WORK SESSION

1. Foreman's Reports:

Maintenance Financial and Work Program Reports

Mr. Anthony Winsor read the Foreman's Report -

Maintenance and Operations Update:

- Fall Sweeping is scheduled to begin September 1, 2023.
- Summer Crack Sealing was completed in sectors 5, 10, 17, 18, and part of 21.
- · Storm system cleaning is still ongoing.
- Fall Maintenance will begin after all scheduled Capital Improvement Projects (C.I.P.) are completed, approximately September 18, 2023.

Capital Improvement Program (CIP):

- The difficulties obtaining access thru Aurora Borealis has pushed the Starner Bridge Project to spring of 2014. Bridge plans are at 100% and ready to go out to bid.
- Delivery and production of materials for the Breckenridge lift station has been a challenge. Had to be postponed until the spring of 2024.
- Falling Water Creek culvert replacement has also been postponed until 2024. Design is 100% and ready to go out to bid.
- New projects were added to the 2023 CIP project list due to other projects being postponed: War Admiral, Ptarmigan, Glacier View, Upper Terrace, and Knik Vista.

Mr. Winsor requested community councils start working on their 2024 CIP wish lists.
