A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AFFIRMING THAT THE

MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE IS NOT, AND SHOULD NOT BE REFERRED TO AS, A

"SANCTUARY CITY"; AND AFFIRMING THE MUNICIPALITY'S COMMITMENT TO ASSIST FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAWS.

WHEREAS, the Anchorage Assembly passed a Resolution in 2003 (AR 2003-223, as amended) that led some to label the Municipality of Anchorage a "sanctuary city";

WHEREAS, the term "sanctuary city" is not defined in law and has no definite legal meaning;

WHEREAS, by vote taken on December 18, 2007, the Anchorage Assembly rescinded AR 2003-223, thereby lifting restrictions of the Municipality's use of Municipal resources and

institutions for the enforcement of federal immigration law;

**WHEREAS**, there is consequently no basis upon which to validly classify the Municipality of Anchorage as a "sanctuary city";

WHEREAS, certain media outlets have recently indicated that Anchorage is a "sanctuary city";

WHEREAS, certain websites continue to list Anchorage as a "sanctuary city";

**WHEREAS,** it is apparent that confusion exists regarding the status of the Municipality; now, therefore,

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Municipality of Anchorage is not, and should not be referred to as, a "sanctuary city."

<u>Section 2.</u> The Municipality affirms and declares its commitment to render appropriate assistance in the enforcement of federal immigration laws.

<u>Section 3.</u> This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
