WHEREAS, the community of Girdwood is a neighborhood within the Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, the Heritage Land Bank (HLB) applies for grants on lands managed by the HLB within Girdwood; and

WHEREAS, the Girdwood South Townsite Master Plan provides two routes to be studied to provide access from Karolius Road to Alyeska Highway, which requires further study in order to finalize; and

WHEREAS, the US Department of Transportation's Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant is a potential source of funding to assist in study, design and engineering of this project; and

WHEREAS, this grant opportunity was discussed at the Girdwood Land Use Committee at their regular meeting on May 10, 2021 with a recommendation for this action by a vote of 18 in favor, 1 opposed and 12 abstentions;
