17 WHEREAS, after a rash of burglaries in the neighborhoods of East Anchorage, a
18 group of area residents from all walks of life came together to provide their solution to the
19 problem by creating the NorthEast Community Patrol; and

21 WHEREAS, fifteen members including Michelle Daugherty, Michael Daugherty, *
22 Russell Nogg, Timothy Sullivan Sr., Bobby Alexander, Louis Gallegos, Jerry Johnson,
23 Samuel Haywood, Helen Lindsey, Peter "Pete" Biondich, Daniel Dildine, David Pree, Charles
24 Kelly, Larry Roberts, and Eldon Mulder volunteer their time on weekends to patrol the
25 neighborhoods of East Anchorage to ensure the safety of residents and assist other
26 community patrols on an as-needed basis; and

28 WHEREAS, Community Patrol members have become the "eyes and ears" of their
29 community, patrolling East Anchorage neighborhoods, responding to drug houses, and
30 informing area residents how they can help themselves with civil law and abatement
31 procedures; and

33 WHEREAS, Community Patrol members are FEMA trained and certified so they can
34 assist with emergency response teams and prepare for disasters before they happen; and

36 WHEREAS, these individuals have chosen to voluntarily serve their community and
37 assist their neighbors in creating a safe environment for all residents and deserve our thanks
38 and recognition for their unselfish efforts and the public service they provide.


40 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:
