#### PROGRAM OUTLINE

The Equipment and Supply Division, formerly known as the Mechanical Maintenance Division was established as a service organization under the Public Works reorganization plan of January 1, 1968 and consists of four sections:

- (1) Maintenance Section Repair, service, cleaning and inspection of all vehicles (P.W. Garage)
- (2) Inventory Section Receiving, storing and issuing all parts and supplies (P.W. Garage)
- (3) Accounting Section Maintaining equipment, inventory, costs and earnings records (P.W. Garage)
- (4) Telephone Garage Repair, service, cleaning, and inspection of Telephone fleet.

## Goal Number I

Continuation of Program to provide maximum utilization of Equipment, Facilities and Personnel.

# Goal Number II

Continuation of 1970 effort to reduce inventories of obsolete equipment, parts and supplies.

## Goal Number III

Continuation of Data Processing Services that provide operating cost analysis of individual equipment units for purposes of establishing equitable vehicle rental rates.

## Goal Number IV

Continuation of Apprentice Mechanic Training Program

## Goal Number V

Provide for more efficient control and utilization of Pool Equipment thru Vehicle Control Specialist.

## Goal Number VI

Continued study to provide data to result in lower operating costs thru use of outside contracted services.

#### LEVEL OF SERVICE

The functional purpose of the Equipment and Supply Division is to provide necessary automotive and other services to City departments at the lowest possible costs. Its main function is to manage and maintain a modern and adequate fleet. This involves the acquisition, maintenance, repair, administration, financing, and the utilization of passenger cars, trucks, heavy equipment and miscellaneous equipment. The Division also provides repairs and maintenance of all other City department owned automotive equipment, and miscellaneous equipment, such as pumps, power saws, light plants, mowers, etc.

The Division also performs special services for all departments, such as welding, fabrication and repair, designing of special tools and equipment and various services that are related to mechanical activities.

The Division is also responsible for warehousing and issuing all supplies used in Public Works Maintenance Operations and warehousing and issuing all janitorial supplies.

It also has the important responsibility for writing specifications for all automotive equipment, disposal of surplus equipment and obsolete supplies and liaison with the Purchasing Division.

The Equipment and Supply Division is operating on the three-shift schedule, with a mechanic and serviceman on third shift at Public Works Garage only.

The Equipment and Supply Division is operated as a working Capital Fund and derives its funds from Equipment Rental and Garage Job Orders and has no direct charges against the General Fund.

The Division in 1971 will be responsible for operation of the Public Works Garage at East 3rd Ave. & Post Road and Telephone Utility Garage located on East 38th Ave. of Seward Highway.
