Agenda Item LUC 2503-01:

Land Acknowledgement: As we gather with a common intention for our GVSA this evening, LUC would like to begin by acknowledging the stewardship of the indigenous peoples of Alaska, whose land we reside on and the surrounding waters we depend on. Old Business:

Agenda Item LUC 2403-04: Status of the Girdwood Comprehensive Plan, Intro Nov 19, hearing Dec 17 and Feb 25 hearing/Assembly action. Imagine!Girdwood). Hearings are closed. Assembly will consider 2 substantive amendments related to land north of the airport and land in the Lower Virgin Creek area and then are expected to vote on amendments and vote to adopt the plan on TUE March 18. Following that, the process to update code to match the new plan must begin.

Agenda Item LUC 2407-04: Status of LUC recommended GBOS Resolution of Support for Service Area STR registration and regulation. (Wilbanks/Schechter/Edgington). No update. GBOS requested that GHEC consider some changes to the draft framework that was passed last fall to match the GBOS housing goals of STR as an accessory use rather than a primary use of housing. GHEC declined to take action after discussion. No action requested of LUC.

Agenda Item LUC 2502-05: Request for LUC recommendation for GBOS Resolution of Support for code change to allow retail in gC-10, Tract B2A, Alpine View Estates, Phase 3 (Tim Cabana, presenting).

Cabana has received new information on what he needs to develop this tract for retail and has shifted his request from variance to code change. Preliminary draft resolution is included in the packet, this will be amended as well. Goal is to build a retail space for a hardware

store.

Concerns expressed are impact of increased retail to traffic on Alyeska Highway and impact to neighborhood adjacent to this property. gC-10 was purposefully protected from retail in GAP because of proximity to neighborhood and desire to concentrate town center in specific areas (Old Girdwood, Town Center and Resort base).

Request for traffic study and consideration for reasons that retail has been restricted previously.

Motion:

LUC moves to postpone this topic to April LUC meeting. Motion by Brice Wilbanks/2nd R Hutchins-Cabibi Motion carries by assent vote

Cabana will provide updated resolution language and other supporting documents regarding traffic study already performed and code change already received for the proposed motel and retail space at the next meeting.

Agenda Item LUC 2408-04: Request for LUC recommendation for exclusion of the GVSA from the proposed 3% Municipal Sales Tax (Brice Wilbanks)

Assembly is considering proposal for special election that includes the Girdwood Arts and Recreation proposal. If it passes, the Assembly would put the sales tax item with the recommended projects to voters in a special election. No action on this item at this time; it will return at the April meeting.
