FIREARM AND AMMUNITION STORAGE

An applicant who applies for a Child Care Home license must inform licensing and all parents of children in care of the presence of firearms in the facility. Additionally, the administrator of the facility must ensure any firearms are unloaded and stored in a locked gun safe or other locked place and ammunition is stored separately from the firearms, in a place inaccessible to children in care. (7 AAC 10.1080).
