

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPLICATION FOR SUBDIVISION PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVE

On September 10, 2019, the Anchorage Assembly approved Ordinance No. AO 2019-102, amending Anchorage Municipal Code Chapter 12.15 and creating a property tax exemption for certain subdivided property prior to sale or transfer.

AMC 12.15.015 provides that a municipality may partially or wholly exempt from taxation all or a portion of the increase in assessed value directly attributable to the subdivision of a single parcel of property into three or more parcels and any improvements made to the property necessitated by its subdivision prior to sale or transfer.

The exemption shall terminate for each lot when: the lot's ownership is transferred; a residential or commercial structure has been completed on the lot, and a certificate of occupancy or a conditional certificate of occupancy has been issued; or after five years.

A request for exemption from property taxes under this chapter shall be made in writing to the Municipal Assessor and must be submitted prior to **March 15**th of the year the exemption is requested.
