WHEREAS, the Mayor has presented the Assembly with the biennial Municipal Utilities/Enterprise Activities Operating Budget for 2006 and 2007, in accordance with Anchorage Municipal Charter (hereinafter Charter) Section 13.03; and

WHEREAS, the biennial Municipal Utilities/Enterprise Activities Operating Budget sets forth annual budget requirements for Fiscal Year 2006 (Year 1) and Fiscal Year 2007 (Year 2); and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has reviewed the biennial Municipal Utilities/Enterprise Activities Operating Budget for 2006 and 2007 as presented; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2005 and November 8, 2005 duly advertised public hearings were held in accordance with Charter Section 13.04;

WHEREAS, the Utilities' Operating Budget for 2006 (Year 1) is now ready for adoption and appropriation of funds; in accordance with Charter Section 13.05; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Utilities/Enterprise Activities Operating Budget for 2007 (Year 2) is now ready for adoption and approval, subject in 2006 to mid-cycle review, public hearings, Assembly action and appropriation of funds during the 2006 budget process for fiscal year 2007, in accordance with Charter Sections 13.04 and 13.05; now therefore.

#### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The biennial Municipal Utilities/Enterprise Activities Operating Budget for fiscal year 2006 (Year 1) and 2007 (Year 2) and 2006 Municipal Utilities/Enterprise Activities Capital Improvement Budget for fiscal year 2006 are hereby adopted for the Municipality of Anchorage.
