1 **A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ESTABLISHING**  
2 **A PLAN FOR EMERGENCY COLD WEATHER SHELTERING THROUGH**  
3 **DECEMBER 31, 2022 AND REAPPROPRIATING NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION**  
4 **TWO HUNDRED SEVENTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,217,000) PREVIOUSLY**  
5 **APPROPRIATED FOR ADULT EMERGENCY SHELTERING AND**  
6 **APPROPRIATING NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED SIXTEEN**  
7 **THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,216,000) OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES RETAILS**  
8 **SALES TAX FUND (206000) FUND BALANCE TO THE ANCHORAGE HEALTH**  
9 **DEPARTMENT TO BE USED FOR EMERGENCY COLD WEATHER SHELTERING.**

11  
12 **WHEREAS**, Anchorage Municipal Code 16.120, Emergency Shelter Plan for  
13 Homeless Persons, provides for the activation and deactivation of emergency shelter  
14 under certain weather conditions which occur annually in Anchorage; and

15  
16 **WHEREAS**, Assembly Resolution 2022-252, As Amended established a community  
17 task force led by the Anchorage Coalition to End Homelessness to develop an  
18 Emergency Shelter Plan for Cold Weather and that task force provided a detailed  
19 recommendation to the Assembly Committee on Housing and Homelessness on  
20 September 21, 2022; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor released the Administration's Winter 2022-2023 Emergency  
23 Shelter Plan summary on August 31, 2022 which included a four-pronged approach  
24 providing diverse solutions; and

25  
26 **WHEREAS**, the Assembly Committee on Housing and Homelessness discussed the  
27 options contained in both Plans and reached a general consensus on a workable plan  
28 given the information available, collaborating with the Mayor's administration; now,  
29 therefore,

31 **THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:**

33 **Section 1.** The following facilities will be mobilized as emergency shelter locations  
34 as soon as the Acting Health Director activates the Emergency Shelter Plan under the  
35 conditions contained in Anchorage Municipal Code 16.120.020A:

**Section 2.** When additional capacity allows, the Sullivan Arena shall be the first facility to be deactivated.

**Section 3.** That an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$1,217,000) previously appropriated for adult emergency sheltering by AR 2022-221(S), As Amended, is hereby reappropriated to the Anchorage Health Department 2022 Operating Budget, all within the Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000), to be used for emergency cold weather sheltering through December 31, 2022.

**Section 4.** That an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$1,216,000) of Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000) Fund Balance is hereby appropriated to the Anchorage Health Department 2022 Operating Budget, all within the Alcoholic Beverages Retail Sales Tax Fund (206000), to be used for emergency cold weather sheltering through December 31, 2022.

**Section 5.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
