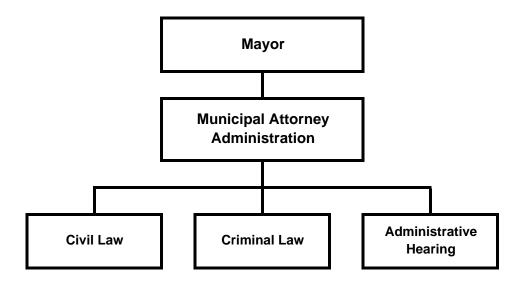

- Administrative Hearing Functions adjudicates Municipal Code violations
