

Cross Town

This project is the next Route to be implemented, based off of TOTM 2020 priorities. Since 2020, PTD has heard from various members of the public, stakeholders, and organizations that cross town service is needed, and especially service to the Anchorage Neighborhood Health Center.

Cross Town: This route will connect East Anchorage and West Anchorage via Boniface Parkway, Alaska Native Medical Center, UMED, 36th Ave, Loussac Library, Anchorage Neighborhood Health Center, and International Airport Road.

There are two potential starting points for this route, and both versions end at the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport - South Terminal.

The **first** version is what TOTM 2020 had as Project B.1. Starting at the Muldoon Transit Hub, heading West across Debarr to Boniface Parkway and across town to the Airport.

The **second** version is a reimagined North Mountain View service where part of the current Route 31 would be assumed by this new Route, which then travels across all of Boniface Parkway, and then across town to the Airport.

(Both route alternatives could also service the St. Elias Specialty Hospital from Denali and Cordova Streets, rather than A & C Streets.)
