transportation and recreation systems.

There is also considerable effort to upgrade and rehabilitate existing parks and facilities, including reduction of access barriers for the disabled. Maximum use will be made of volunteers, donations, and other fund-raising efforts to increase community involvement and reduce public expenditures.

Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Trails:

The 1998-2003 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation Service Area includes continued upgrading and development of Loretta French, Schroeder, Oberg, and Eliassen Parks. A multi-year, high-priority plan is also included to rehabilitate play equipment in area parks to meet safety and accessibility guidelines.

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Girdwood Parks, Trails and Acquisitions:

The 1998-2003 Capital Improvement Program for Girdwood follows recommendations in the approved Girdwood Area Plan and the Anchorage Trails Plan. The program provides for continued upgrading and development of existing parks, facilities and trails.

Park Acquisition:

The 1998-2003 Capital Improvement Budget/Program will emphasize park acquisition in areas deficient in park land and to meet park/public access needs.

Greenbelt Acquisition

The 1998-2003 Capital Improvement Budget/Program continues to target acquisition of land along area creeks. The goals of these acquisitions include 1) protection of creeks, creek banks and the upland area along waterways from encroachment by other development which might threaten water quality; 2) provision of green space; and 3) public access to waterways.

Library

The 1998-2003 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for the Library focuses on projects designed to support and enhance the delivery of library and informational services while enriching the educational, cultural and economic climate of the community.

Remodeling the Circulation Area of Z. J. Loussac headquarters library will provide better customer service and increased space for collections and address accessibility and technological needs. The replacement and addition of library shelving meeting earthquake resistance standards is a high priority for the safety of library patrons and staff and the secure storage of library materials.

Acquisition of additions to the automated library system will increase public terminals and printers; provide accurate and timely statistical information; provide additional equipment to improve access for patrons with disabilities; and provide hardware and software to increase efficiency of service.

Museum

The 1998-2003 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for the Anchorage Museum of History and Art focuses on enhancement of the acoustical properties of the atrium, improvement of security and storage for collections and replacement of furnishings and equipment worn by age and public use.

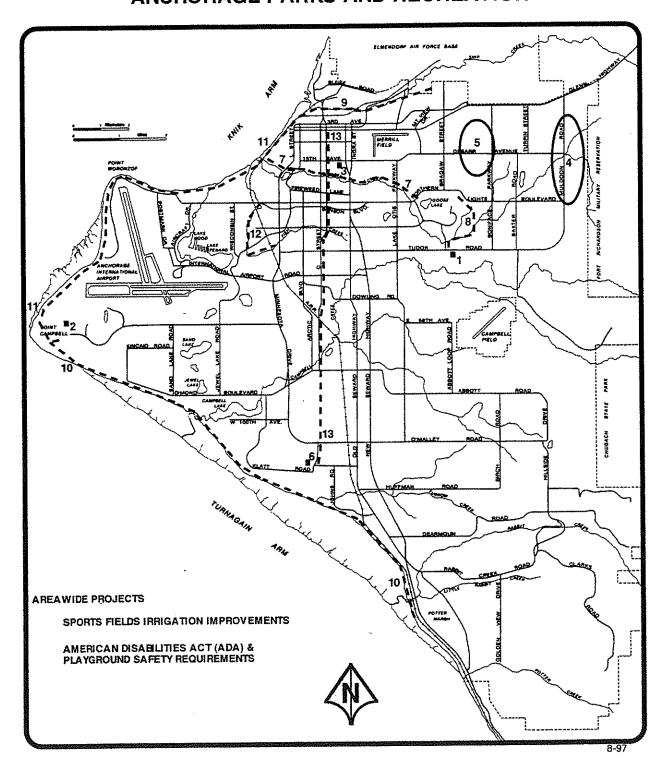
