- Following the agenda, we did introductions and discussed the project background and process for developing a new playground.

 - 2. Project Engineer and Landscape Architecture Firm: The Boutet Company
- Funding Available for project
- Improvement Prioritization Map Exercise (see attached map graphic with Opportunities and Constraints), everyone went around and shared their opinions and we discussed "repeated trends" or themes from the board.
- Analysis Data Review: we briefly discussed the analysis maps & data including highlights:
 - 1. Analysis Data <u>LINK</u>
 - 2. Population of Youth
 - 3. Population of People with disabilities in area and types
 - 4. Wetlands in area just north of playground (high water table, drainage, etc.)
 - 5. Reuse of existing footprint of playground is ideal for financial, but also for keeping the field open, proximity to sledding hill, etc.
 - 6. Other area observations (wind, connection to Chugach, etc.)
