

#### Revenue

This section presents a summary of all major revenue sources for general government operations and detailed descriptions of revenue accounts.

#### **Department Detail**

This section presents the approved 2008 and 2009 operating budgets for all general government departments. The budget presentation for each department includes an organizational chart, narrative description, department resource plan, reconciliation summary of departmental budget changes from 2007 revised budget to the approved 2008 and 2009 budgets; budget detail by major divisions/programs within the department, as applicable. Also included, where applicable, is a summary of grant resources.
