This letter serves as formal written notice to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development that the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) is transferring the Collaborative Applicant Primary Contact to The Anchorage Coalition to End Homelessness (ACH).

The last two grant cycles (2011 & 2012), the CoC process and application was implemented by the MOA Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) in collaboration with the Housing And Neighborhood Development Commission, the Commission's Oversight Subcommittee on Homelessness and the Anchorage Coalition on Homelessness.

The MOA DHHS sent the ACH Board written notification April 8, 2013 stating they were withdrawing from the role as the CoC Collaborative Applicant. Both parties agreed to have the transition completed no later than August 1, 2013. ACH will have responsibility for the CoC process, including writing and submitting the CoC grant.
