**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

This pathway runs through Northeast Anchorage, offering a route for pedestrians and cyclists traveling north-south. It's also designated as a Safe Route to School for Creekside Elementary, which is adjacent to the park. However, the pathway is currently in poor condition and would greatly benefit from upgrades to its lighting fixtures and overall infrastructure. Playground equipment and surfacing would also be upgraded, as it no longer complies with ADA accessibility standards.
