#### CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

#### **Department Goal**

The goal of the Cultural and Recreational Services Department for the 2003-2008 Capital Improvement Budget/Program is to:

- provide improved cultural, educational and recreational opportunities for the benefit of the community,
- increase recreational options, particularly for youth, through design and construction of sports and recreation facilities.
- emphasize an overall priority to 1) improve the condition of existing cultural and recreational facilities, parks, and trails, 2) complete trails which form missing links in existing trail systems and 3) add facilities in areas deficient in parks or facilities.

The Department's capital budget/program represents input from individual citizens, neighborhood associations, community councils, Anchorage Parks and Recreation Commission, the Chugiak/Eagle River Parks and Recreation and Girdwood Valley Service Area Boards of Supervisors, Library Advisory Board and the Anchorage Historical and Fine Arts Commission.

#### **Anchorage Sports and Recreation Facilities**

This program provides major emphasis on sports facilities improvement and expansion. Planned improvements include development of new sports fields and sports field irrigation improvements throughout the Anchorage bowl and improvements to Centennial Park, Kincaid Outdoor Center and Russian Jack Springs Park.

#### **Anchorage Parks and Beautification**

The program provides major emphasis on trail connections, rehabilitation of existing facilities, and development of under-served areas. Significant improvements are planned for Campbell Creek Trail, Chester Creek Trail, Centennial Park, Far North Bicentennial Par, Goose Lake Park, and Russian Jack Park. Emphasis is also placed on the upgrade and rehabilitation of existing parks, playgrounds and facilities, including reduction of access barriers for the disabled, improved safety for users and a focus on neighborhood needs. Maximum use will be made of volunteers, donations, and other fund-raising efforts to increase community involvement and reduce public expenditures.

#### **Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Trails**

The 2003-2008 Capital Improvement Budget/Program includes continued upgrading and development of Eagle River Commons, Schroeder and Eliassen Parks, Oberg Soccer Field and Beach Lake Trail. A multi-year, high-priority plan is also included to rehabilitate play equipment in area parks to meet safety and accessibility guidelines.

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#### **Girdwood Parks, Trails and Acquisitions**

The 2003-2008 Capital Improvement Program for Girdwood follows recommendations in the approved Girdwood Area Plan and the Anchorage Trails Plan. The program provides for continued upgrading and development of existing parks, facilities and trails.

#### **Park Acquisition**

The 2003-2008 Capital Improvement Budget/Program emphasizes park acquisition in areas deficient in parkland and meeting park/public access needs.

#### **Greenbelt Acquisition**

The 2003-2008 Capital Improvement Budget/Program continues to target acquisition of land along area creeks. The goals of these acquisitions include 1) protection of creeks, creek banks and the upland area along waterways from encroachment by other development that might threaten water quality; 2) provision of green space; and 3) public access to waterways.

#### Library

The 2003-2008 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for the Library focuses on projects designed to support and enhance the delivery of library and informational services while enriching the educational, cultural and economic climate of the community.

The Girdwood Library and Community Room project will replace an under-sized temporary library located in an elementary school and add community meeting space. The new facilities have been designed to be integrated with the newly completed Girdwood Fire Station.

Remodeling the Circulation Area of Z. J. Loussac headquarters library will provide better customer service and increased space for collections and address accessibility and technological needs. The secure storage of library materials through the replacement and addition of library shelving that meets earthquake resistance standards is a high priority for the safety of library patrons and staff.

Design of a library in Chugiak Eagle River is the first step towards a permanent facility located in the central services area of Eagle River.

#### Museum

The 2003-2008 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for the Anchorage Museum of History and Art focuses on enhancement of the acoustical properties of the atrium (See Chapter Nine, Property and Facility Management), improvement of security and storage for collections and replacement of furnishings and equipment worn by age and public use.
