


Northeast Anchorage realignments

The major function of this realignment option is to better connect Fairview and Northeast residents with a one seat ride to different parts of the city. (*This scenario can only be implemented if the Cross Town Route is implemented and there is no duplicative service in North Mountain View where Route 31 currently is.*)

Routes 11 & 31: Combining these routes connects the neighborhoods of Fairview, Airport Heights, Russian Jack, and Northeast, giving riders one seat ride opportunities from downtown to the Senior Activity Center, Alaska Regional Hospital, Cook Inlet Tribal Council and the Muldoon Transit Hub.

Route 51: Would not change and still provide service from the Muldoon Transit hub to Centennial Village.






Northeast Anchorage Realignments

With the implementation of the Cross Town Route in North Mountain View, this version of Route 31 can be realigned to connect to the Alaska Regional Hospital campus.

Route 31: Would no longer serve North Mountain View and would give riders one seat ride opportunities to/from Alaska Regional Hospital and the Muldoon Transit Hub.

Route 51: Would not change and still provide service from the Muldoon Transit hub to Centennial Village.
