# BOND SUPPORT

## HISTORY 2015

68% of Girdwood's voters voted to tax themselves for the cost of establishing and maintaining a cemetery. Girdwood and the Heritage Land Bank identified a parcel to study.

## ANALYSIS 2016-2019

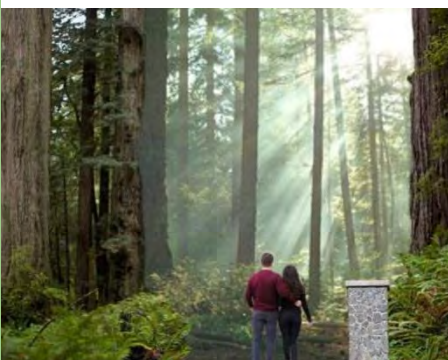
Girdwood Cemetery Committee presented to the public a Feasibility Study, a Master Plan Analysis Report, and a Schematic Report detailing the proposed cemetery's four phases.

## FORECASTING 2020

Anchorage Daily News reported on June 22, 2020, that the Anchorage Memorial Park, established in 1915 and our only public cemetery, would run out of space for public burials by 2027.

## SELECTION 2021

Combined community councils in both Eagle River/Chugiak and Birchwood selected a proposed cemetery site in Eagle River.

## Resolution 2022-20 Of the Girdwood Board of Supervisors **RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT** **FOR AREAWIDE BOND PROPOSAL FOR CEMETERIES IN ANCHORAGE**

Whereas, in 2015 voters in Girdwood voters passed an ordinance allowing the Girdwood Board of Supervisors (GBOS) powers to tax property owners to establish and maintain a cemetery in Girdwood by an unprecedented 68.7% in favor; and,

Whereas, the GBOS established a committee, The Girdwood Cemetery Committee, which pursued the goal of establishing a cemetery whose meetings are open to the public and which reports regularly to the GBOS; and,

Whereas, public land was chosen from several offered sites from the Municipality of Anchorage's Heritage Land Bank after extensive public process; and,

Whereas, the GBOS expended public funds for the environmental study which proved the suitability of the chosen site; and,

Whereas, communication and consultation has been maintained with the Director of the Anchorage Memorial Park and the Municipality's Memorial Park Advisory Board since 2002; and,

Whereas, a design and construction cost estimate was created for a multi-phase development plan for the establishment of the Cemetery in 2019; and,

Whereas, the Anchorage Daily News reported in 2020 that the Anchorage Memorial Park had space for public burials for five more years; and,

Whereas, the Girdwood Cemetery Committee has reached out with community councils in Chugiak and Eagle River who expressed their wishes to establish a cemetery in the northern part of the Municipality of Anchorage, has shared information, participated in their public process, and has helped coordinate efforts toward that goal; and,

Whereas, the Girdwood Cemetery Committee has also coordinated efforts with the Municipality's Memorial Park Advisory Board to help promote needed improvements for the Anchorage Memorial Park; and

Whereas, through the coordinated efforts of the Girdwood Cemetery Committee, the Eagle River and Chugiak Community Councils, and the Municipality's Memorial Park Advisory Board, a bond proposal is being developed to fund the establishment of a cemetery in Girdwood at an estimated cost of \$5M, a cemetery in Eagle River and for renovations and improvements at the Anchorage Memorial Park;

THEREFORE, the Girdwood Board of Supervisors requests the Municipality of Anchorage place an areawide bond for those projects on the Spring 2023 Municipality of Anchorage Areawide Ballot.

PASSED AND APPROVED by a vote of 5 to 0 this 17th day of October 2022.

## Chugiak Community Council Resolution

From Council Meeting

October 20, 2022

A resolution of the Chugiak Community Council regarding a CER area public cemetery

**Whereas**, the Chugiak Community Advisory Board on April 6, 2019 did pass a resolution supporting the CER Cemetery effort, and encouraging/requesting that the Parks and Rec, HLB and other MOA entities cooperate and help identify potential sites, and that local community councils solicit members to makeup a steering committee.

**Whereas**, the CER area community councils, Eagle River Chamber of Commerce, and CER Ministerial Association in April/May of 2019 did pass resolutions supporting formation of a steering committee that would work towards establishment of a community cemetery in Chugiak – Eagle River.

**Whereas**, the Municipal Assembly passed funding to support a Land Use study of the Chugiak Eagle River area for suitable sites for a public cemetery. The Heritage Land bank was to administer the Land Use Study.

**Whereas**, the CER Cemetery Steering committee worked in 2019 and 2020 to promote the cemetery and coordinate with the Consultant performing the Land Use Study. As well as presenting preliminary site selection information to the area Community Councils.

**Whereas**, the final results of the Land Use Study, identifies the property "A-2" which is adjacent to the correctional center, and Eagle River High School as the site with the "Best Development Potential".

### ***Excerpt from the Chugiak-Eagle River Site Selection Study July 2021***

*"The conceptual site plans were circulated among the Chugiak-Eagle River Cemetery Committee and the Community Councils of: Chugiak, Birchwood, Eagle River, and Eagle River Valley. It was the general consensus of these groups that site A-2 has the best development potential for a community cemetery based on the established selection criteria:*

- A. Ownership: This parcel is owned by Municipality of Anchorage/Heritage Land Bank, no additional property acquisition costs.*
- B. Location: This site is easily accessible from Yosemite Drive, which is a collector, and is in a central location that is advantageous all residents to offer equitable use of the facility.*
- C. Zoning: This parcel is currently zoned CE-PCD (Planned Community Development); a cemetery is a permitted use under this designation; however, does require a formal master plan process per AMC Title 21, specifically for the community cemetery use.*
- D. Existing Uses: The site is currently vacant, however there are plans in place to develop a recreational trail loop in the northeast portion of the parcel. The cemetery master plan will integrate these facilities to assure their continued accessibility, functionality and*

*maintenance.*

- E. Adjacent Uses & Zoning: The adjacent parcels are zoned CE-PLI and CE-PCD. To the north of the site is the Hiland Mountain Correctional Center, to the west is the Alaska Division of Forestry maintenance shop, and to the south is Eagle River High School. These designations and existing uses are considered compatible with a cemetery.*
- F. Size: There is adequate acreage to accommodate approximately 17,600 full body burials with a projected life span of 440 years.*
- G. Vehicular Access: Vehicular access is easily provided from Yosemite Drive; no new road construction is required. As this is not a residential site and cemeteries do not generate significant vehicle trips, traffic impacts should be negligible.*
- H. Topography: The land on this site gently sloping and well drained and is suitable for development as a cemetery. Extensive earthmoving and grading are not anticipated.*
- I. Positive Drainage: There are no known flood hazards, wetlands, or drainage issues.”*

Whereas the Chugiak-Eagle River Advisory Board met at a public advertised meeting on May 19,2021 to hear the results of the Land Use Study presented by the Boutet Company. At that meeting the Board voted to acknowledge the importance and need for a local cemetery and voted to support the “ A-2” location as the favored location.

Whereas there is currently support on the Anchorage Assembly for the establishment of a cemetery including potential funding.

Therefore, the Chugiak Community Council passed a resolution at their October 20, 2022 meeting. The motion for the resolution as worded below passed unanimously.

1. The Chugiak Community Council supports development of a public cemetery in the Chugiak Eagle River area, specifically at the site A-2 (across from Eagle River High School on Wolf Pack drive) as recommended in the 2021 Land Use study report prepared by the Boutet Company for the Heritage Land Bank.
2. Funds would be raised for the Chugiak Eagle River (CER) Cemetery project by voter approval on the April 2023 ballot per one of two potential options.
  - a. Our first preference is that the funds be raised by CER levy for up to \$3M land, design, construction, and initial maintenance.
  - b. Our second preference is that the funds be raised as part of an Area-wide Cemetery bond where up to \$3M specifically for the land, design, construction, and initial maintenance be dedicated for the CER cemetery project in conjunction with funding the costs of other area cemeteries (Girdwood and Downtown Anchorage) through the same area-wide bond.

## Girdwood Cemetery Frequently Asked Questions

### **Why doesn't Girdwood already have a cemetery?**

Girdwood had a graveyard that was displaced during re-construction after the 1964 earthquake. Girdwood does not currently have a cemetery.

### **Why does Girdwood need a cemetery?**

Cemeteries provide a sense of history and permanence to the people who live here and generations of residents and visitors. Girdwood is a place that people think of as "home", is a place that many people who don't live here love. Girdwood is a place that people have expressed a desire to be buried or memorialized. There is great need for public cemeteries in the Municipality of Anchorage. It is estimated that the public portion of the Anchorage Memorial Park Cemetery will be full in less than 7 years.

### **Where will the cemetery be located?**

The Municipality of Anchorage's Heritage Land Bank offered several pieces of land, and the Girdwood Cemetery Committee selected the site at MP.5 on Crow Creek Road, opposite the school bus turnaround. The site is undeveloped, mostly forested land.

### **What type of cemetery will this be?**

The Girdwood Cemetery Committee is dedicated to retain as much of the wild character of the current setting as possible. Forested areas will remain, alder meadows will be seeded to create grassy meadows. Looping trails and paths will weave between the various burial area. The structures that are built will be consistent with our community's character and grounds-keeping will be minimal and low maintenance.

The cemetery will be a quiet place for reflection, grieving, celebration and honoring of the deceased. The cemetery will be an inclusive public space available to all religious denominations and spiritual communities.

The Girdwood Cemetery will offer a variety of types of burial and disposition of human remains:

- **Green, or natural burials:** These burials are fully body interments into the ground in a manner that does not inhibit decomposition. They do not include a vault, use non-toxic body preparation methods, and use containers made of organic materials, including shrouds. Green burials protect worker health, reduce carbon emissions, conserve natural resources and preserve habitat.
- **Conventional burials:** These burials may include the use of burial vaults, burial containers made of non-organic materials, and remains prepared using embalming chemicals.
- **Cremated Remains:** The Girdwood Cemetery will have locations for burial and placement of cremated remains (cremains), including a columbarium structure for the placement of urns and an area for cremains to be spread. There will be locations for permanent plaque or other marker placement to commemorate those who are interred.

### **Can I bury my pet at the cemetery?**

The Girdwood Cemetery will not have an option for animal companion full body burial, but we are planning to have a pet-specific memorial garden where pet cremains can be spread. This component of the cemetery is still being planned.

### **How long will the cemetery last?**

The Girdwood Cemetery will be able to accommodate burials for over 100 years. The site will be maintained and managed as a cemetery forever.

**How much will it cost?**

Our 2019 Schematic Design includes multiple phases for construction. Cost of phase 1 includes the majority of the infrastructure, estimated at four million dollars in 2019. To compensate for inflation and contingency funds, we are currently estimating \$5M for Girdwood Cemetery and \$10M for the bond overall.

**How do we pay for this?**

Infrastructure will be paid for through an Area Wide Bond. To build a cemetery, we will request a bond to be approved by Areawide voters in 2023, along with Chugiak/Eagle River and work at the Anchorage Memorial Park. Cemetery management and operation is an Area Wide responsibility of the Municipality of Anchorage.

**Who will manage the cemetery?**

Cemeteries are managed by the Municipality of Anchorage as an Area Wide function. Snowplowing will be handled by Girdwood Valley Service Area.
