This Administrative Agreement (Agreement) is between the Municipality of Anchorage (Municipality) and the Plumbers and Steamfitters. The Municipality and Plumbers and Steamfitters are parties to the Collective Bargaining Agreement implemented on December 17, 2019.

The purpose of this Agreement is to amend classification changes identified in a comprehensive classification review for specific classifications at the Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility. These changes align specific classifications to proper job titles and wage compensation while deleting language and classifications that are no longer relevant. The Municipality and the Plumbers and Steamfitters worked collaboratively and in good faith to ensure specific classifications are properly compensated and other additional compensation which no longer applies are removed.

Effective the first full pay period following Assembly approval of this Agreement the classification table in Section 11.4 Classification will be amended as follows:

Section 11.4 Classification

Employees are generally hired at the entry/trainee level. Applicants who meet the minimum qualifications, including any required State of Alaska certification(s) and or license(s) may be hired at the higher job classification within the levels of the position. Employees who meet the minimum qualifications and obtain the required State of Alaska certification(s) and or license(s) shall be reclassified to the higher-level job classification within the levels of the position. The reclassification shall be effective within the beginning of the pay period in which the certification(s) and or license(s) are is received by Human Resources Classification.

All certifications must remain current to remain employed.

- A <u>Employees who were downward reclassified on August 28, 2017 more than one pay grade due to the above classification changes will have their salaries remain frozen for the full two year period unless they promote to their previous pay grade or higher.</u>
- B. Employees whose positions are affected due to the above classification changes, will have their salaries frozen for the full two (2) year period and must obtain the required certification(s) and or license(s).
- C. Any employee whose position is affected by the above classification changes and who does not obtain the required certification(s) and/or license(s) within two (2) years will no longer meet the minimum requirements for their position and will be laid off due to their position being eliminated.

Pursuant to AMC 3.70.130 D., each and every collective bargaining contract, agreement, modification, written interpretation, or other change, alteration or amendment, no matter how denominated, shall include a summary of requirements and remedial provisions, and the certification under oath or affirmation by each duly authorized representative signing in behalf of a party. The duly authorized representatives, on behalf of the parties to this agreement, herby affirm and certify as follows:

- A. This agreement complies with Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.70.130.
- B. Section 3.70.130 requires Assembly approval of all modifications and amendments, no matter how denominated.
- C. Absent Assembly approval as required by section 3.70.130, any modification or amendment, no matter how denominated, shall be deemed null and void, and any payments made shall be recoverable by the Municipality.

- D. Absent Assembly approval as required by section 3.70.130, written clarifications and interpretations within the definition of "administrative letter" are invalid.
- E. Section 3.70.010 prohibits the use of administrative letters to vary the explicit terms of a labor agreement.
- F. Intentional actions in violation of section 3.70.130 are subject to fines and penalties under section 1.45.010.
- G. Remedial actions: in the event the provisions of section 3.70.130 are violated by administrative action, any labor agreement, agreement, modification, written interpretation, or other change, alteration or amendment, no matter how denominated, shall be null and void with no force or effect.
