Follow up discussions on Earl's power point presentation:

- Runway 5/23 will be temporarily closed for a 10-night period to facilitate the SCS emergency methane gas project, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on dates to be determined.
- The Air Force Memorial is open, and MRI is collaborating with the Mayor's Office and the Veterans Affairs Commission on long-term maintenance arrangements.
- The Merrill Field 1984 replat of the airport included a 15-year self-executing term that was set in place, has expired.
- There have been approximately 10 noise complaints related to the construction closure of Runway 7/25. Earl has responded to and addressed each complaint individually.
- John Pratt recommended that the MAAAC board draft a resolution regarding the homeless shelter on 5th Street, focusing on the security at the airport. Stormy requested additional security statistics from MRI to include in the resolution.
- A year ago, MRI ranked second nationally for VPDs, but as of last month, it has declined to 30th place.
- MRI is awaiting the MAAAC Board Budget Resolution from July in order to present it to the administration for the 2026 budget meeting.
- The ALP patch has been submitted for review by the FAA.

A. Runway 7/25 Rehabilitation Update- Mark Swenson (HDL) & Matt Wavra (QAP)

- The runway project appears to have been constructed as designed and HDL is currently addressing the punch list items.
- The paving process proceeded smoothly.
- Awaiting the arrival of lighting components before installation, after which FAA will conduct the night flight checks.
- FAA has designed the PAPI's, they are overseeing their installation and will conduct the flight checks.
- HDL would like to thank everyone for their cooperation at MRI during the construction period.
- There could be some nighttime closures for 8/26, per the contract, as needed.
- Runway 8/26 is on schedule to open on Saturday, August 9th.
- Striping is scheduled for Friday, August 8th.
- NOTAMs will be in place and for now 8/26 will be daytime VFR only.

Earl's FYI's - Continued

- Landfill Gas Mitigation:
 - Meeting regularly with SWS Dept and their contractor (SCS) regarding Landfill Gas Collection System repair.
 - Project will take place over 2 years; Will require occasional, temporary, and select relocation of tiedowns in taxiway Q
 - Work delayed due to FAA review of Form 7460 and runway closures.
 - SCS is communicating well with MRI and tenants.
- MRI Master Plan Status.
 - RFP has been submitted to MOA Purchasing. Awaiting FAA Grant Agreement to proceed.
 - FAA Grant Application has been submitted to FAA. Awaiting response.
