# 2001 General Government Operating Budget SUMMARY OF ALL REVENUE ACCOUNTS

The following is a discussion of some of the revenue changes in the 2001 approved budget.

1. <u>State Revenues</u>. The 2001 budget assumes no additional reduction in State Revenue Sharing and Safe Communities funding during the 2001 legislative session (amount received in 2001 same as amount actually received in 2000).

#### 2. Local Allocated Revenues

- Increases/decreases in the following revenues are based on 1999 actuals, revised 2000 estimates and 2001 projections:
  - Penalty/Interest on Delinquent Taxes
  - Hotel and Motel Taxes
  - Contribution of Interest from G.O. Bonds
  - Cash Pool Short-Term Interest
  - --- Automobile Tax
  - Tobacco Tax
  - Motor Vehicle Rental Tax
- Anchorage voters approved a Motor Vehicle Rental Tax in April 2000, with an October 1, 2000 effective date. Estimated revenues for 2000 are \$456,000. Full year implementation is expected to generate \$3,050,000 in new tax revenues. Under the Municipality's existing tax limit, these new revenues offset property taxes, thereby helping to reduce their burden.
- The Revised 2000 budget estimated receipts from the Hotel/Motel tax at \$10 million.
  This amount is expected to be adjusted upward to \$10.8 million. Revenues projected for 2001 in the Approved budget are \$11 million and may be adjusted, if necessary, during first quarter budget revisions.
- Earnings on the investment of general obligation bond proceeds and the Municipality's cash pool is projected to earn an additional \$2,048,070 in 2001.
- At the request of the Anchorage Convention and Visitors Bureau, which operates the Egan Center, a contribution of \$365,000 was made from their capital reserve account (401) to fully fund contract management costs of operating the Egan and Civic Convention Center.

#### 3. Local Program Revenues

 Program generated revenues fluctuate with level of service provided. Overall, the 2001 approved budget shows a reduction of \$52,080. 4. <u>Fund Balance</u>. The amount of fund balance available for 2001 is significantly less than that for 2000 because in 2000 significant one-time savings contributed to the availability of additional balances that could be applied to reduce property taxes. Instead of the \$20 million that was available in 2000, \$5.1 million is estimated to be available in 2001.
