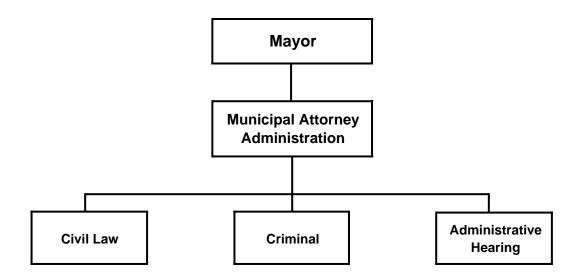

# **Municipal Attorney**

### **Description**

The Municipal Attorney is responsible for providing legal services to Municipal government, managing all civil litigation to which the Municipality is a party and providing judicial prosecution of misdemeanor criminal offenses in direct support of enforcement activities.

This department consists of four divisions:

- Administration chief legal counsel to the Municipality
- <u>Civil Law</u> provides legal counsel for civil Municipal matters
- Criminal Law prosecutes misdemeanor and traffic offenses
- Administrative Hearing Functions adjudicates Municipal Code violations

### 2005 Highlights

- Added an attorney position to deal with Municipal Code enforcement issues.
- Opened fewer cases/matters during the same period of 2005 YTD vs. 2004, while closing more cases/matters during the same time period.
- The resolution of cases/matters as a percentage of cases handled increased dramatically for 2005 YTD, moving up to 124% vs. an 84% rate for 2004.
- The department, now fully staffed, plus the addition of an attorney position in 2005, reversed prior-year trends. For 2005 YTD, the department reduced its total case load 14% rather than ending the year with more cases.

#### 2006-2007 Operational Goals

- Continue to improve efficiencies in case load management.
- Reduce annual amount spent on outside attorney contracts.
- Further increase efficiency in prosecution by purchasing a new case management system to reduce existing costs of third-party system applications; reduce employee computer input time; and provide an online interface with both the Anchorage Police Department and the court house.
- Spend additional time actively pursuing the pre-trial diversion program with defendants, contributing to a further reduction in total prosecution case load and increased revenues.
