Status: Apr 13 2015 - No work is underway and no funding is proposed in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. The project will remain on the Capital Project Needs List for future funding consideration.

Status: Apr 13 2015 - Design is underway by term contractor.

9 [Wentworth St Surface Rehab - Northwestern Ave to south end](#)

Status: Apr 13 2015 - This project has not started. No funding is proposed in the current six-year CIP.

10 [Woodside East Area Road and Drainage Improvements](#)

Status: Apr 13 2015 - This project will remain on the needs list for future funding consideration. There is no funding programmed in the current six-year CIP. Because these are local roads, this project would be funded through the Road Improvement District (RID) program. In this program, property owners initiate the project and agree to pay 10% of the project costs through special assessments.
