

Closure of City Hall Public Counter for Treasury Department

To help slow the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) in the community, the Municipality of Anchorage is temporarily closing its main customer counter area at City Hall until further notice. This office closure notice affects in-person, normal business operations tied to the Treasury Division. The Treasury Department will be going virtual starting at 8:00am Wednesday, March 18th until further notice.

We strongly encourage customers to avoid making payments in-person and to instead use regular mail, Municipal Secure Ballot Drop-Boxes (see below for more information) or pay online with credit card or e-check via Treasury's main website or directly by visiting www.officialpayments.com

For drop-off payments, rather than enter any municipal facility, between now and municipal election day on April 7, 2020 please consider using any of the 18 Municipal Secure Ballot Drop-Boxes located throughout the Municipality. This includes drop boxes outside of City Hall, Loussac Library and Eagle River Town center. These drop boxes are emptied daily.
