## Toilsome Hill/Glen Alps Road, Canyon Road state grant

<u>Projects studied</u> – Josh Cross reviewed the projects considered. Judy noted that the Board had prioritized the projects. A list of the primary alternatives was passed out. (Attached)

<u>Comments received</u> – Shelly passed out the comments received from the brochure mailed out concerning the state grant.

Discussion of the alternatives followed. Daniel requested we add legal access (public use easement) acquisition through the neighborhood on Canyon Road as the second prioritized alternative. Judy amended the motion to make the Canyon Subdivision legal access the third priority alternative. Shelly and Judy voted in favor. Joe opposed. The prioritized alternatives now are #1 and #2 as stated; #3 obtaining the legal access through the Canyon Road neighborhood; and #4 improve Canyon Road to Rohaley property.
