I. Local Revenues

A mill rate of 2.37 is anticipated on 100% property valuation to fund 100% of the 1977 budget as approved.

- Real Property Taxes
 The estimated 1977 real property valuation is \$2,054,771,000 in general property and \$110,251,000 in
 Utility Net Plant for police protection purposes. In addition to other revenues, \$5,117,850 is
 required from taxation on real property to fund the 1977 budget.
- Personal Property Taxes
 The estimated 1977 personal property valuation is \$644,579,000 for police protection purposes. In addition to other revenues, \$1,527,400 is required from taxation on personal property to fund the 1977 budget.
- Penalty and Interest on Delinquent Taxes

 The revenue estimated for penalties and interest on taxes paid after the due date is \$69,500.
- Franchises
 Anchorage Natural Gas, Incorporated franchise tax to the City and Spenard Service Areas is based on 2% of the gross revenues generated within these areas during 1976. Estimated revenue is \$316,700 based on prior year's experience. Shell Oil Franchise is continued at the same level \$1,400.
- 9211 <u>Court Fines and Forfeitures</u>
 Estimated revenue is based on prior year's experience.
- 9212 <u>Failure to Appear Warrants</u> Estimated revenue is based on prior year's experience.
- 9481 State of Alaska 911
 Per agreement with the State of Alaska 1977 estimated revenue is expected to continue at the same level \$26,750.
- Police Services

 Based on prior year's experience the Anchorage Police Department will be requested by various individuals, clubs, schools and organization to provide an off-duty police officer. This service is rendered at a charge equal to what is paid to the officer on duty at overtime rates. The 1977 estimated revenue is \$20,000.
- 9731 <u>Lease and Rental Revenue</u>
 State of Alaska, Department of Health & Welfare, Jail Facility, Public Safety Building \$88,000.

9761 Interest on Short-Term Investments
Police Service Area cash not required for immediate disbursement is invested until required. It is estimated that such investments will earn \$20,000 in 1977.

II. State Revenues

- Business License Allocations
 Alaska Statute 43.70 provides for a business tax to be collected by the State and refunded to
 Municipalities. Sixty percent of all Alaska Business License collections within the Municipality
 are returned to this area. The 1977 estimated revenue is \$1,321,950.
- Alaska Statutes provide for refund to Municipalities of fees paid by liquor establishments in the State. The law provides that the fees are refunded in full to the Municipalities that provide police protection where the establishments are located. 1977 estimated revenue is \$482,650.
- Police Protection
 In accordance with Alaska Statute 43.18, "State Aid to Local Governments", Police Protection State Shared Revenue is calculated at \$12 per civilian and \$6 per military person. Estimated revenue is based on receiving 90% of actual entitlement. 112,956 x \$12 x .90 = \$1,219,900

 18,897 x \$ 6 x .90 = 102,050
- Electric Co-op Allocation
 Electric Co-ops are taxed 2% of the gross operating revenues by the State of Alaska. This revenue is refunded to the Municipality based on distribution facilities within the Municipality. The estimated revenue for 1977 is \$95,550.

III. <u>Federal Revenue</u>

9311 <u>Federal Revenue Sharing</u> Federal Revenue Sharing monies are allocated to the Police Service Area in the amount of \$622,450.
