Dear Residents of Anchorage:

I am pleased to present the Approved 2002 Capital Improvement Budget (CIB) and 2002-2007 Capital Improvement Program (CIP). Capital projects contribute in a large way to improving the physical appearance of the city and enhancing the quality of life in Anchorage.

The six-year capital program addresses many of the needs of the community by maintaining and improving the existing capital infrastructure of roadways, buildings, police and fire vehicles/equipment, parks, cultural/recreational facilities and public transportation. The capital program strives to maintain and enhance the overall quality of life in Anchorage for the benefit of residents and to help attract new businesses and visitors to our City.

The Proposed General Government CIB/CIP will emphasize:

- upgrading and rehabilitating of municipal roadways;
- complying with state and federal mandates;
- upgrading public safety facilities, vehicles, and equipment
- upgrading and rehabilitating our city's highest-use, most visible public facilities.

This plan proposes \$55 million in general obligation bond proposals for the April 2002 election, to include Fire Stations, Police facilities, and Roads and Drainage, Parks and Recreation, and Loussac Library improvements. Some of these anticipated bond funds will be pledged as local match in order to obtain State capital matching grants during the 2002 legislative session.

Well-informed citizens are critical to the quality of life in our city. I encourage you to become familiar with the projects that are proposed for our city and vote in the April 2 election.

Program (CIP)

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The attached Assembly Ordinance and Assembly Resolution represent, correspondingly, an "S" Version of the Proposed 2002 General Government CIB and 2002-2007 General Government CIP. Two changes have been made as follows:

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LIBRARY-SAFETY-SECURITY-DESIGN IMPROVEMENTS

(\$1,500,000)

With the concurrence of the Library Advisory Board, this project has been moved out one year to 2003 where current plans call for combining it with other library projects to form a larger Areawide Library bond in 2003.

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BEN BOEKE ICE ARENA-MAJOR REPAIR

\$1,300,000

This new project has been added to replace the rink refrigeration system that has failed, and other improvements to the facility. Ice arena reserves had been anticipated as the source of funding for this project. However, settlement of a claim related to construction of the second ice sheet at Dempsey Anderson Ice Arena significantly depleted available reserves, necessitating the proposed bond funding for the project. It is important that this project be completed as soon as possible to avoid scheduling problems for the users and to meet required revenue projections for the arena.

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THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS THAT THE ATTACHED ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE 2002 GENERAL GOVERNMENT CIB AND RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE 2002-2007 GENERAL GOVERNMENT CIP BE ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY.


