Anchorage Assembly Third Worksession regarding American Relief Plan Funding and Town Hall this Friday, April 9 from 5:00-9:30 PM

On March 19th and March 26th, the Assembly held the first two Worksessions receiving public input on the allocation of new COVID-19 relief dollars and engaging in a productive public dialogue. In accordance with the Anchorage Assembly's plan for a thorough public process, the Assembly will hold its third Worksession/Town Hall this Friday, April 9th, to continue planning usage of COVID-19 relief dollars.

The meeting will be divided into two parts:

- 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.: Worksession to continue discussion possible allocations of funds.
- 8 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.: Town Hall-style discussion.
