Status: Apr 13 2015 - This study will build off an unfinished 2006 drainage study. State grant funding is proposed.

Status: Apr 13 2015 - The Girdwood Service Area has provided funding for design and will pursue state grant funding for construction. Survey and base mapping underway.

Status: Apr 13 2015 - This project has not started. State grant funding is proposed.
