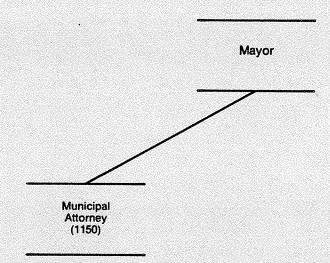

Mission

To provide legal services to all phases of municipal government operations; defend against liabilities; and provide justice and prosecution service for certain misdemeanor criminal offenses with special emphasis on drunk driving.

Major Program Highlights

- Support public safety initiatives especially in the areas of drunk driving and domestic violence.
- Provide additional training to client departments in prevention and processing of labor personnel grievances.
- Provide additional training to code enforcement staff in processing of complaints and infractions.
- Increase capability to process domestic violence cases by increased use of paralegal/investigator.
- Continue support of Anchorage Police Department's Directed Patrols Against Drunk Drivers program which was previously grant funded.
