

SAFE OPERATIONS AT MERRILL FIELD

Runway incursions are a serious safety concern. A runway incursion is defined as any occurrence at an airport involving the incorrect presence of an aircraft, vehicle, or person on the protected area of a surface designated for the landing and takeoff of aircraft.

GUIDANCE FOR PEDESTRIANS



Never ever cross a taxiway or runway on foot!



Stay with the pilot or ramp agent when boarding or deplaning an aircraft.



Avoid distractions like using a cell phone, texting or unnecessary conversation.

GUIDANCE FOR DRIVERS



Know where you are and where you are going.



Do NOT cross solid lines without clearance from the tower controller on 126.0.



Drivers must repeat controller's "Hold short of runway" instructions.

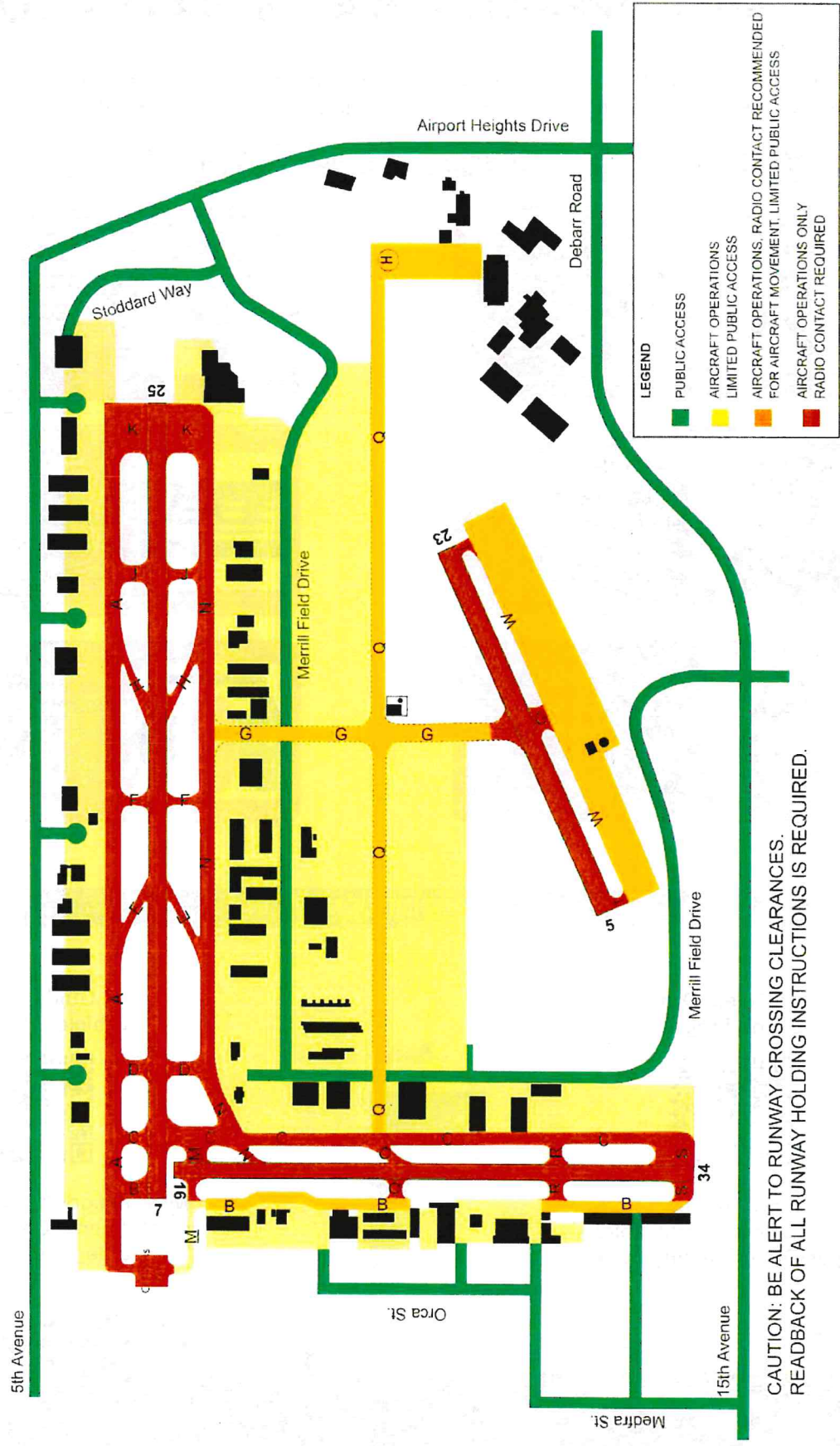
