CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

Department Goal

The goal of the Cultural and Recreational Services Department for the 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Budget/Program is to:

- Provide improved cultural and recreational opportunities for the benefit of all in the community.
- Increase recreational options, particularly for Anchorage youth, through design and construction of sports and recreation facilities.
- Emphasize an overall priority approach to parks and trails is as follows: 1) improve maintenance of existing parks and trails, 2) complete missing links to connect existing trails, and 3) add new parks and trails in underserved areas.

The Department's capital budget represents input from individual citizens, neighborhood associations, community councils, Anchorage Parks and Recreation Commission, Library Advisory Board, and the Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation and Girdwood Valley Service Area Boards of Supervisors.

Anchorage Sports and Recreation Facilities

This program provides major emphasis on sports facilities improvement and expansion. Upgrades or expansions are planned for Chester Creek Sports Complex (Mulcahy Stadium) and the Kincaid Outdoor Center and Annex, new softball fields, and sports fields irrigation improvements. In addition, the capital program includes future funding requests for new or expanded recreational centers in Mountain View and Northeast Anchorage.

Anchorage Parks and Trails

This program provides major emphasis on trail connections, rehabilitation of existing facilities, and completion of existing projects currently underway throughout the community. Significant improvements are planned for the Coastal Trail, Campbell Creek Trail and Chester Creek Trail, Town Square Park, Valley of the Moon Park, Arnold Muldoon Park, Russian Jack Springs Park, Balto Seppala Park, Oceanview Park, Birch Road Park and others. Maximum use will be made of volunteers, donations, and other fund-raising efforts to increase community involvement and reduce public expenditures.

There is also considerable effort to upgrade and rehabilitate existing parks, facilities and trails, including reduction of access barriers for the disabled, improved safety for users and a focus on neighborhood desires. Linkage between major trails will be completed to expand the role of the areawide trails system as a major element of both the transportation and recreation systems. Neighborhood parks will be improved where needed and additional sports fields will be developed to meet expanding needs for organized athletics programs.

Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Trails

The 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation Service Area includes continued upgrading and development of existing parks such as Loretta French Park, Schroeder Park and Peters Creek Park, and parkland acquisition including Oberg soccer fields and Eliassen Park.

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Girdwood Parks, Trails and Acquisitions

The 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for Girdwood follows the recommendations of the approved Girdwood Area Plan and the Anchorage Trails Plan. This program provides for the acquisition of land which will then be developed as new parks, trails and recreation facilities in the Girdwood Valley. The program also provides for continued upgrading and development of existing parks and facilities.

Park Acquisition

The 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Budget/Program will continue to in-fill greenbelts, emphasizing water quality improvement and public access. Acquisition is being pursued through bond and matching state grant funding requests and management transfers from the Heritage Land bank, supplemented by private donations.

Greenbelt Acquisition

The 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Budget/Program continues to target acquisition of land as budget and community priorities direct. Protection of wetlands, creeks, creek banks and the immediate upland area along waterways from human and domestic animal contamination and encroachment by structures and other development which might threaten water quality are the main goals of these acquisitions. Designated wetlands identified in the Greenbelt Acquisition Program are included because of the habitat and hydrological values and have been selected for acquisition because of documented high resource value.

Library

The 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for the Library focuses on projects that insure the safety of library patrons, increase staff efficiency and support and enhance the delivery of library services.

Acquisition of Phase II of the library's automated library system will increase public terminals and printers, provide accurate and timely statistical information, provide additional equipment to conform to ADA requirements, and provide hardware and software to increase efficiency of service.

The replacement of old library shelving in branch libraries which does not meet current earthquake-resistant standards is a high priority for the safety of library patrons and staff. Furniture must be regularly replaced to maintain safe and effective use and increase public satisfaction with the physical aspects of library use.

The remodel of the circulation area of Z. J. Loussac headquarters library will provide better customer service and increased space for collections.

Museum

The 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Budget/Program for the Anchorage Museum of History and Art focuses on improvement of security and storage for collections and replacement of furnishings worn by heavy public use. Additionally the expansion into a new facility for the Arctic Studies Center will require capital expenditures which will benefit not only the Arctic Studies Center but also the Anchorage Museum of History and Art by providing laboratories and workshop areas for conservation, exhibition preparation and materials analysis.
