Status: Feb 28 2017 - This is an annual program with bond funding anticipated. CUI is being tasked.

1 36th Ave Upgrade - Patterson St to Muldoon Rd

Status: Feb 28 2017 - No work is currently scheduled in the 6-year Capital Improvement Program. The project will remain on the Capital Project Needs List for evaluation and prioritization. However, it is a state owned collector street and prioritization and funding would be through the State of Alaska.

#### 2 Muldoon Rd Southbound Right-Turn Lane at 36th Ave

Status: Feb 28 2017 - This project has not started and there is no funding programmed at this time. Because Muldoon Road is owned by the State of Alaska, evaluation and prioritization of this project will be done by the Alaska DOT&PF.

#### 3 Old Muldoon Rd Upgrade - 32nd Ave to 36th Ave

Status: Feb 28 2017 - This project has not started. This road is owned by the State of Alaska. Evaluation and prioritization for future funding consideration will be done by the Alaska DOT&PF.

#### 4 Tudor Rd Access Management (East) - Seward Hwy to Patterson St

Status: Feb 28 2017 - No work is underway or scheduled in the six-year Capital Improvement Program. This is a state-owned facility and evaluation and funding would be by the State of Alaska. The route is designated as a major arterial in the Official Streets and Highways Plan (OS&HP). This project is included in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
