The Civil Defense Department staff consists of a director and one clerk stenographer on a full-time employment basis. All other members of the CD planning group are chiefs of other departments such as police, fire, telephone utility, light and power, etc. Other workers in the program are individual volunteers and public service organizations and groups.

The 1963 budget proposal is based upon an assumption that peace-time conditions will prevail. A change in the world political and military situation will have an effect upon the Federal matching funds contribution program and will require a budget revision to meet the existing situation.

The personal services accounts represent the cost of salaries and accrued leave for the existing staff plus a salary budgeted for an assistant director who will be a full-time supply and resources manager. Experience in the office reveals the need for a full-time supply controller due to the complexity and importance of this phase of Civil Defense.

Account 1225.22 provides for funds with which to construct protective facilities for shelter supplies within the various shelter areas in the City of Anchorage. Security of these supplies is a local responsibility. The Civil Defense vehicle is for administrative use and will be radio equipped for emergency service. Account .281 provides for the continued payment to the Telephone Utility Department for the lease of lines to the Anchorage Warning System.

Account .29 provides funds for the purchase of technical publications, subscriptions to professional publication of CD interest and the production of a local Alaska Survival Pamphlet.

Account .291 will provide for the out-of-state schooling of one week each for three individuals at the Alameda CD Training Center.

The present Civil Defense office requires additional construction and furniture to prepare for and provide adequate training space and planning areas for the Anchorage City Emergency Action Group. Two additional sirens are required at the present time and will be installed during 1963.

Fifty percent of the entire cost of the Civil Defense effort are reimbursable from Federal Funds administered by the State of Alaska.
