Department Goal:

The goal of the library for the 1990-1995 CIP is to improve library and information services, thereby enriching both the educational and economic climate of the community, through the repair and improvement of the Z.J. Loussac Regional Library facility, the acquisition of expanded materials collections, and the upgrade of the automated library system currently used to access those collections.

<u>Program Statement:</u>

Exterior repair of the Z.J. Loussac Public Library should increase the safety of users of this major educational and cultural facility during the winter months. Interior modifications will decrease operating costs and enhance efficiency. Completion of the video production studio as originally envisioned will provide full video production capability for Municipal government and community residents.

The current 1.7 book volumes per capita available in the Anchorage Municipal Library system falls short of the American Library Association recommended two to four books per capita, as well as the locally established goal of the 1984 Areawide Library Plan of 3.5 volumes per capita. This program would address this deficiency through the selection and acquisition of approximately 90,000 books or alternate information formats, raising the per capita holdings to 2.1, based on a stable population level. This increase would significantly improve the currency and relevancy of information available through the public library.

Upgrade of the current automated library system to take advantage of technological improvements made over the last six years would allow the enhancement of user access to the library's collections. This replacement would provide database space for anticipated collection growth, permit the addition of public access points as needed, and improve the system response time to both public and staff users, saving time and increasing efficiency.

<u>Department Goal:</u>

Our goal in including the projects listed in our Capital Improvement Plan is to provide for the health and welfare of the public through our programs to comply with Federal/State hazardous materials laws and to maintain public facilities in a safe, satisfactory condition. Very little work in the way of improvements to facilities is included other than the Chugiak Senior Center, and a storage building at the Sullivan Sports Arena. Our emphasis is on the basics; roofs, structures, safety, etc. Frivolous, nice to have projects have long since been dropped from our maintenance/construction plans.

The impact of not funding work identified in this plan is very negative. Buildings will continue to deteriorate as the structures age and receive heavy wear and tear from extensive use. Damage caused by leaking roofs, failing exterior paint, cracks in paving, etc., will result in a substantial acceleration in the deterioration of these facilities. Safety issues will go uncorrected. The net result of all of this is a substantial decrease in the benefits the public derives from our libraries, recreation centers, ice and sports arenas, and other public use facilities. In our opinion, the public, which in this case includes people statewide, deserve and have the right to expect that the millions of dollars invested in their behalf should be maintained properly and present the image, function, and beauty that they were intended to provide. Our program, as presented, fulfills that expectation.

General Facility Projects:

The Municipality of Anchorage owns or leases over 300 buildings or other facilities which provide basic government and recreational functions. These facilities range from buildings such as the Loussac Library, Sullivan Arena, and other large complex public structures including an extensive system of bicycle trails and small parks. These facilities are used by local Anchorage residents, school children, community service organizations, and people from throughout the State. As such, they tend to be a State resource for the benefit of all the people.

Several important factors have stimulated these requests for Capital Funds:

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE NEIGHBORHOOD/COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS CAPITAL PROGRAM Department: Property and Facility Management

- * Although Anchorage has grown considerably and has built these highly utilized facilities, the recent downturn in the economy has severely reduced our operating budgets. While the maintenance expense requirements for the facilities are beginning to increase, our ability to fund the operating and maintenance costs is decreasing. Consequently, the impact of the reduced funding is resulting in a ever increasing degradation in the condition and appearance of the facilities.
- * The past few years has seen an unprecedented number of Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Occupational Safety & Health (OSHA) laws and regulations enacted. These are from both Federal and State levels. For instance, OSHA has established extensive regulations pertaining to PCBs and asbestos. In these areas we have had to spend hundreds of thousands of dollars to comply with laws and to provide a safe working/recreational environment for the public and employees throughout the Municipality. In the asbestos area alone we have surveyed over 100 buildings and identified significant amounts of asbestos in our buildings. We have engineered and removed a substantial amount, but much remains to be accomplished. In the case of underground storage tanks (USTs) used for storing fuel and waste chemicals, we are just beginning to put together a UST plan that will ensure that the Municipality is in compliance with EPA and State regulations and that our groundwater aquifers are protected. These past actions have been expensive but, our future obligations to manage and control hazardous substances throughout the city is going to be even more expensive, far outstripping our financial ability.
- * Other programs, such as the demolition of the Hollywood Vista Apartments, the addition of an Alzheimer's Day Care Center and 20 Special Need Apartments at the Senior Center in Chugiak are all vital community projects but, as with the preceding requirements, they far exceed our normal budget capabilities.

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE NEIGHBORHOOD/COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS CAPITAL PROGRAM Department: Parks and Recreation

Department Goal:

The goal of the Parks and Recreation Department for the 1990-1995 Capital Improvement Program is to provide a wide range of recreational opportunities to all segments of the community. Special efforts will be made to enlist public participation (donations of labor, money, materials) to upgrade present parks and trails, complete current park projects, and develop facilities in those areas where parkland deficiencies require additional parks and recreational areas. Land acquisition will be pursued in areas most deficient. Input was obtained from individual citizens, neighborhood associations, community councils, Parks and Recreation Commission and staff.

Land Acquisition:

This program will continue to fill out existing greenbelts emphasizing water quality improvement and public access, as well as new neighborhood parks. Acquisition will be funded primarily through state grants supplemented by private donations and formation of park improvement districts.

Parks and Trails Development:

This program provides major emphasis on park and trail rehabilitation, reducing maintenance cost and completion of existing projects currently under construction throughout the community. Major construction is planned for Campbell and Chester Creek Trails, Anchorage Football Stadium, Valley of the Moon Park, Kincaid Park, Storck, Russian Jack Springs, and other parks. Maximum use will be made of park improvement districts, volunteers, and other fund raising efforts to increase community involvement and reduce public expenditures.

There is to be considerable effort to repair and rehabilitate the present parks and trails and to focus on close to home neighborhood needs.

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE NEIGHBORHOOD/COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS CAPITAL PROGRAM

Department: Parks and Recreation

Linkages between major trails will be completed to expand the role of the areawide trails system and become a major element of both the transportation and recreation systems. Some ski and bike trails will be maintained for use by runners year-round.

Neighborhood parks will be improved where needed and additional sports fields for organized athletics will be developed to meet expanding program needs.

Eagle River/Chugiak Parks and Recreation:

The 1990-1995 Capital Improvement Program for Eagle River/Chugiak includes development of land for green-belts and neighborhood parks and development of Schroeder Airstrip, Loretta French, Beach Lake, and Peters Creek, as well as the general upgrading of the area's parks.

Girdwood Parks and Recreation:

The 1990-1995 Capital Improvement Program for Girdwood Parks and Recreation fills community needs for extension of pathways and improvements to the Town Square area.
