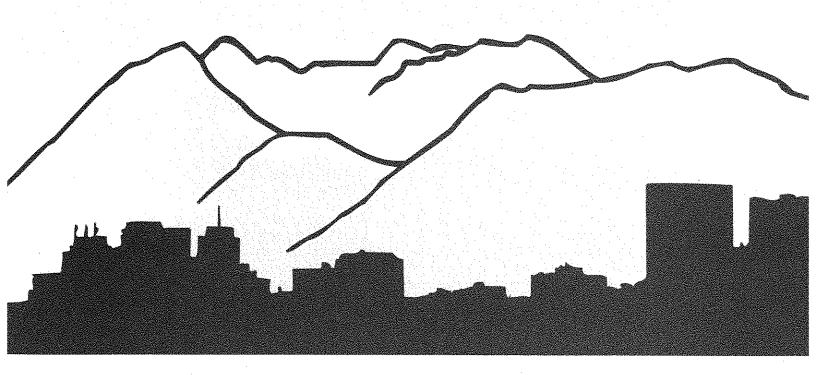

Dear Residents of Anchorage:

I am pleased to present the approved 1997 General Government Operating Budget. There is no net increase in the budget except for voter approved increases, additional police protection and emergency medical/fire services increases, and increased snow removal from neighborhoods. Most areas previously not included in the Anchorage Police Service Area will receive full police protection services in 1997. Even with these increases, together with a \$1.1 million reduction in State revenues, 1997 property taxes are projected to be \$1.4 million under the tax cap.

The 1997 budget will continue our efforts to make Anchorage a safer and more livable city. Crime in Anchorage for the first nine months of 1996 is down from one year ago. Although I am pleased by these results, I am not yet satisfied. The crime statistics are a good sign that Anchorage is moving toward being the city we all want, but there is still work to be done. We will all begin sharing the cost of keeping our city safe on January 1, 1997 as the Anchorage Police Department extends its services in the new police service area.

Making our City safer and a better place in which to live will continue to be our primary focus. We will continue to work to make Anchorage a cleaner, more beautiful city. We will make the streets throughout our City safer and cleaner. In addition to making our City safer and more attractive, we will continue to recognize the importance of quality recreational and cultural opportunities for our citizens.

My administration will continue to put a high priority on working with the business community to foster economic development. The things that make Anchorage a cleaner, safer city are also the things that make Anchorage a place people want to do business. We will continue to place emphasis on working with existing businesses and new prospects in 1997.

I want to thank the Assembly, Municipal Budget Advisory Commission members, and the general public for their efforts during the 1997 budget process. We have continued the steps that we have undertaken to reach our goal of making Anchorage an even better place to live, work, and raise our families.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ADOPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE 1997 GENERAL GOVERNMENT OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, the Mayor has presented the 1997 General Government Operating Budget for the Municipality of Anchorage to the Assembly in accordance with Article XIII of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly reviewed the budget as presented; and

WHEREAS, on November 5, 1996 and on November 12, 1996 duly advertised public hearings were held in accordance with Article XIII, Section 13.04 of the Municipal Charter; and

WHEREAS, the 1997 funds are now ready for appropriation by ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Assembly hereby ordains:

Section 1. That the 1997 General Government Operating Budget is hereby adopted for the Municipality of Anchorage.

Section 2. That the amounts are set forth in the budgets as revised by the Assembly for the respective departments and/or funds shall be, and hereby are appropriations for the 1997 fiscal year.

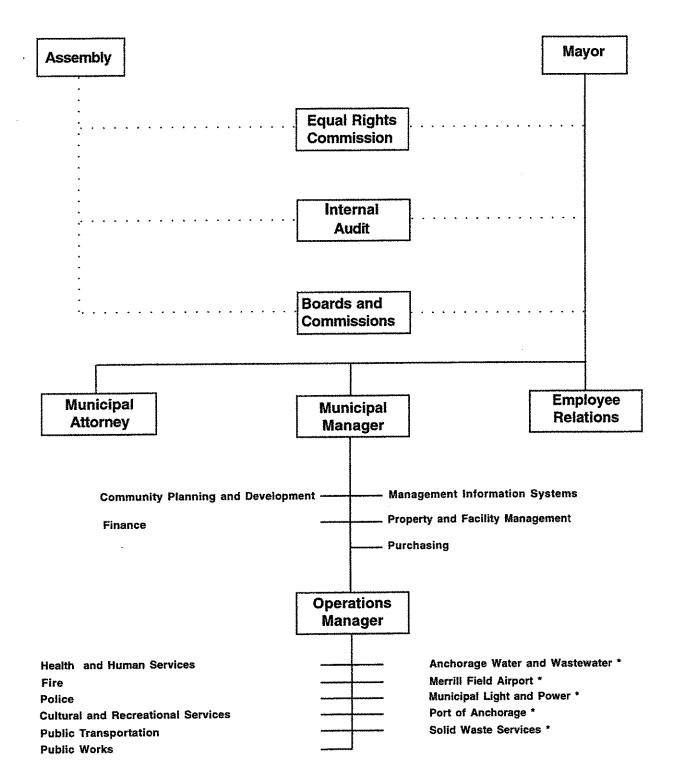
