Assembly ready to work with Mayor Bronson on homeless solutions.

Anchorage Assembly leaders are planning to work with Mayor Dave Bronson to come up with a comprehensive homeless solution.

“We appreciate that the mayor’s first major policy initiative is to address Anchorage’s homeless crisis,” said Assembly Chair Suzanne LaFrance. “I am confident that the administration and assembly will continue to collaborate with each other and stakeholders to develop a plan that works and has broad public support.”

Assembly Vice Chair, Christopher Constant said, “This issue has challenged administrations for decades and Mayor Bronson’s commitment to a bold effort, coupled with his willingness to build a unifying proposal, bodes well for our city.”

The assembly and administration will hold working sessions and regular committee meetings during the coming weeks to develop the plan. The next meeting to discuss this matter is the Assembly Housing and Homelessness Committee scheduled to meet July 21, 2021 from 11:00 AM – 12:30 PM at Assembly Chambers.
