

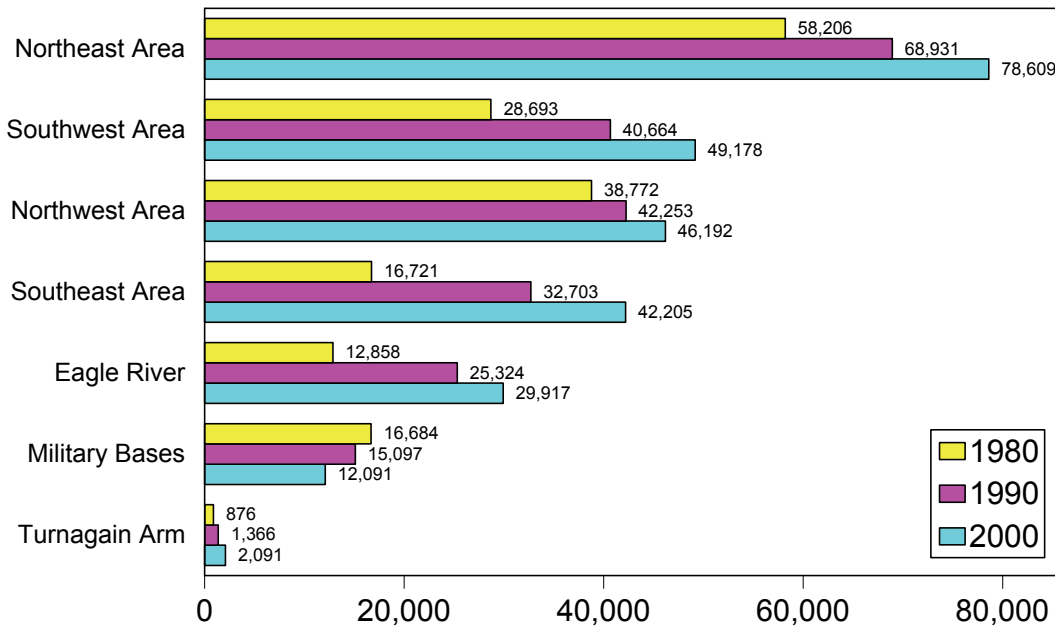

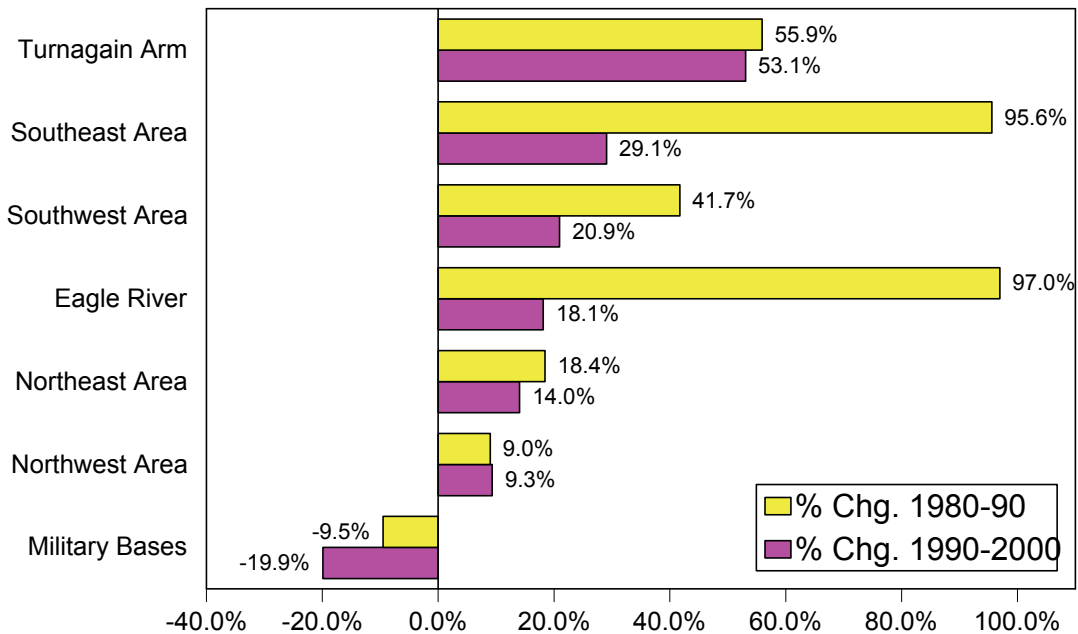
## Anchorage Sub-Areas - 1980-2000

# % Population Change

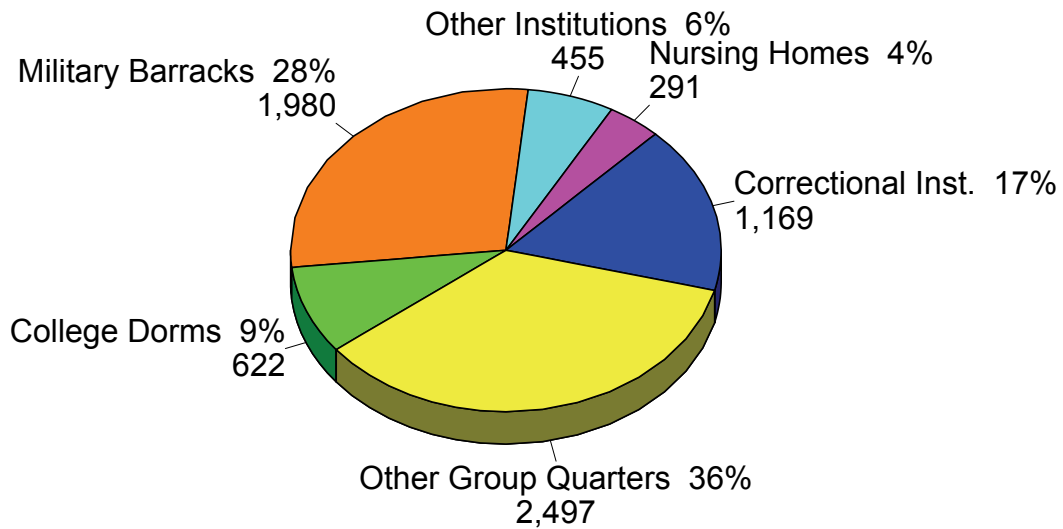

Anchorage - 2000

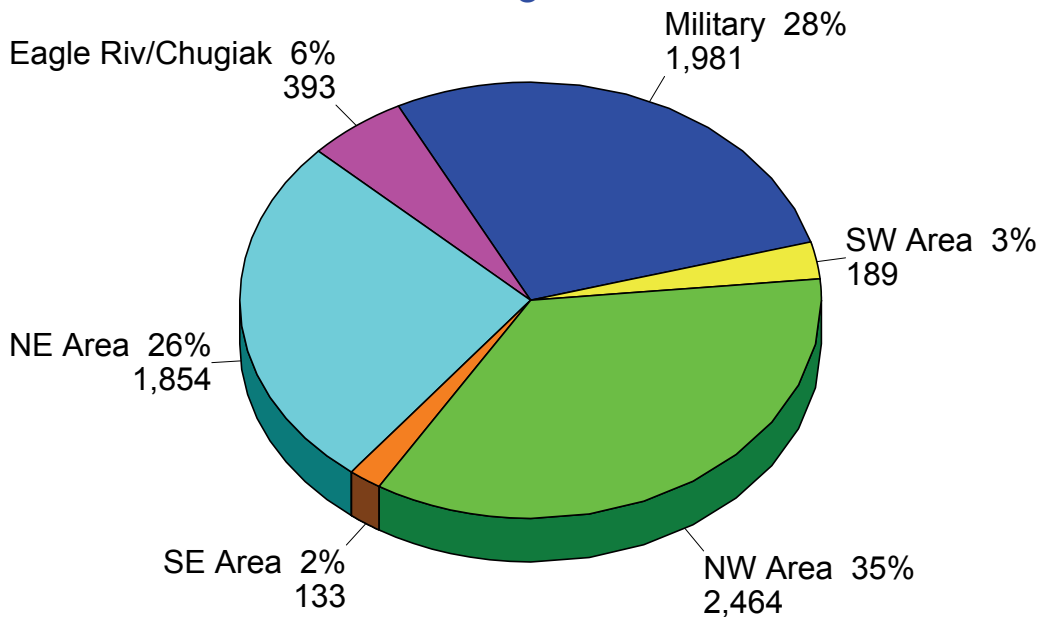

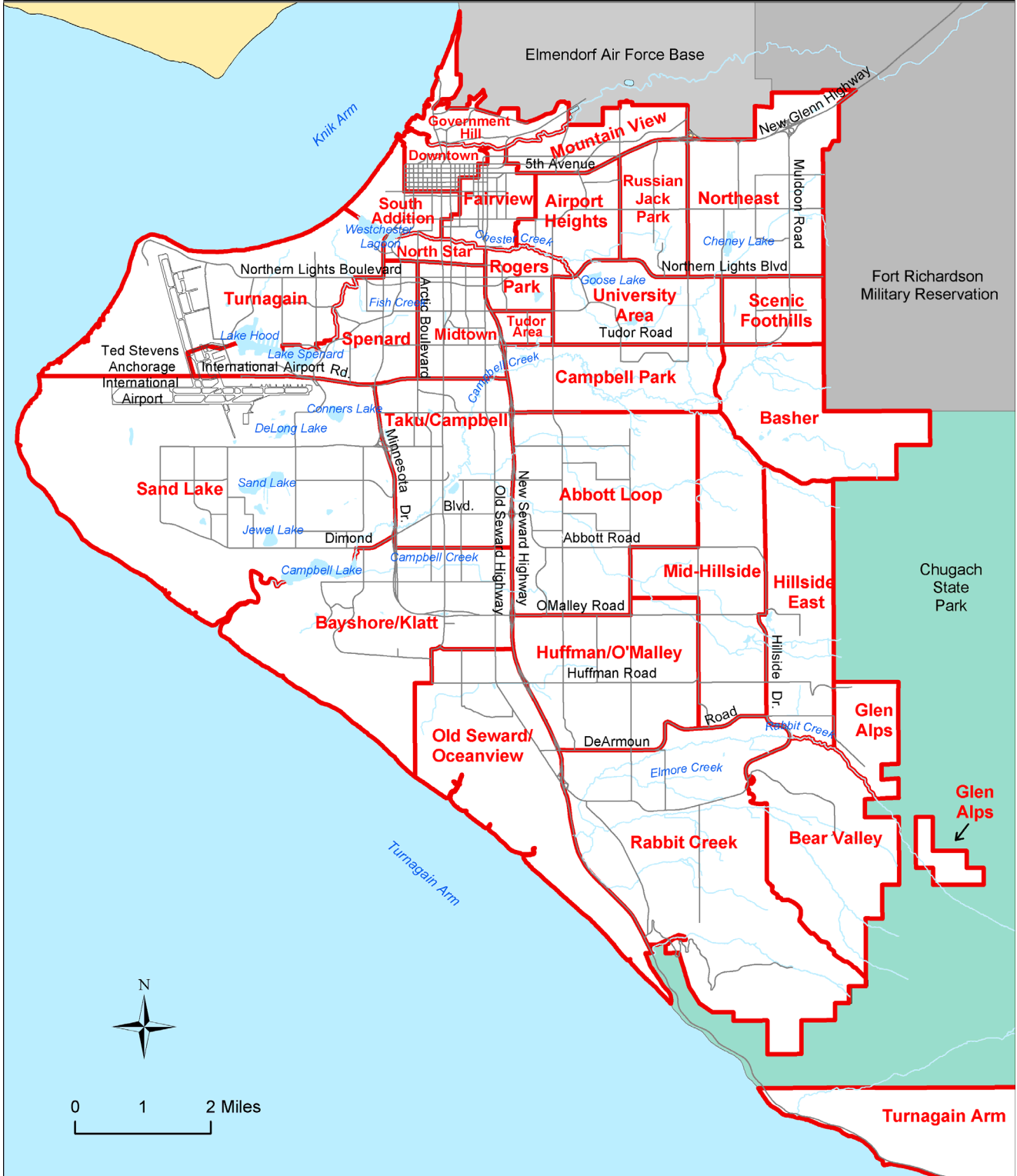

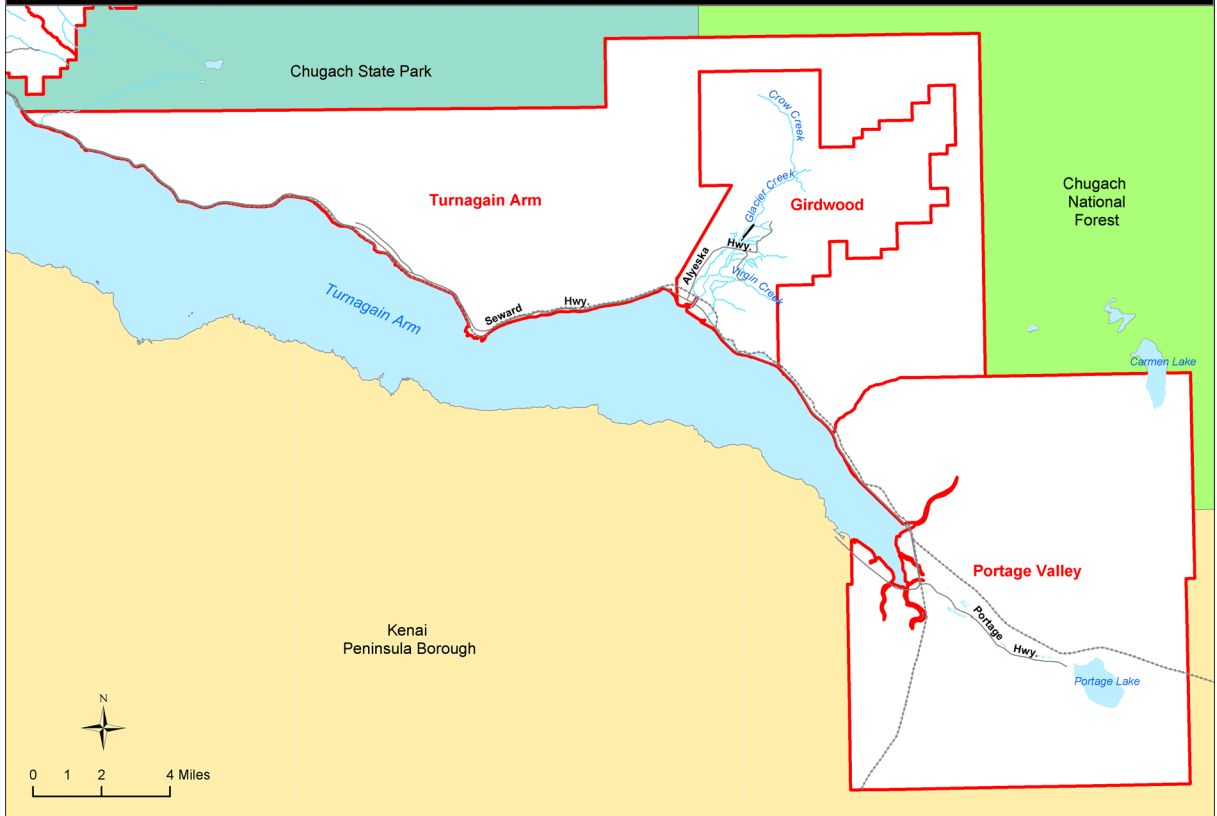

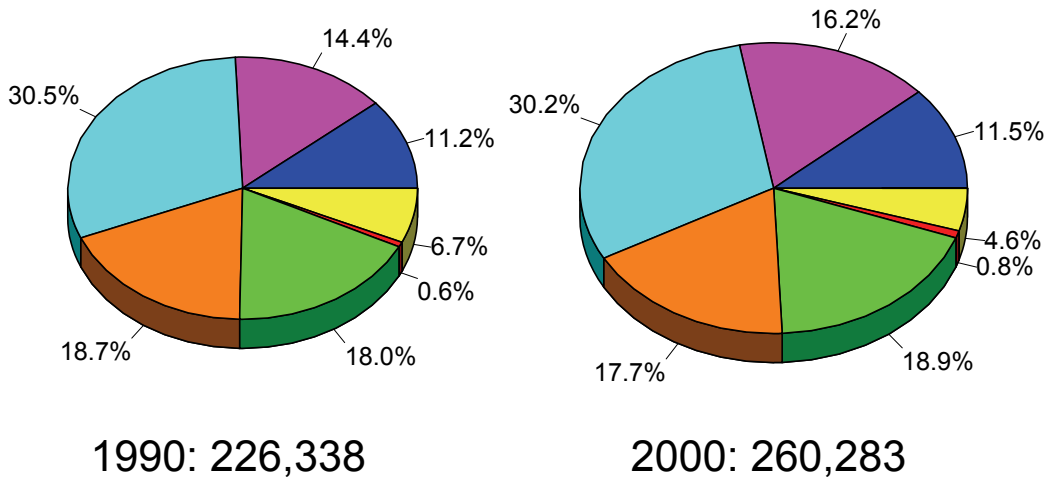

## %Anchorage Population by Sub-Area 1990 and 2000 Comparison

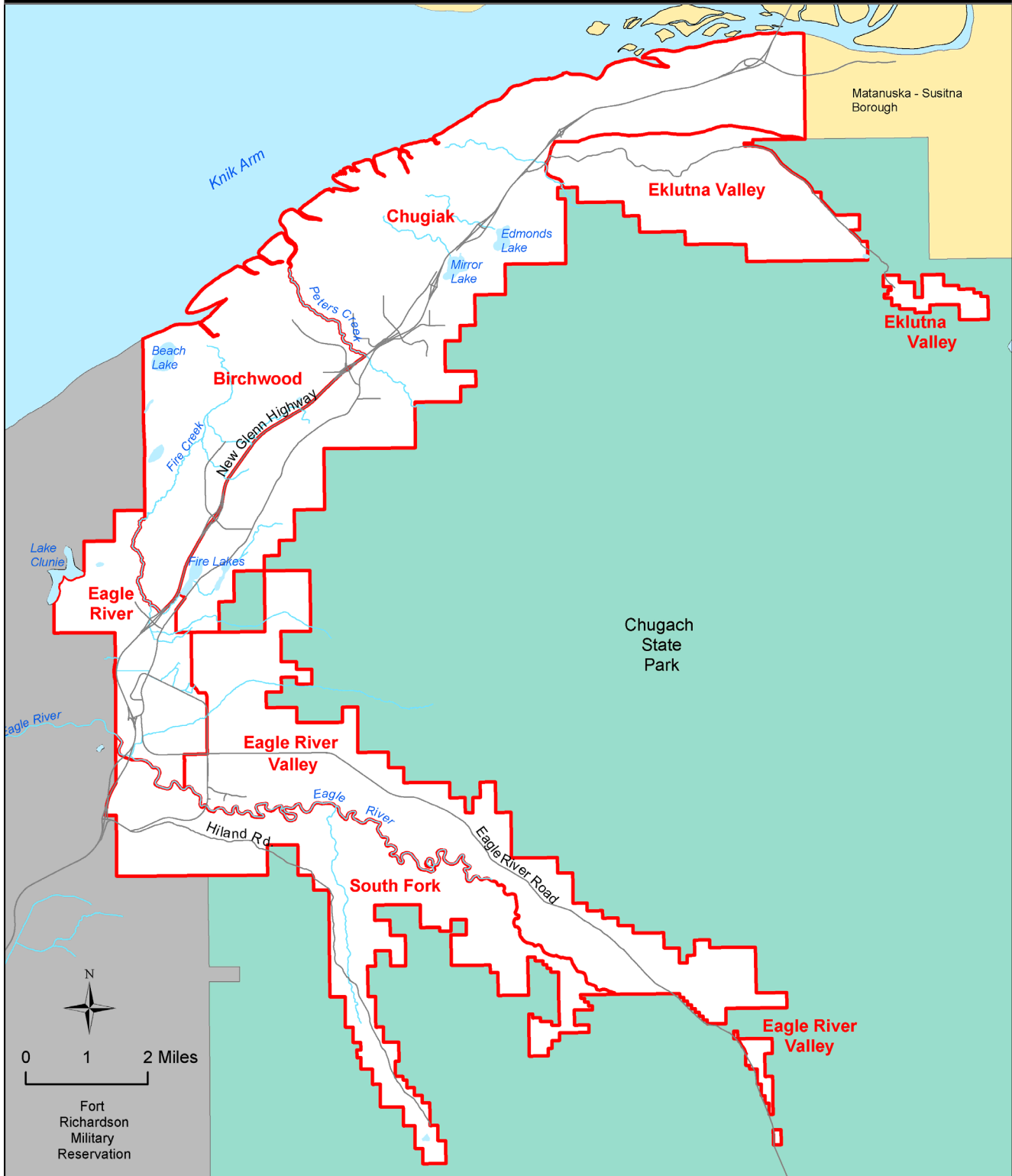

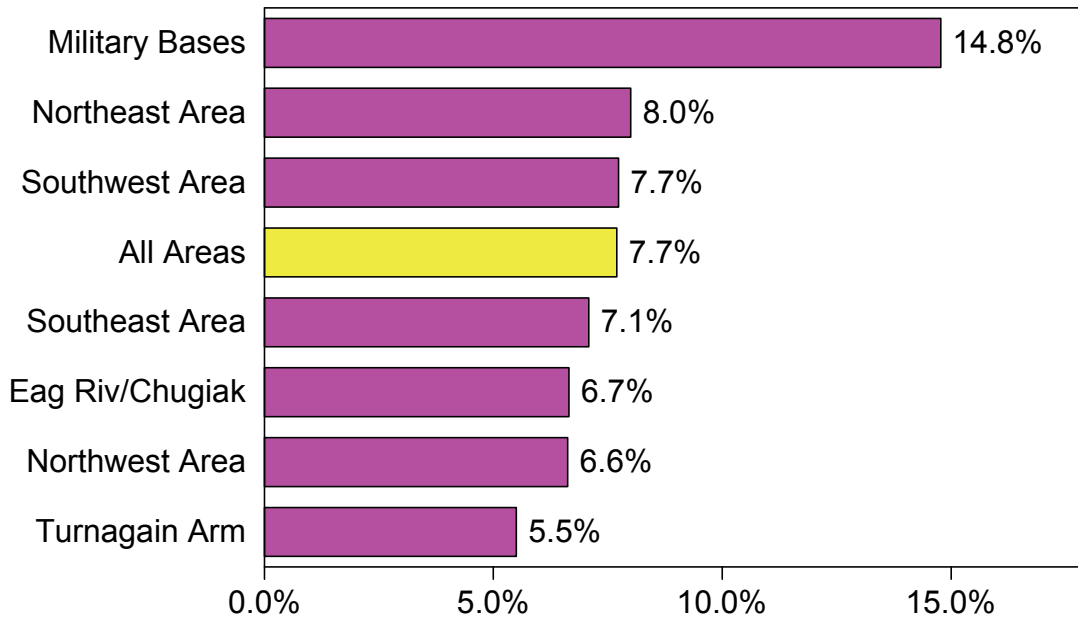

# % Pre-Schoolers (Under 5 Yrs.)

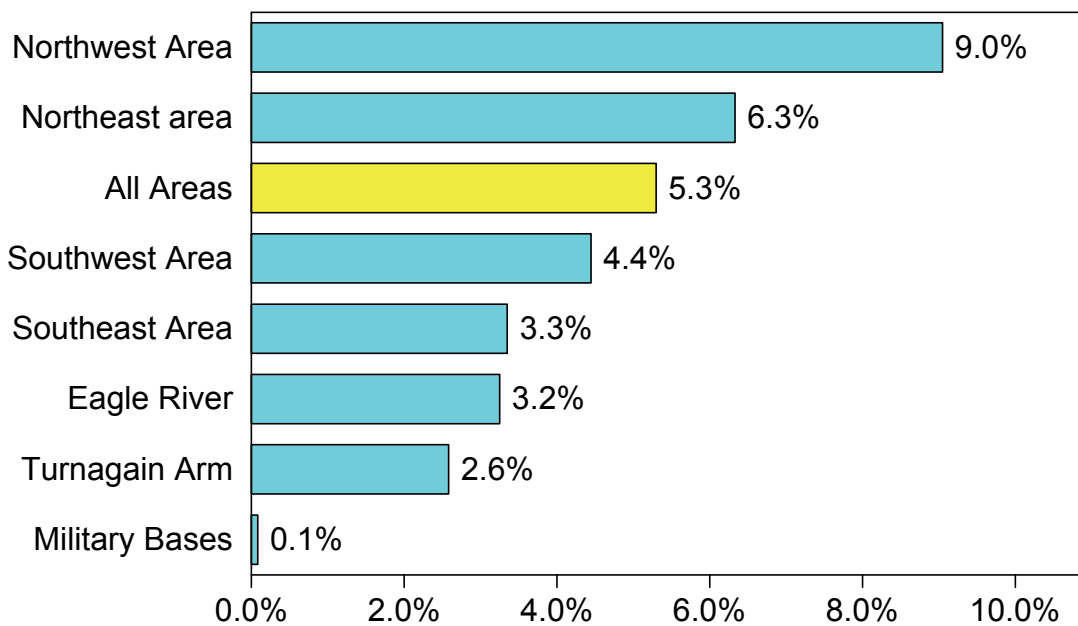
## Anchorage Sub-Areas - 2000

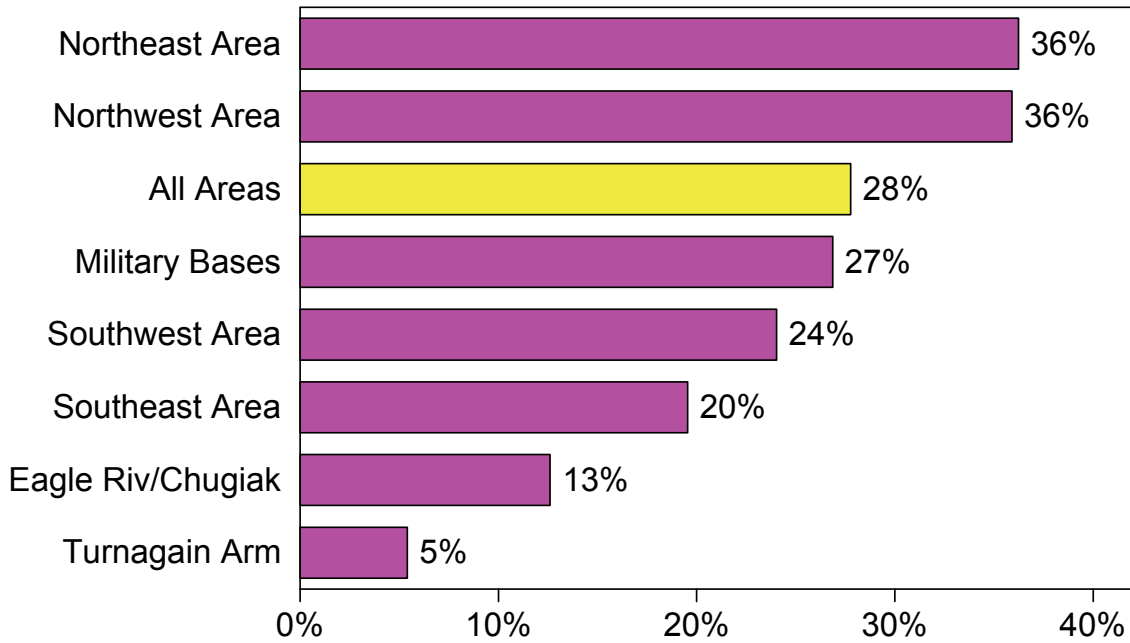

# % Minority Race Population

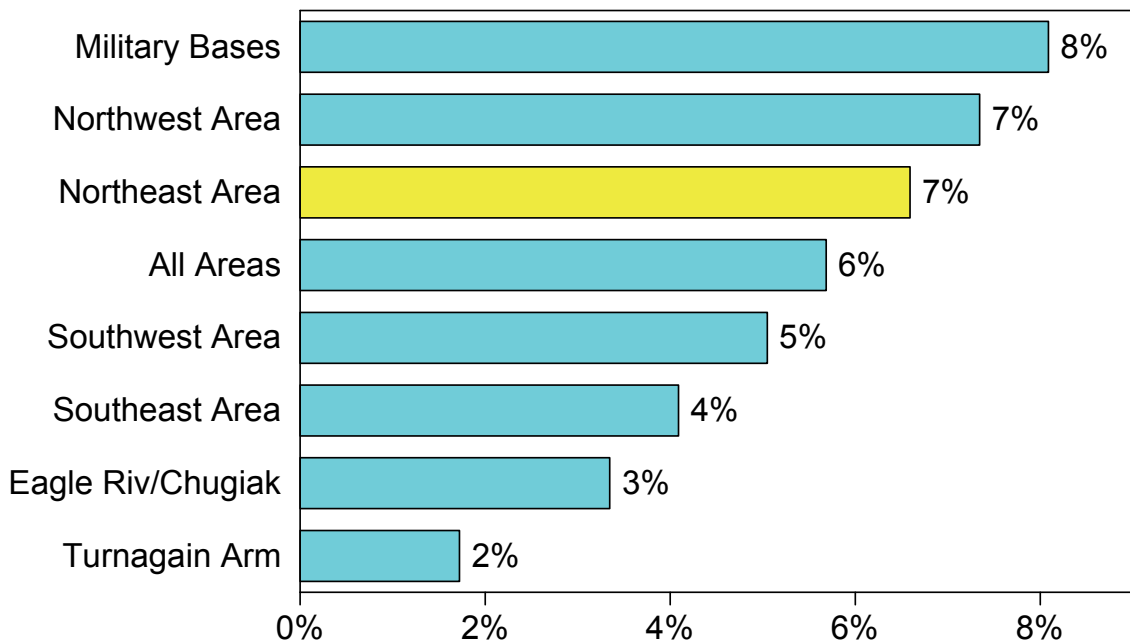
## Anchorage Sub-Areas - 2000

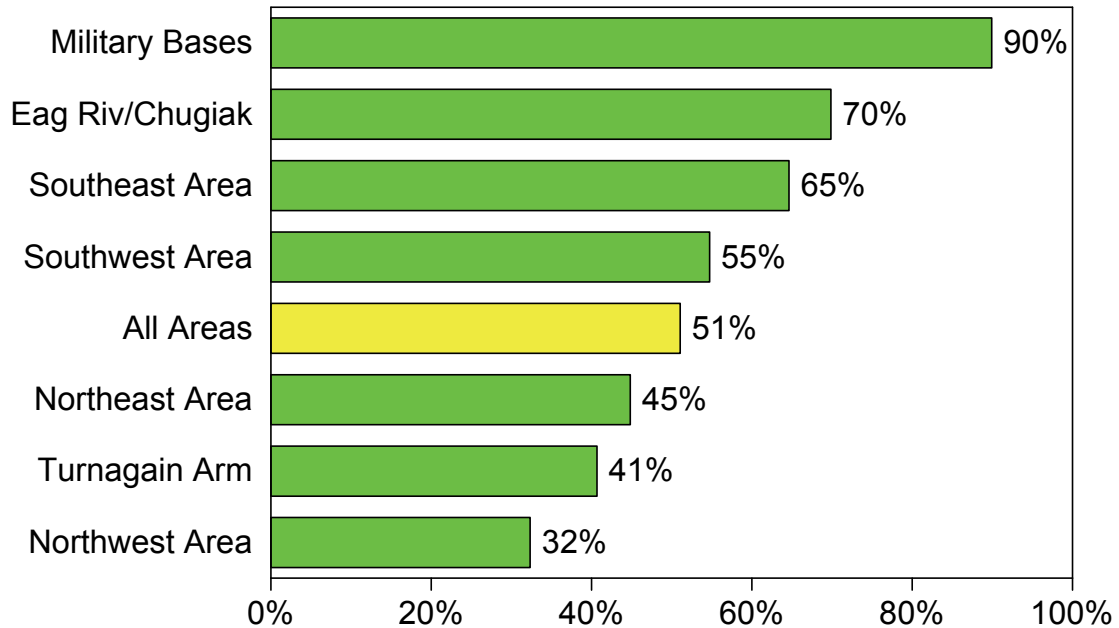

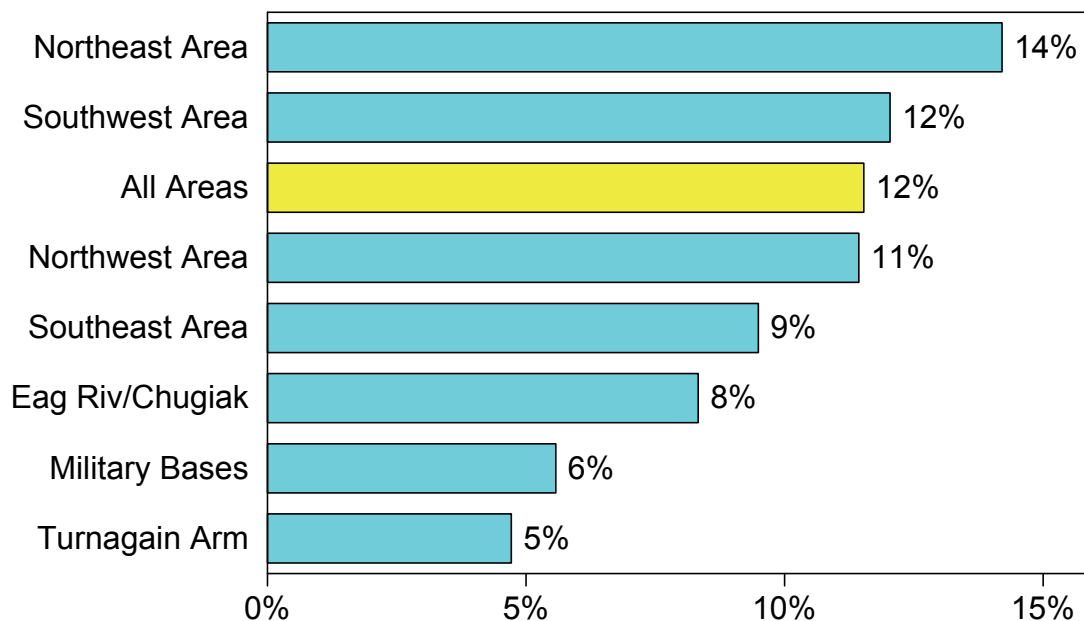

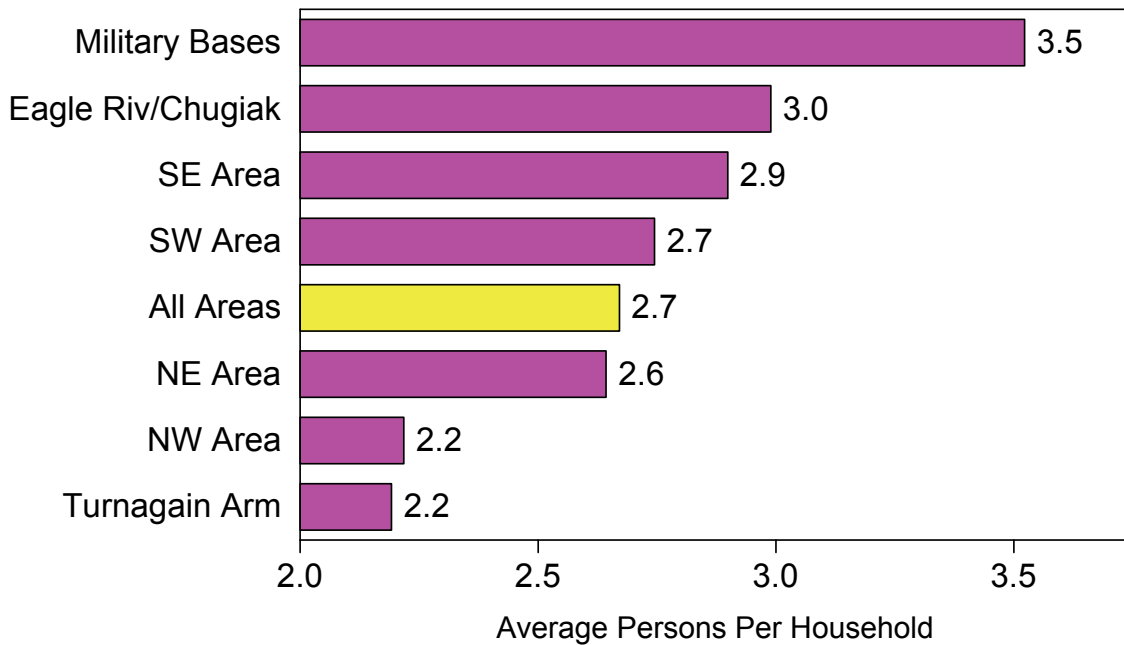

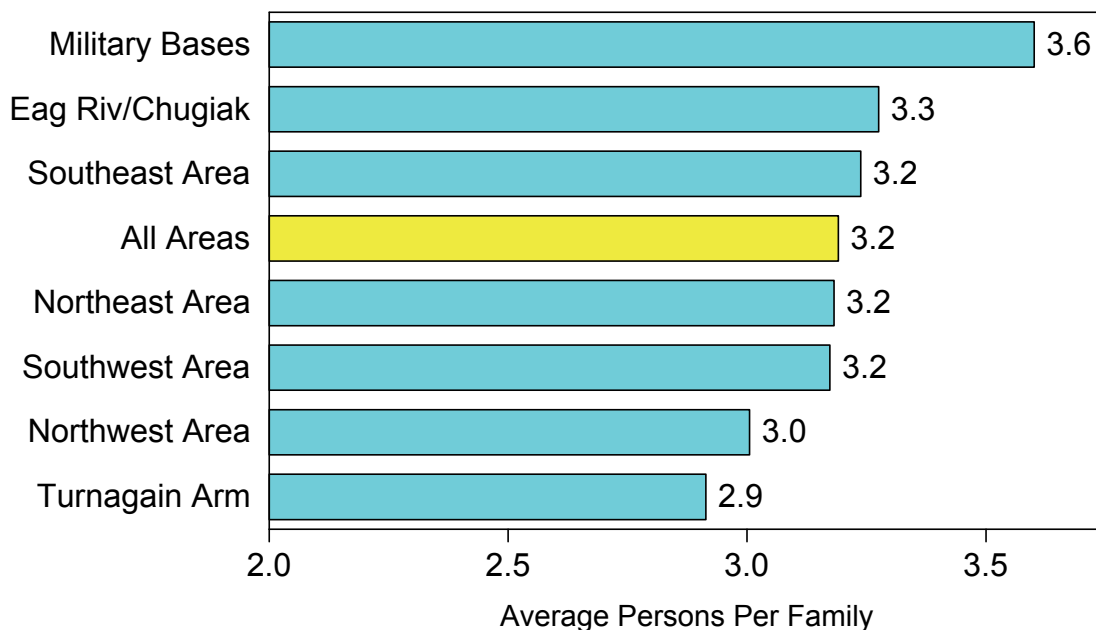

# Average Family Size

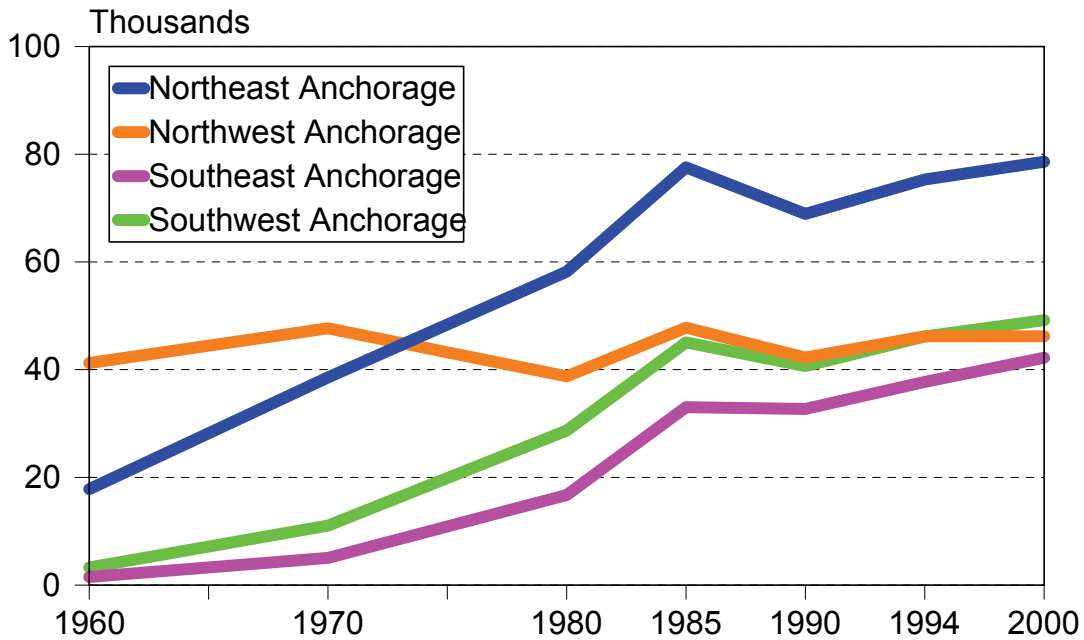

# Anchorage Bowl Population

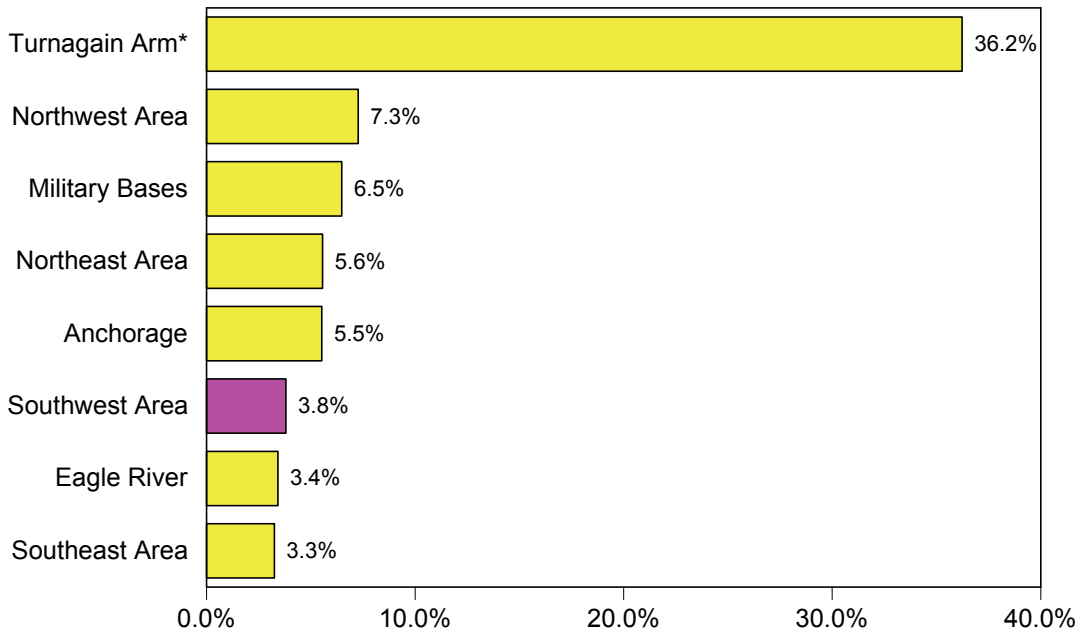
## By Sub-Area 1960 - 2000

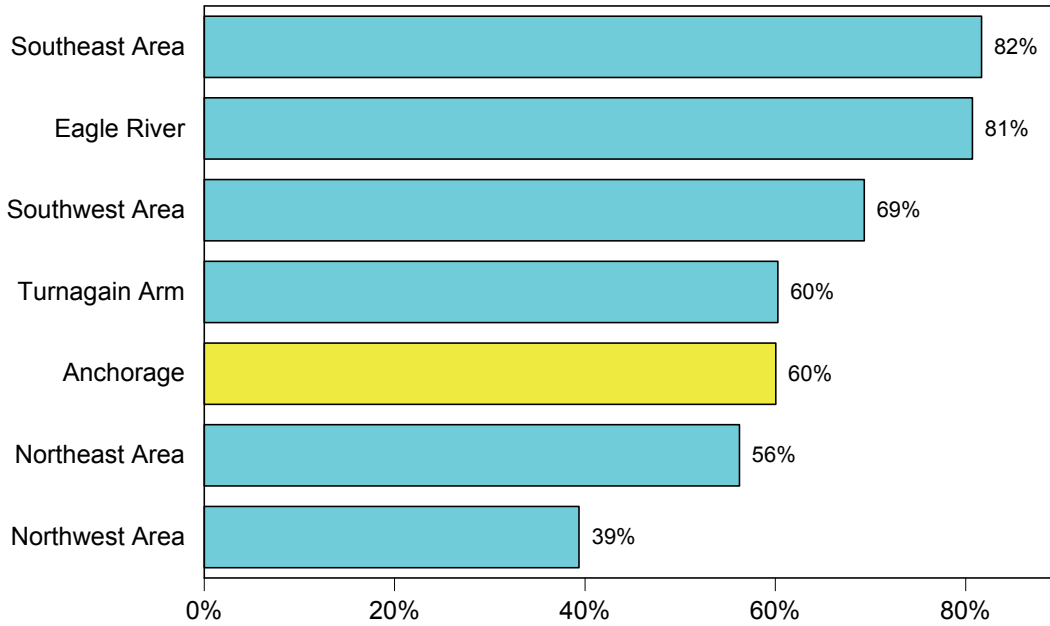

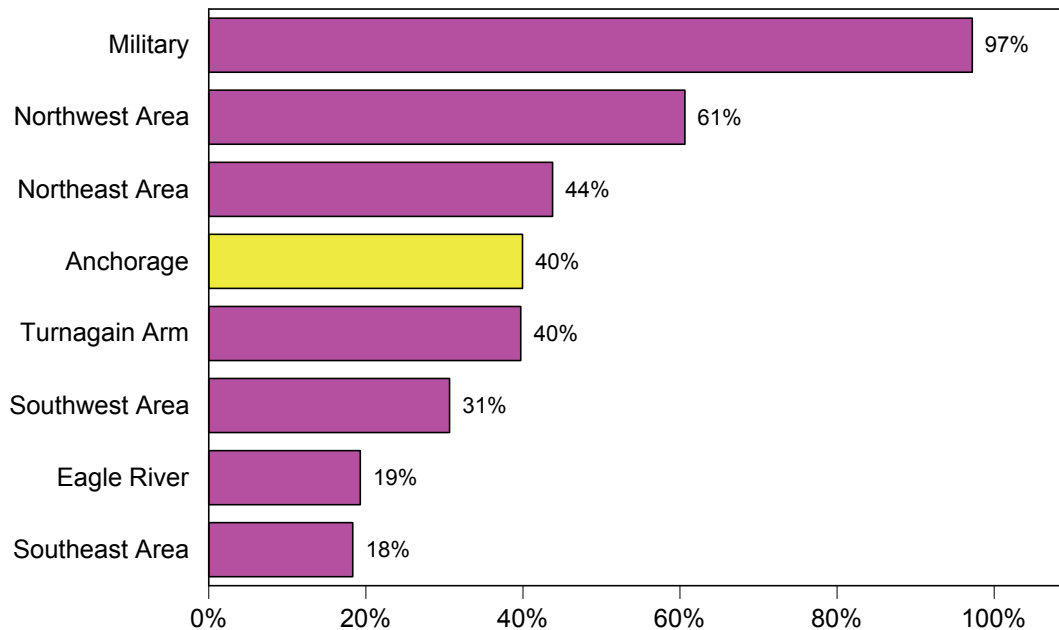

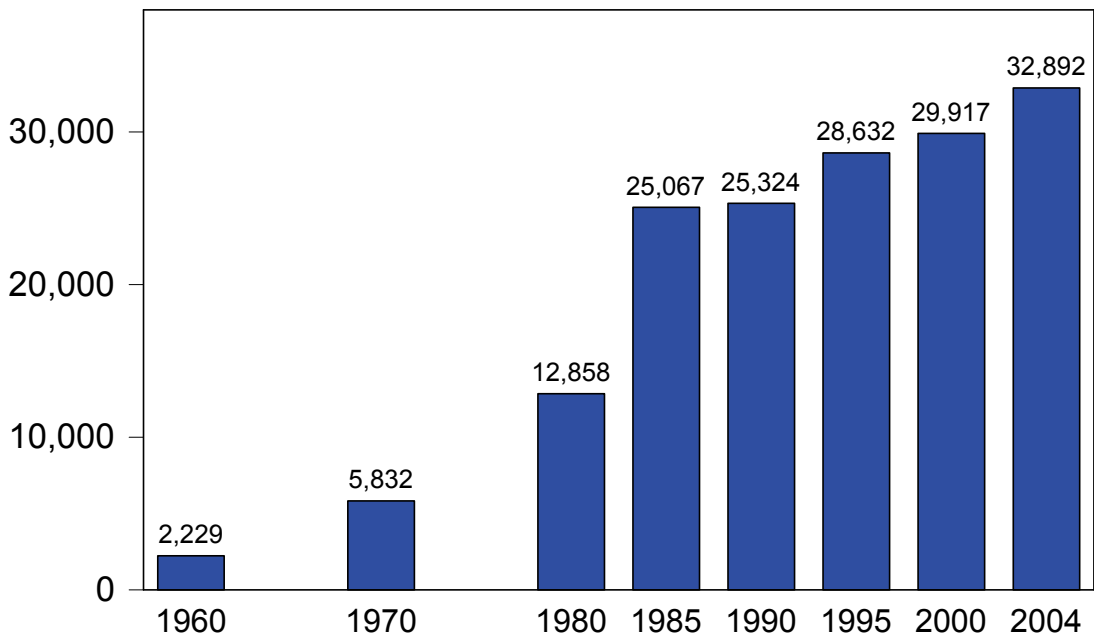

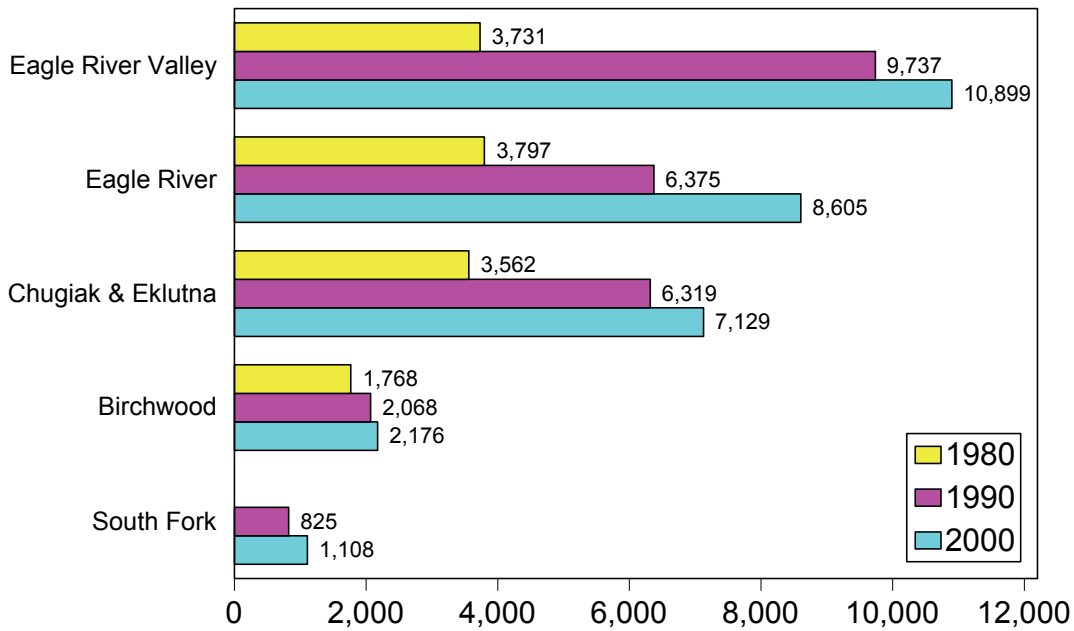
### Eagle River/Chugiak Population 1960 - 2004

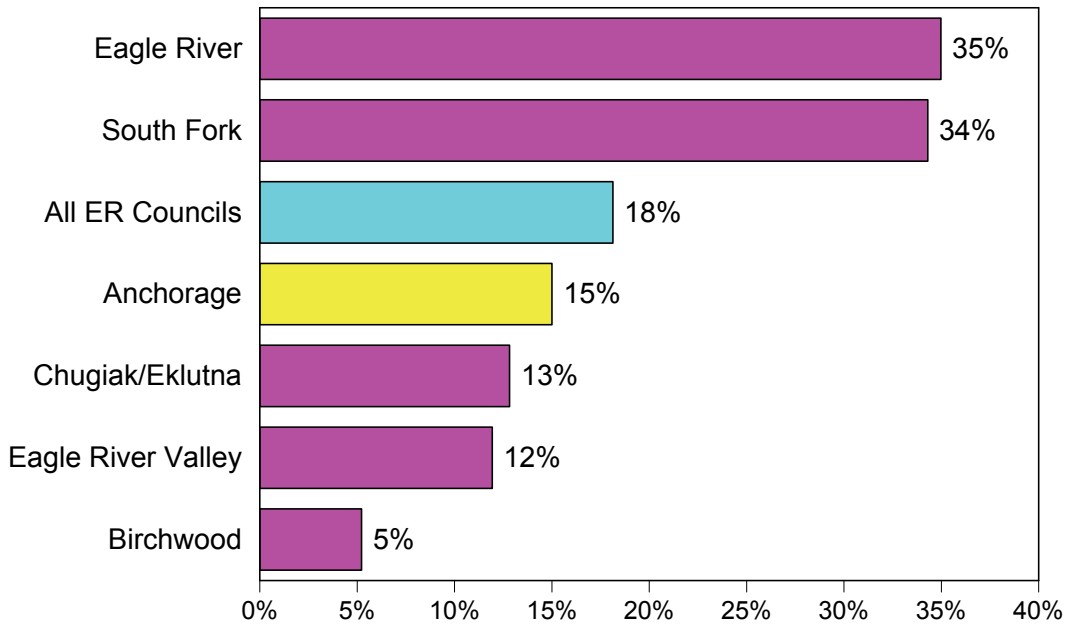
## Eagle River Community Councils - 1980-2000\*

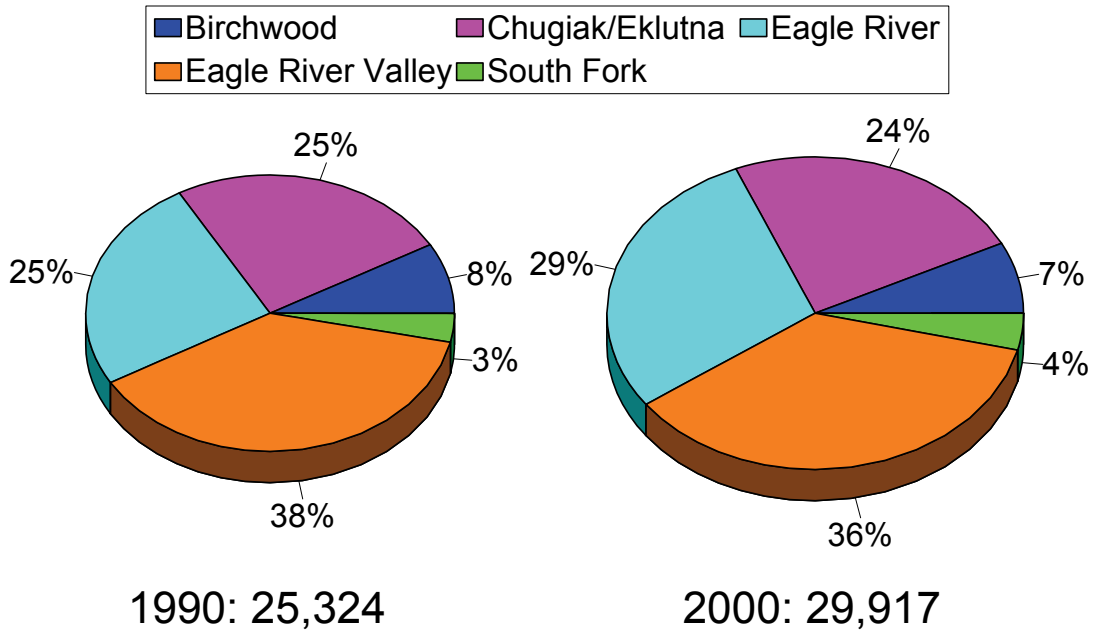
## Eagle River - 1990-2000\*

# %Eagle River Population by Council

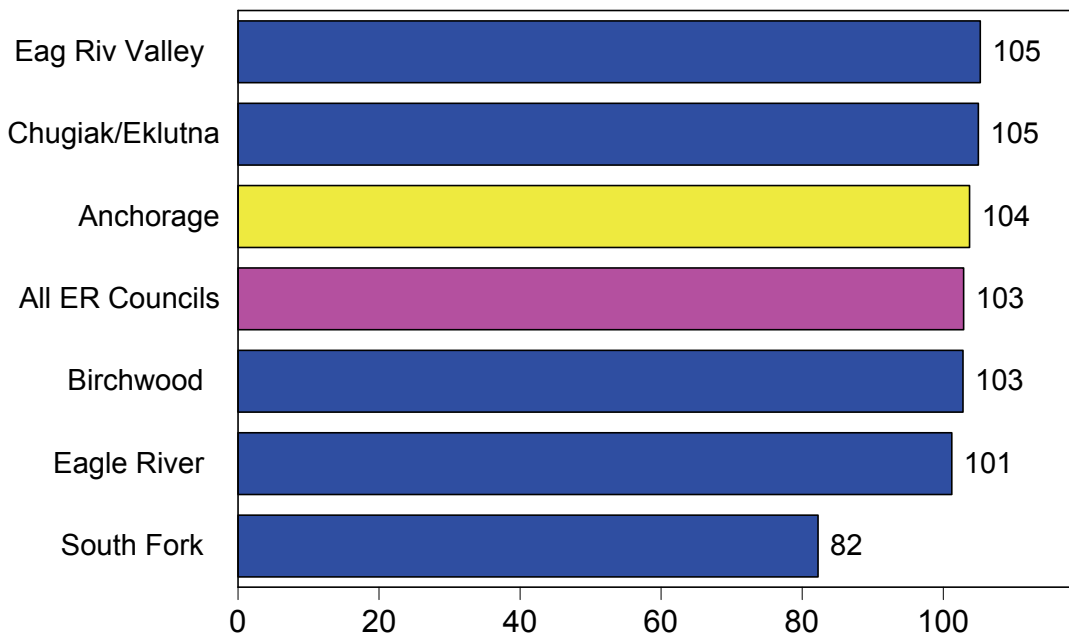
## 1990 and 2000 Comparison

# Males Per 100 Females

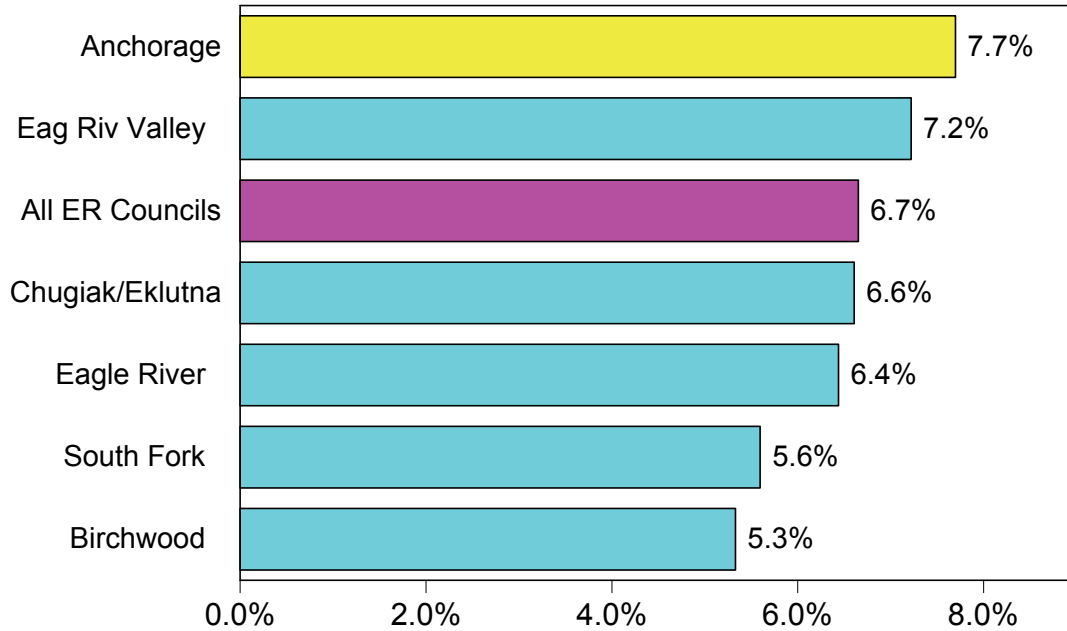

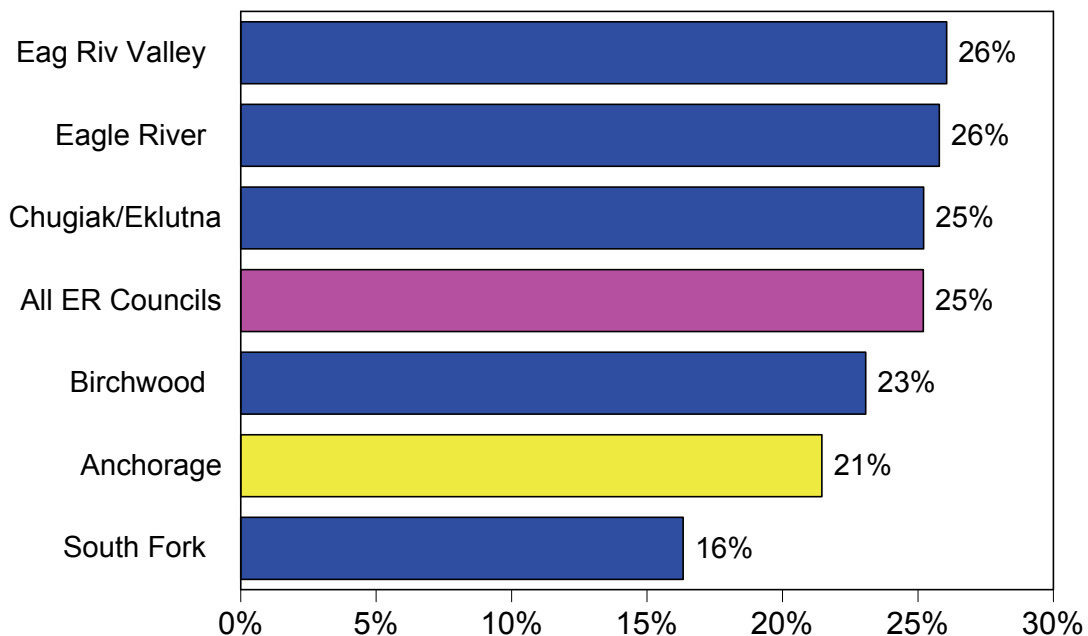

# % School Age (5-17 Years)

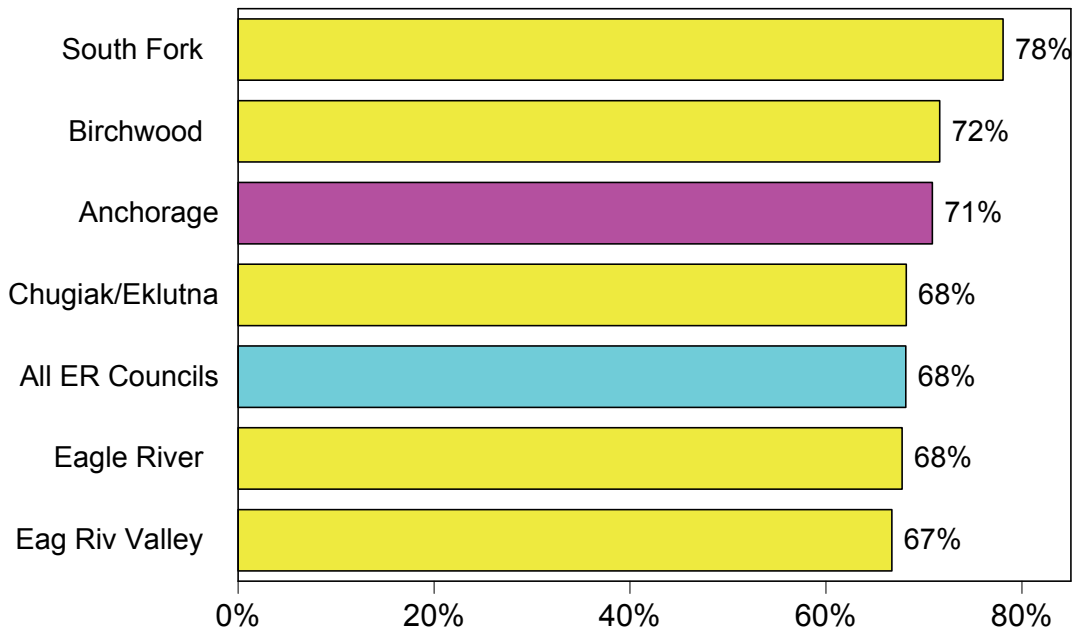

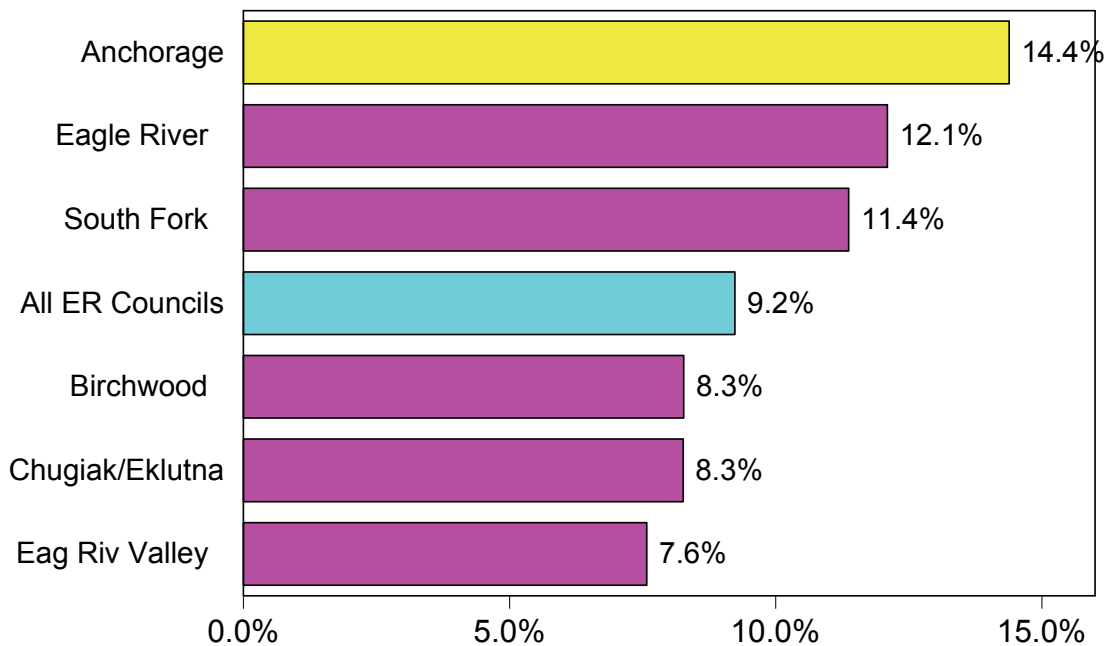

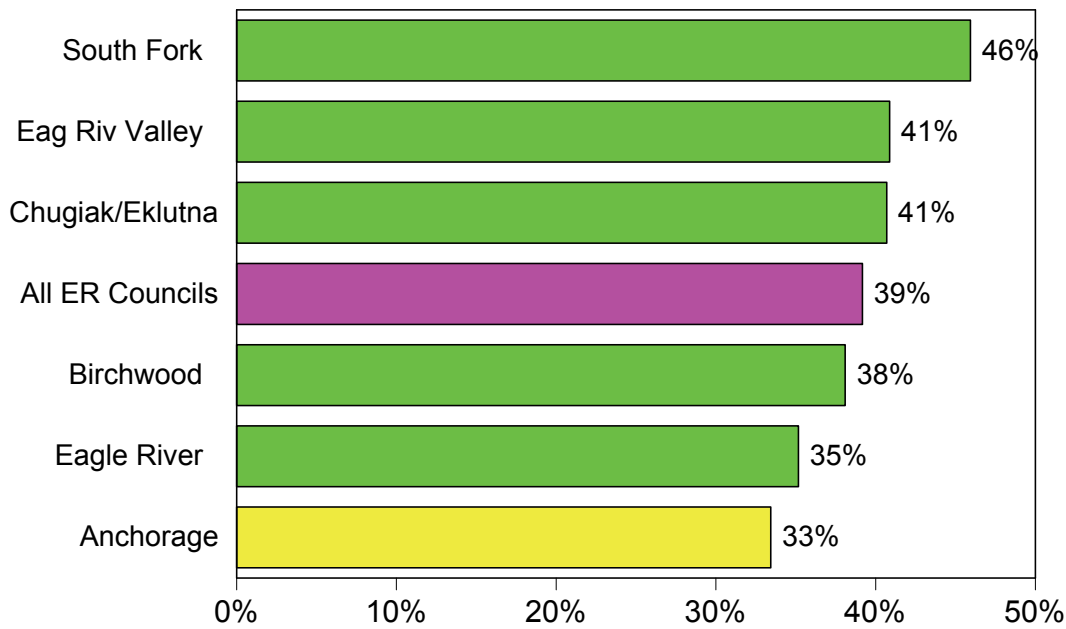

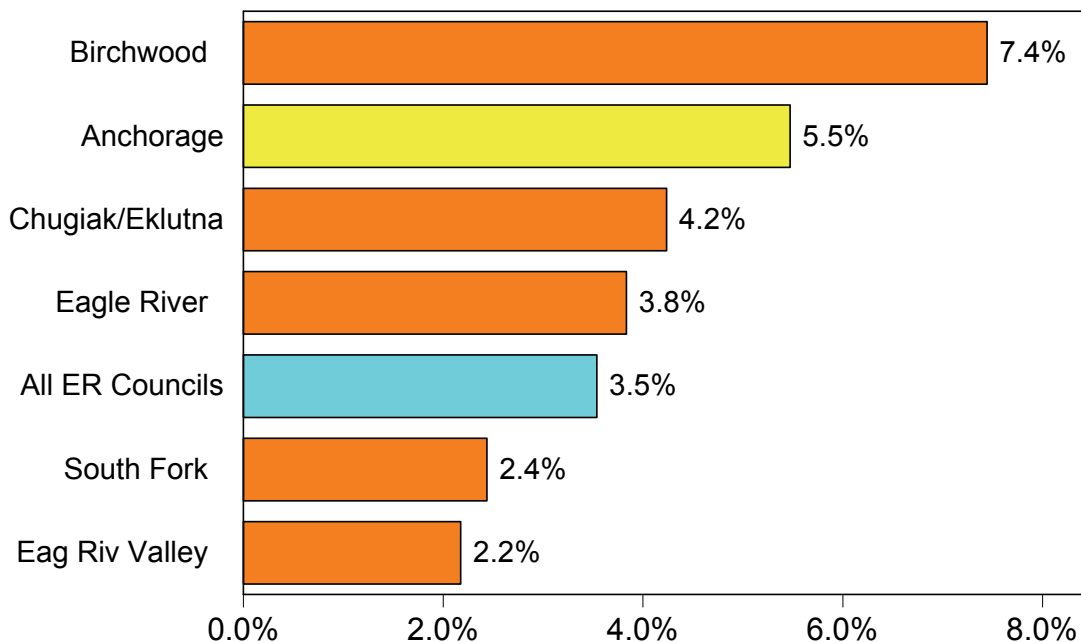

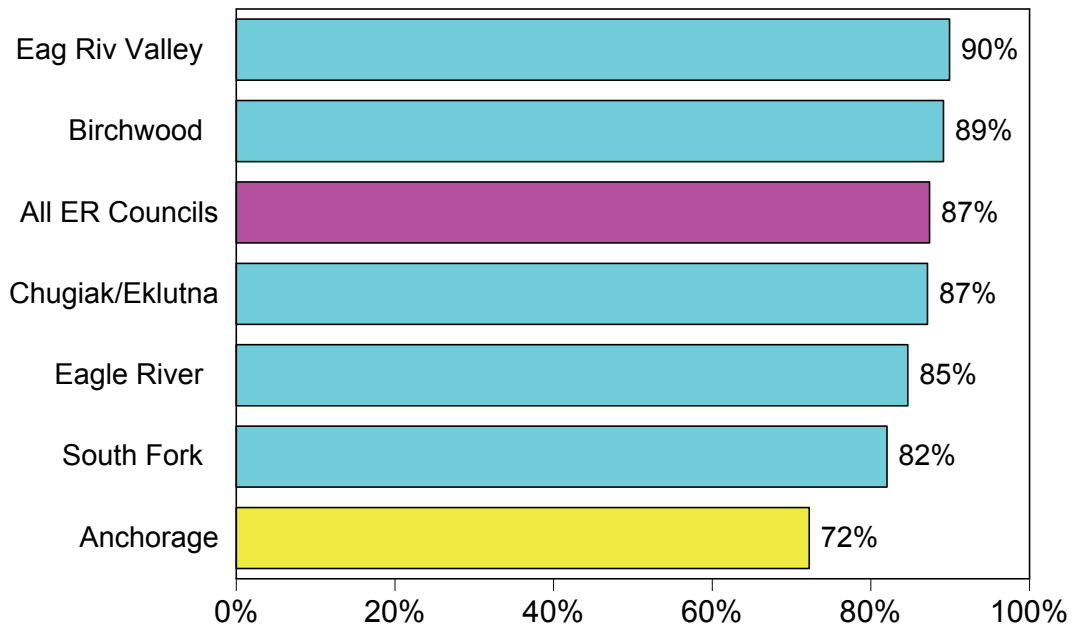

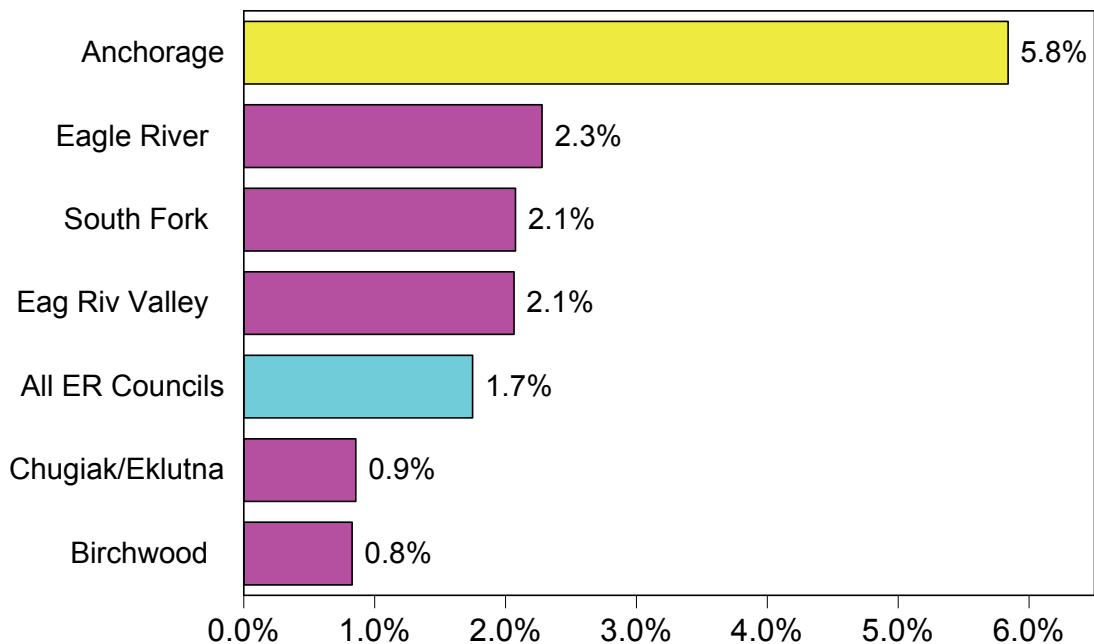

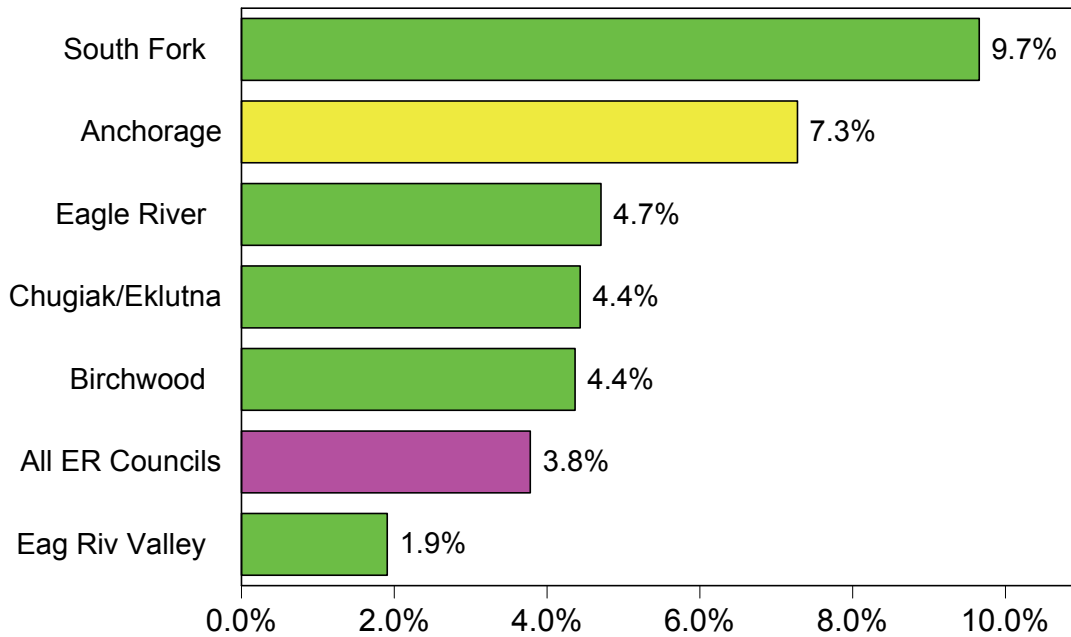

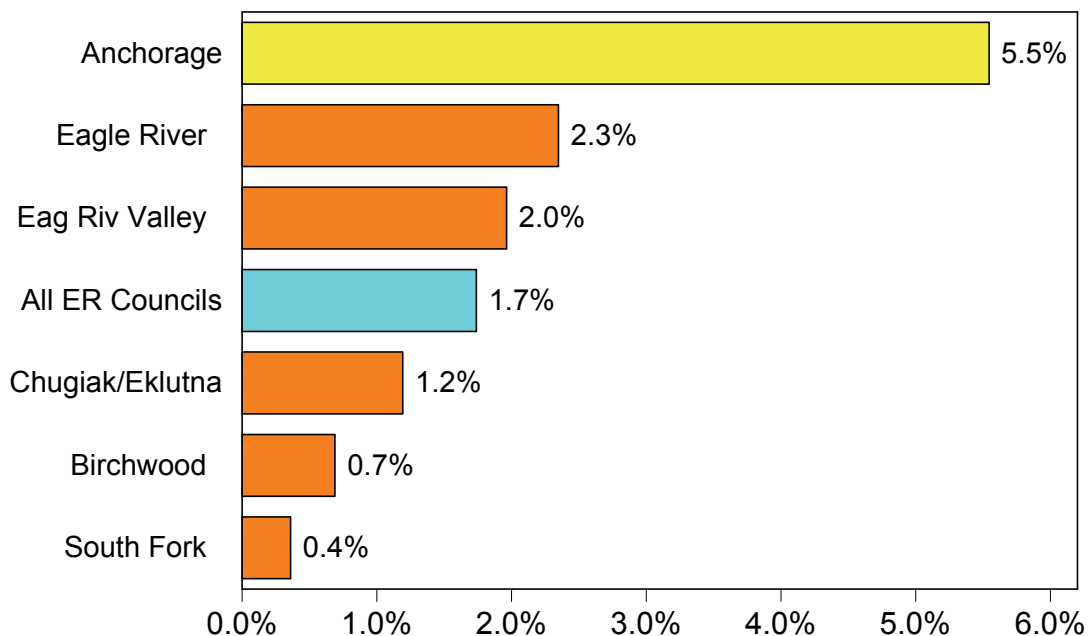

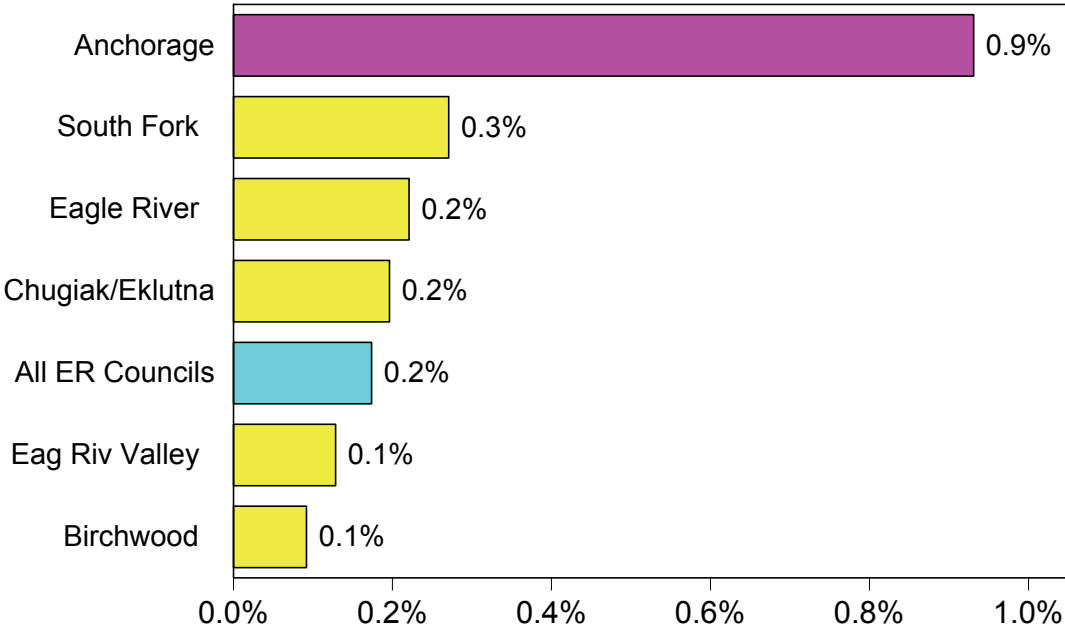

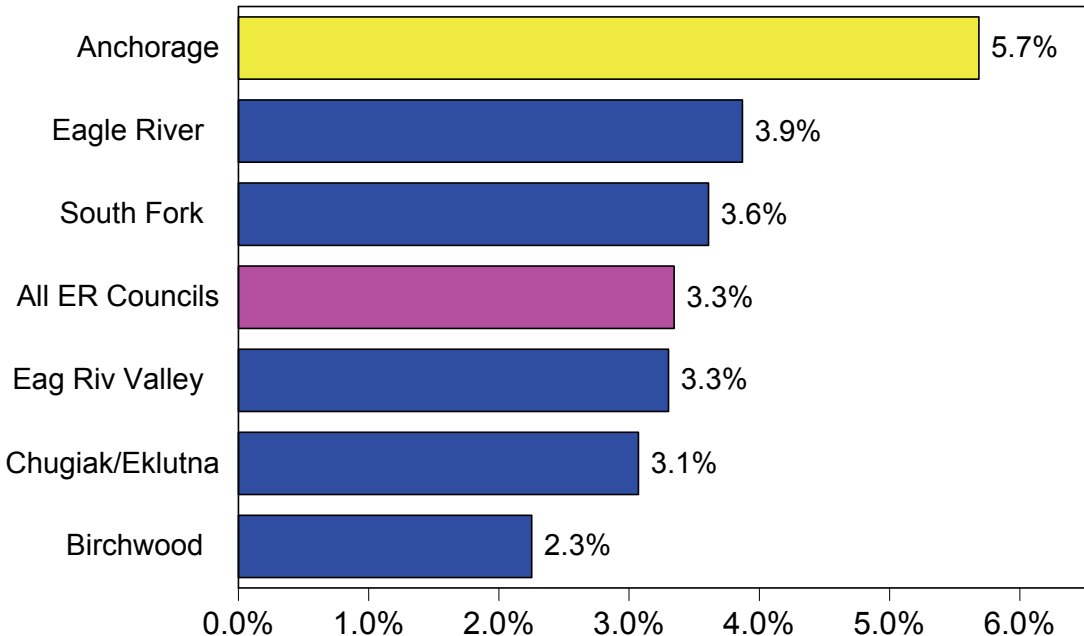

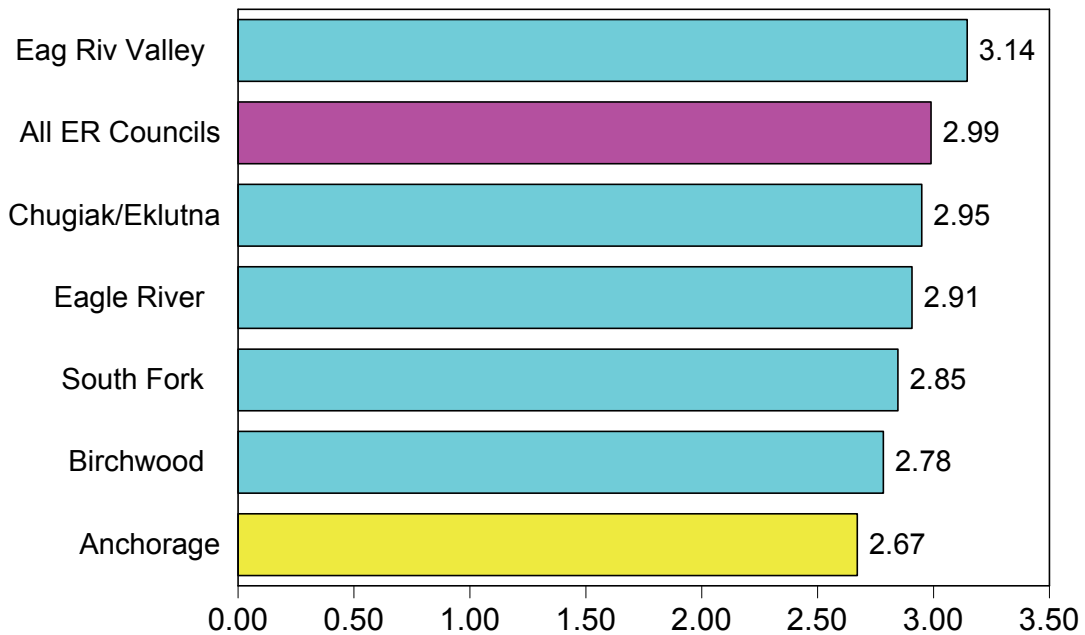

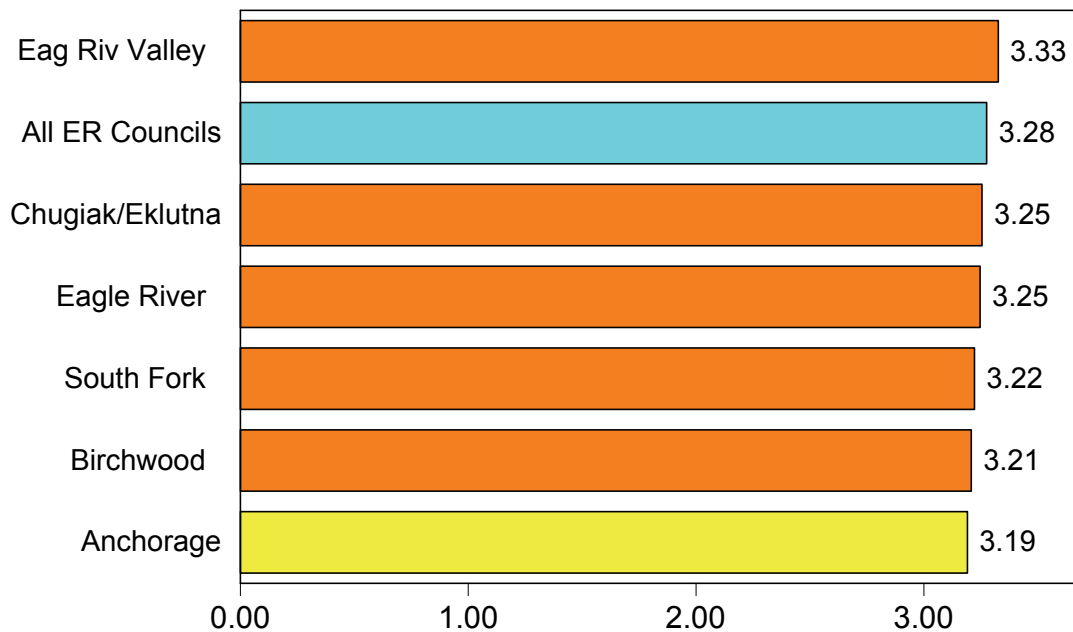

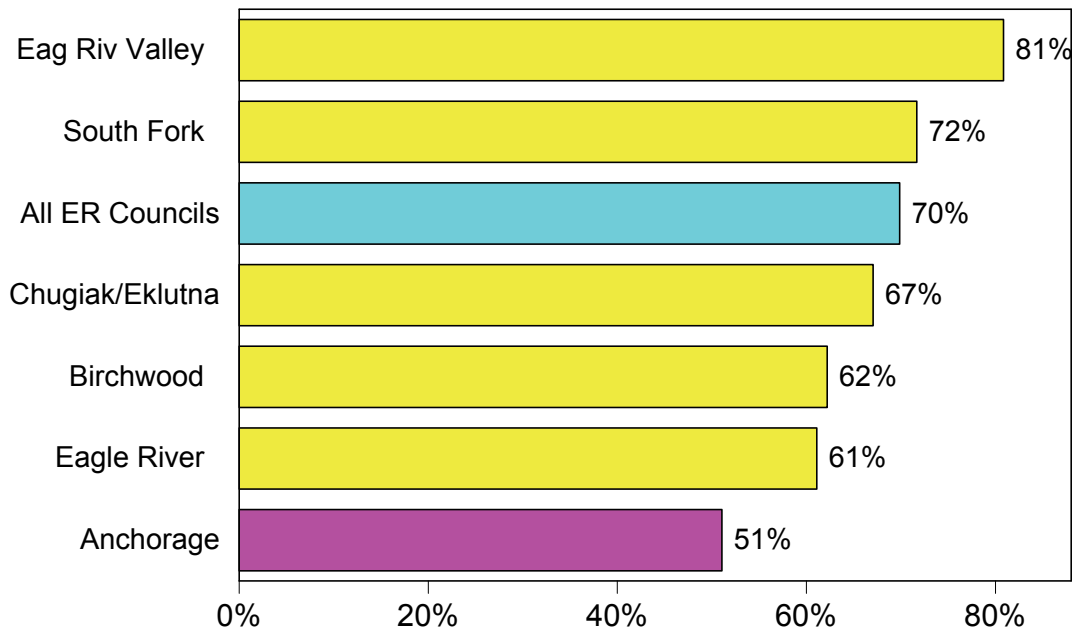

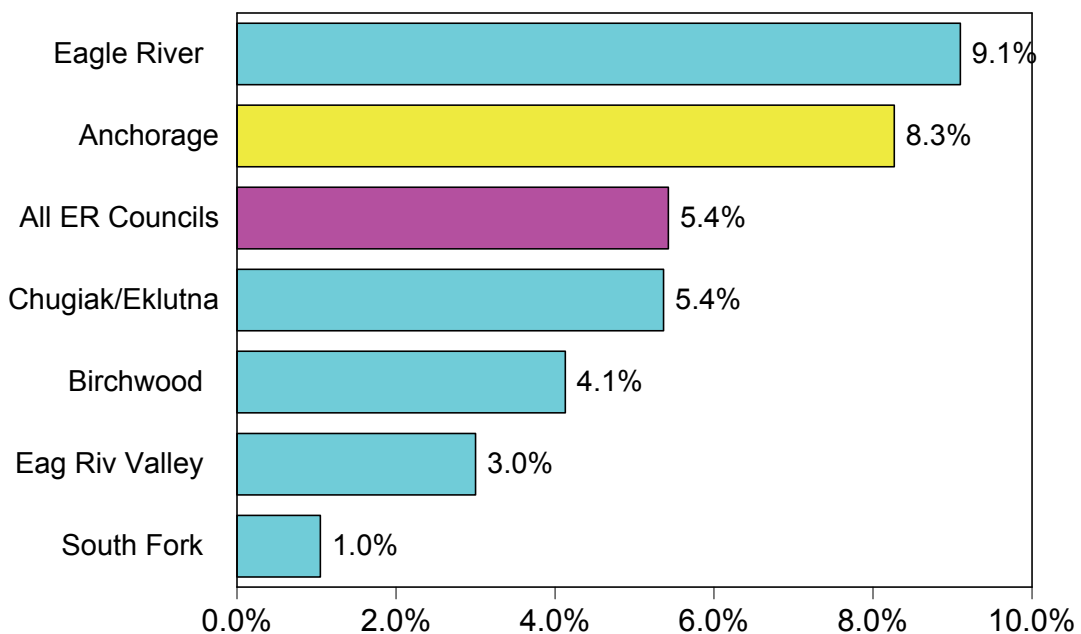

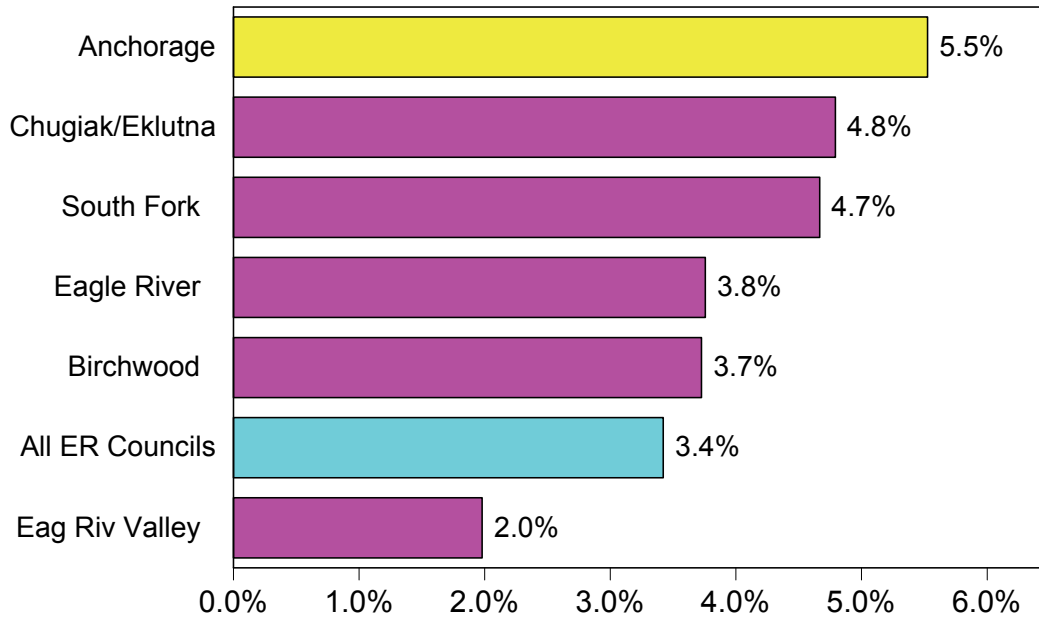

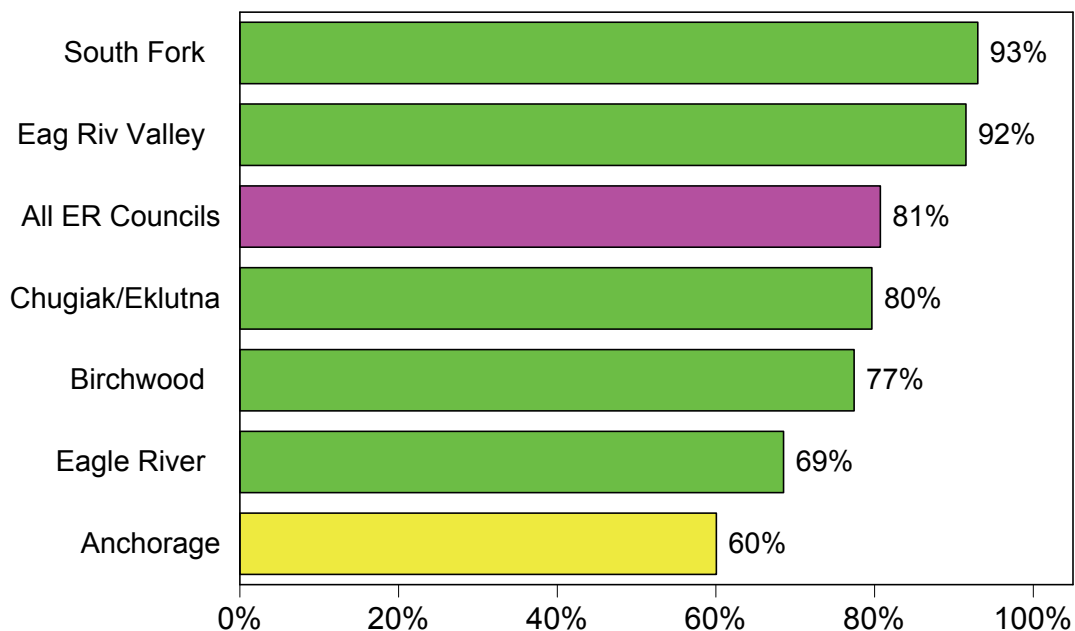

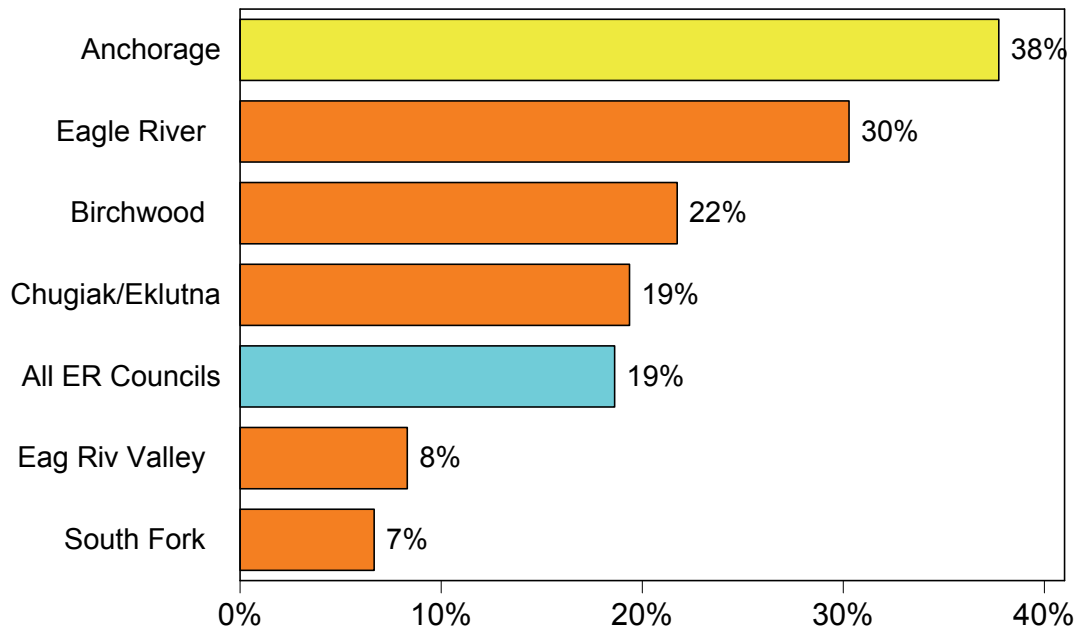

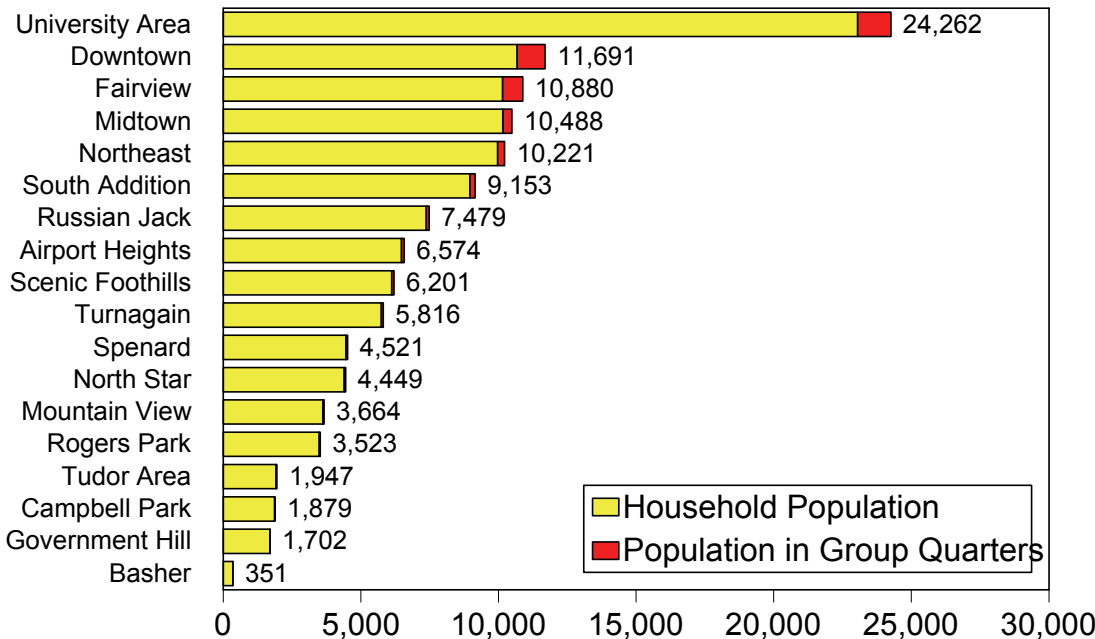

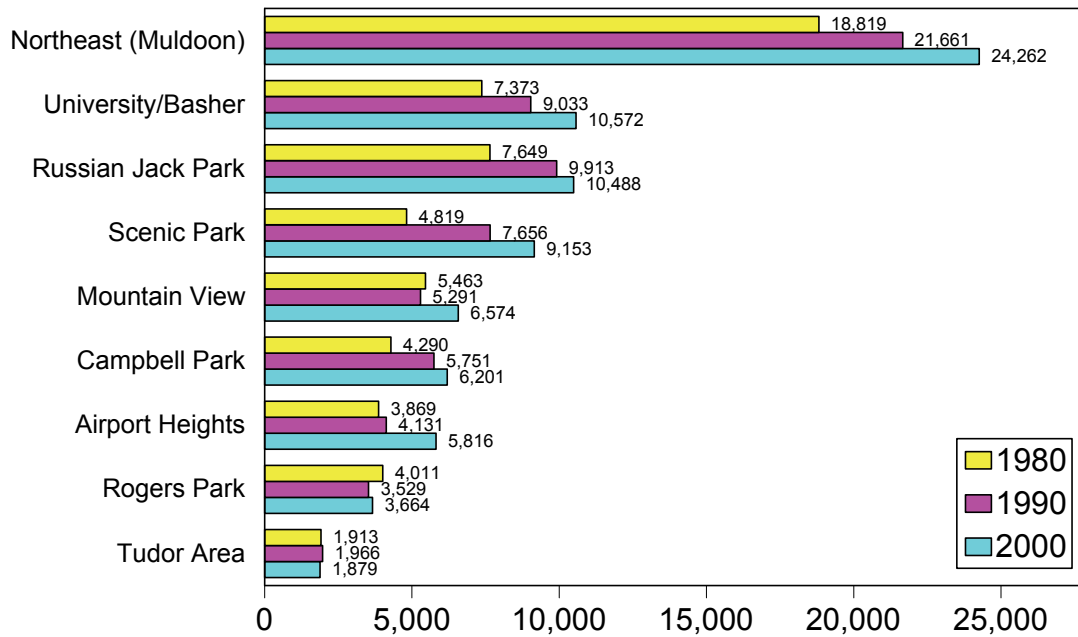

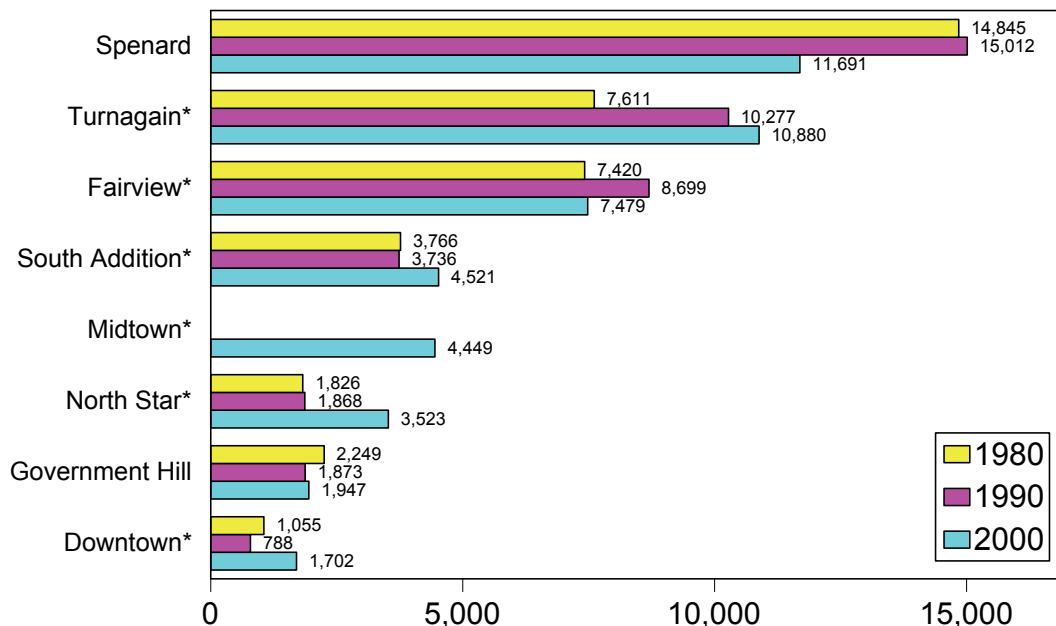
## Northeast Community Councils - 1980-2000

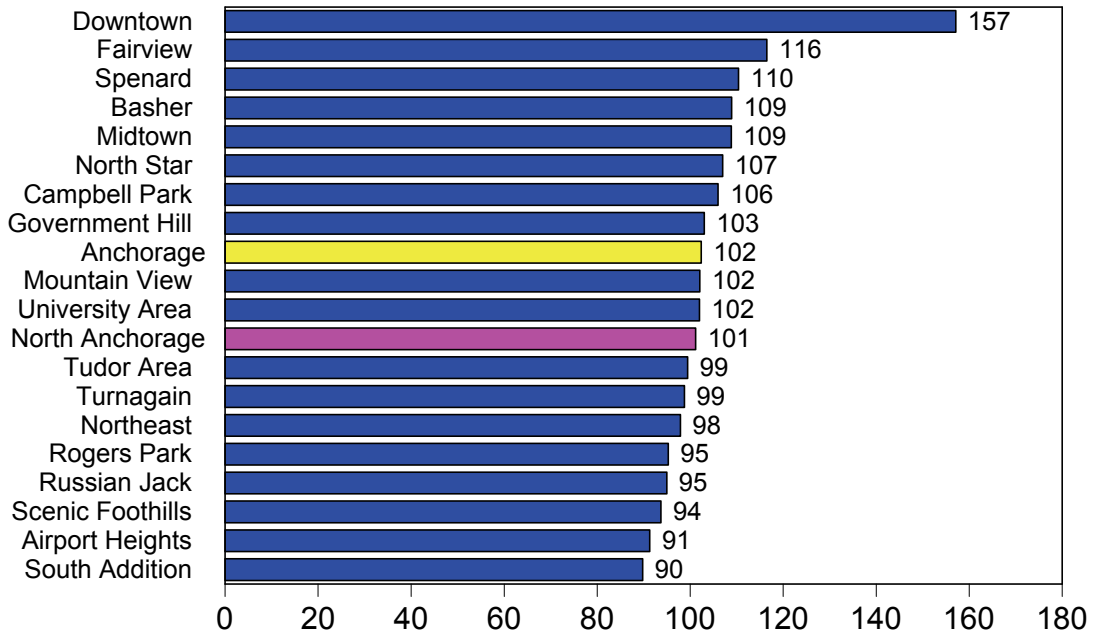
## Northwest Community Councils - 1980-2000

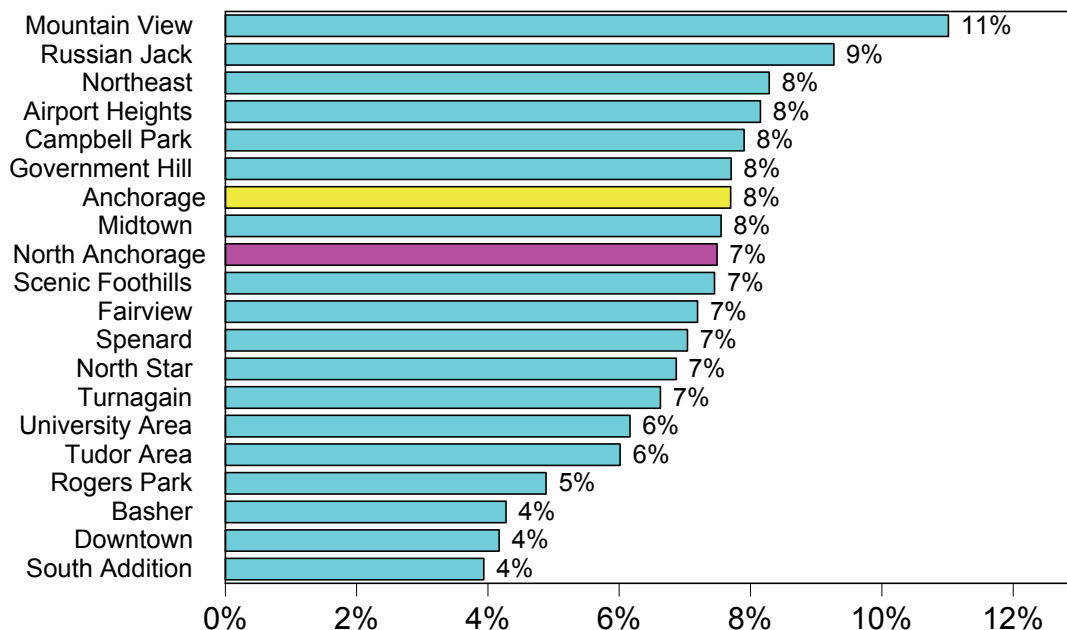

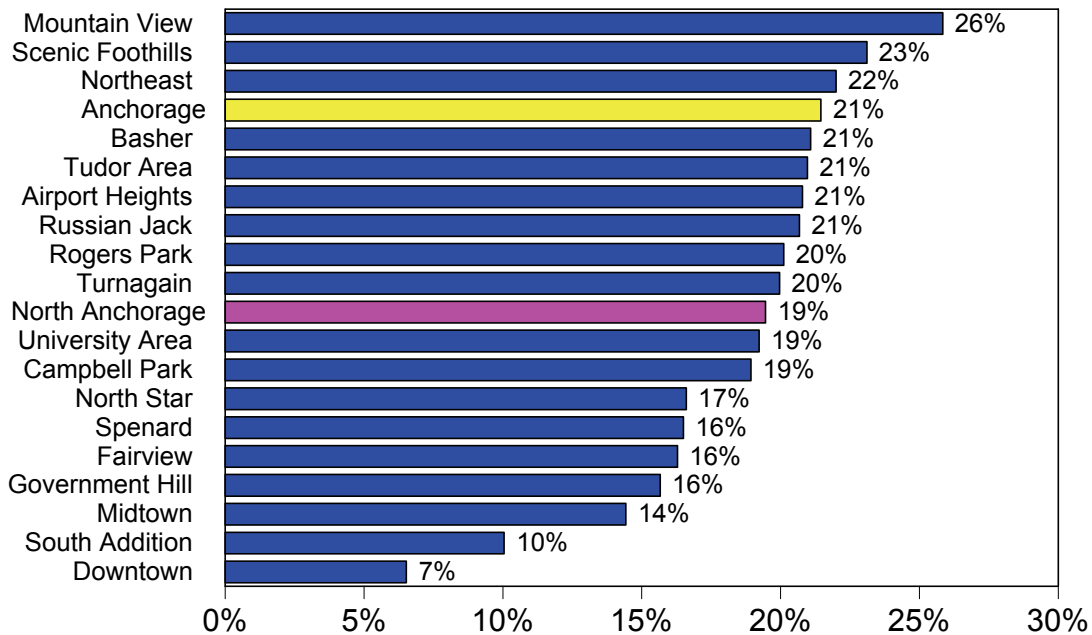

# % School Age (5-17 Years)

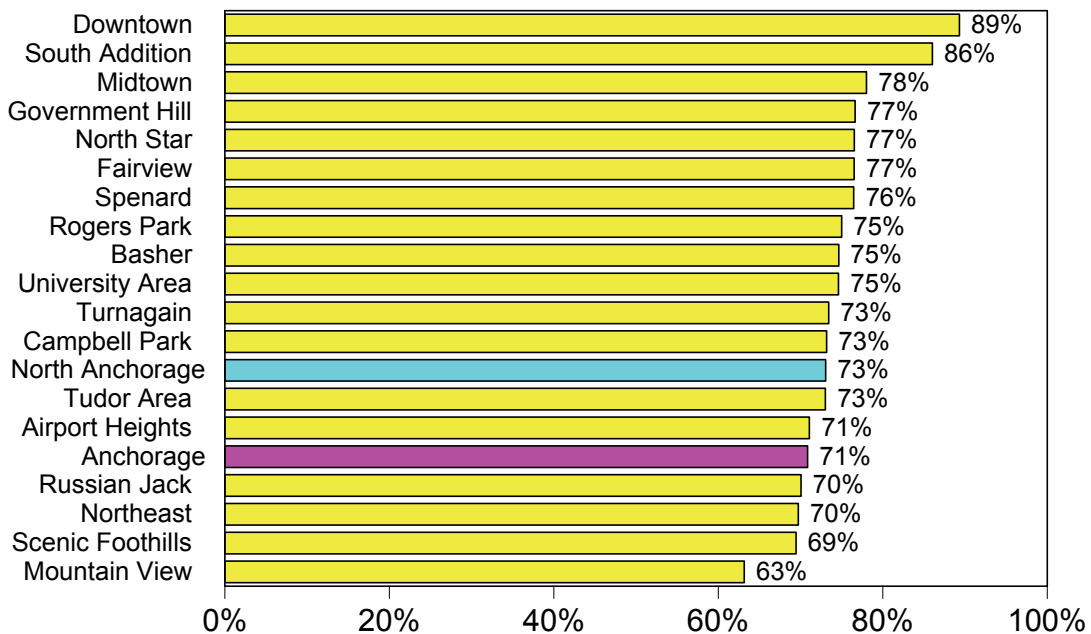

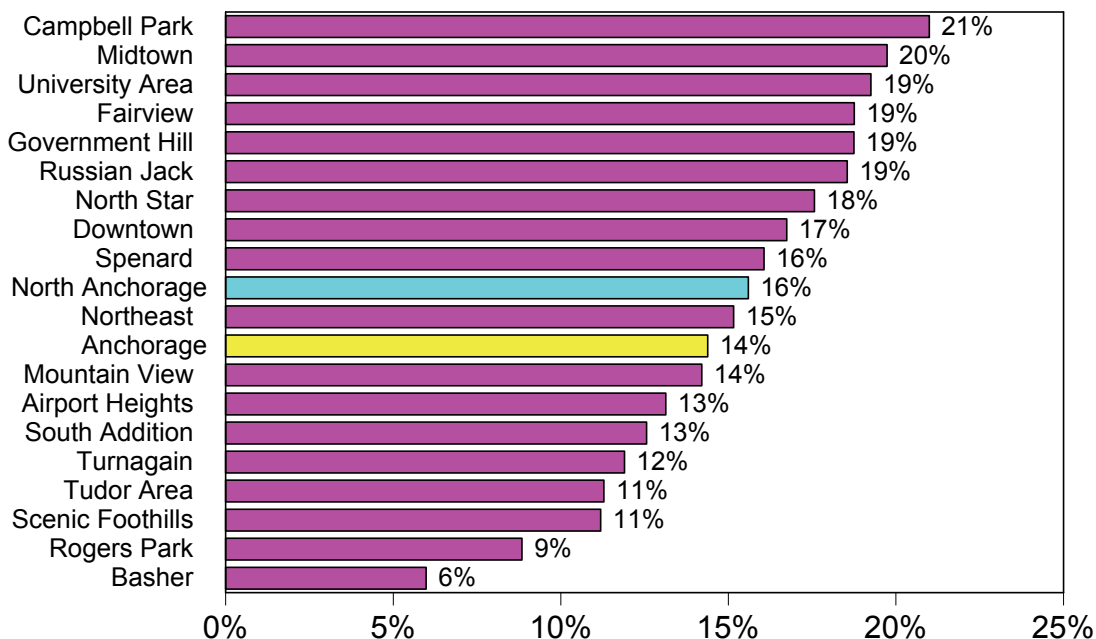

# % Young Adults (Age 20-29)

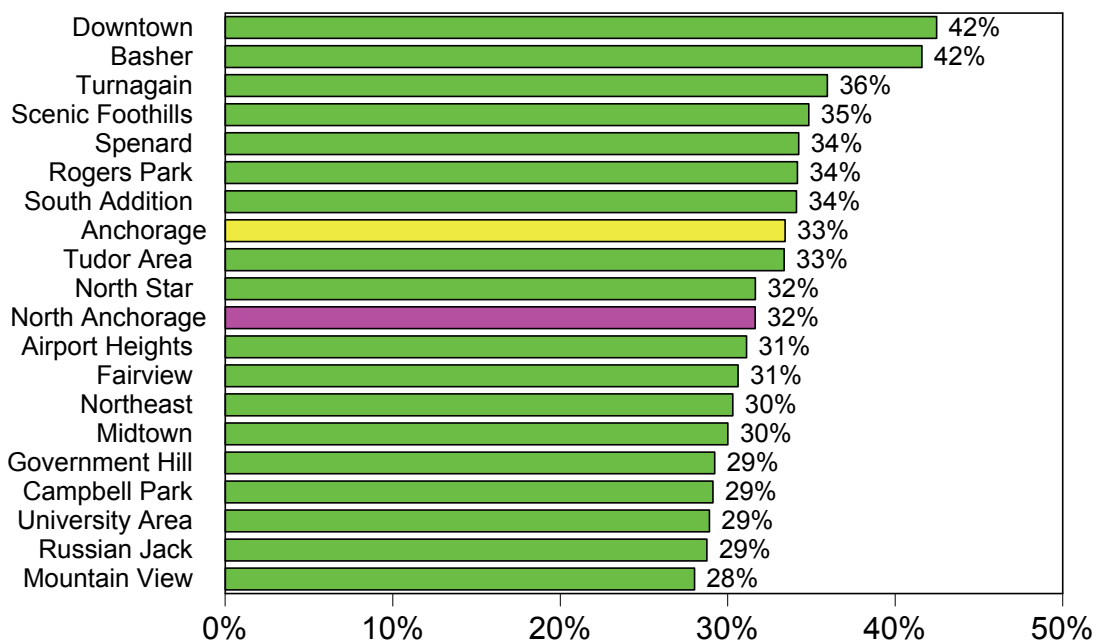

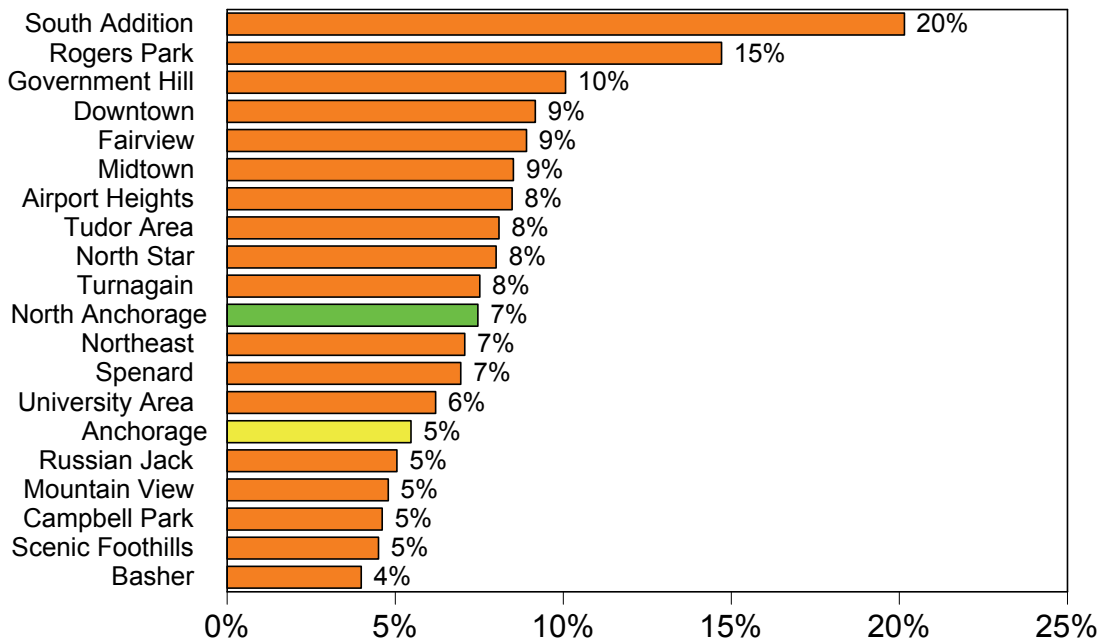

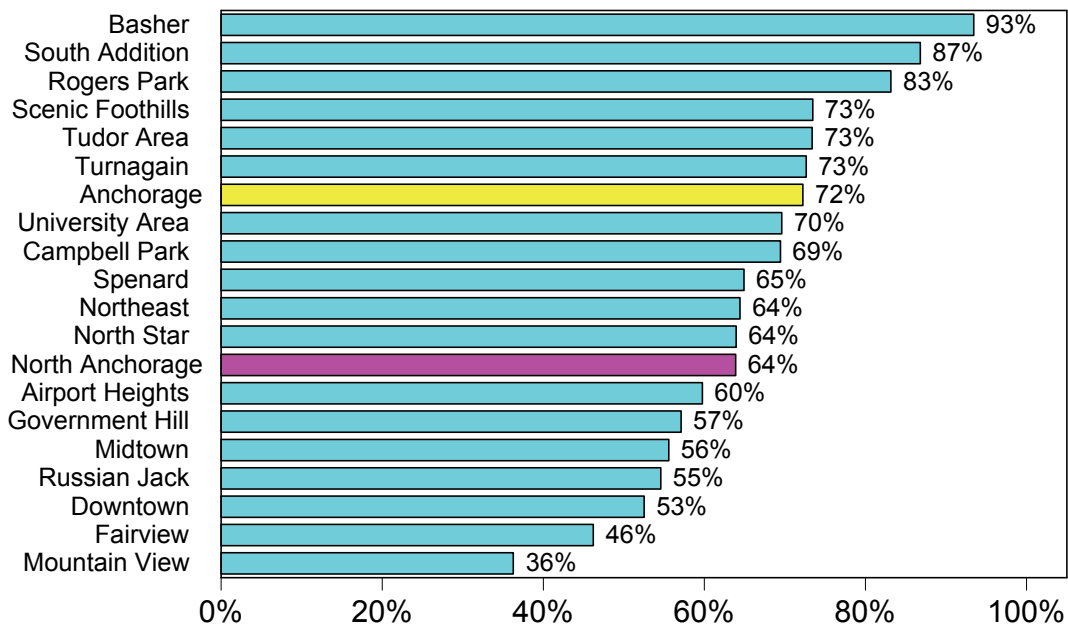

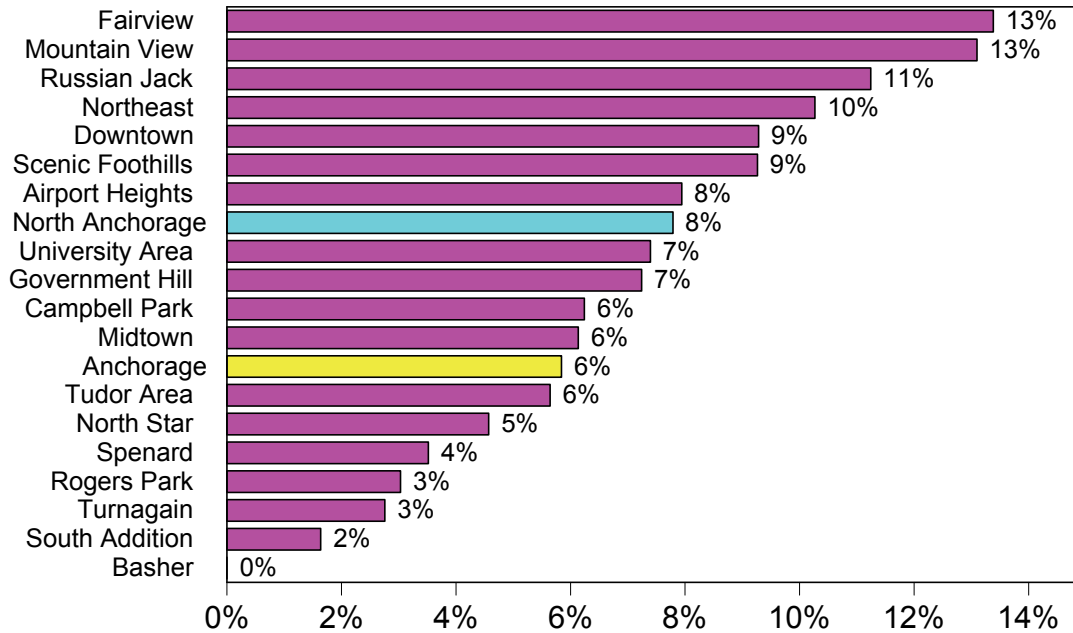

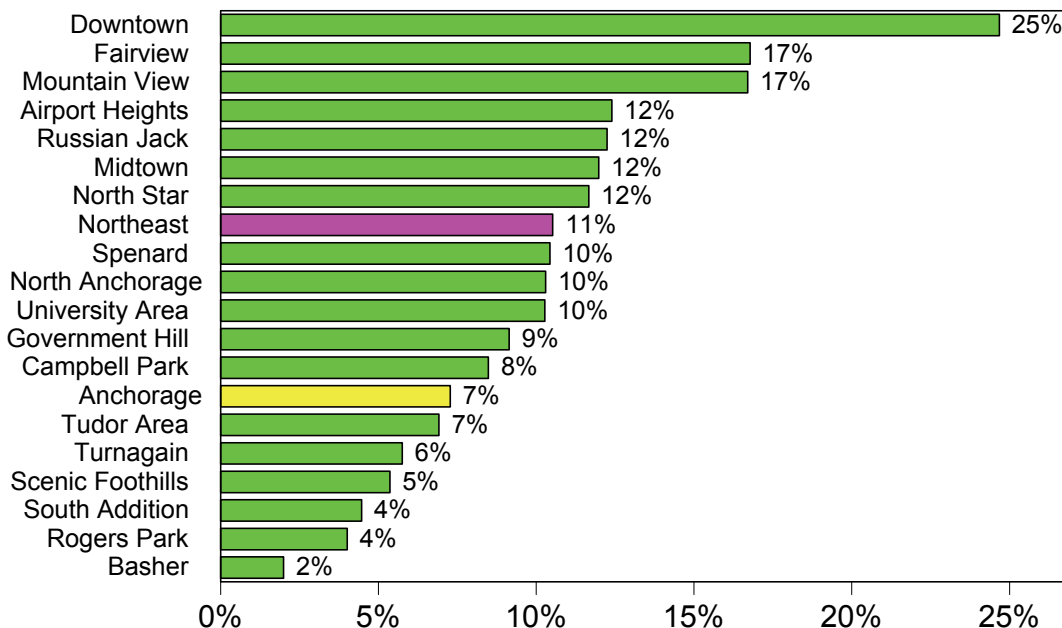

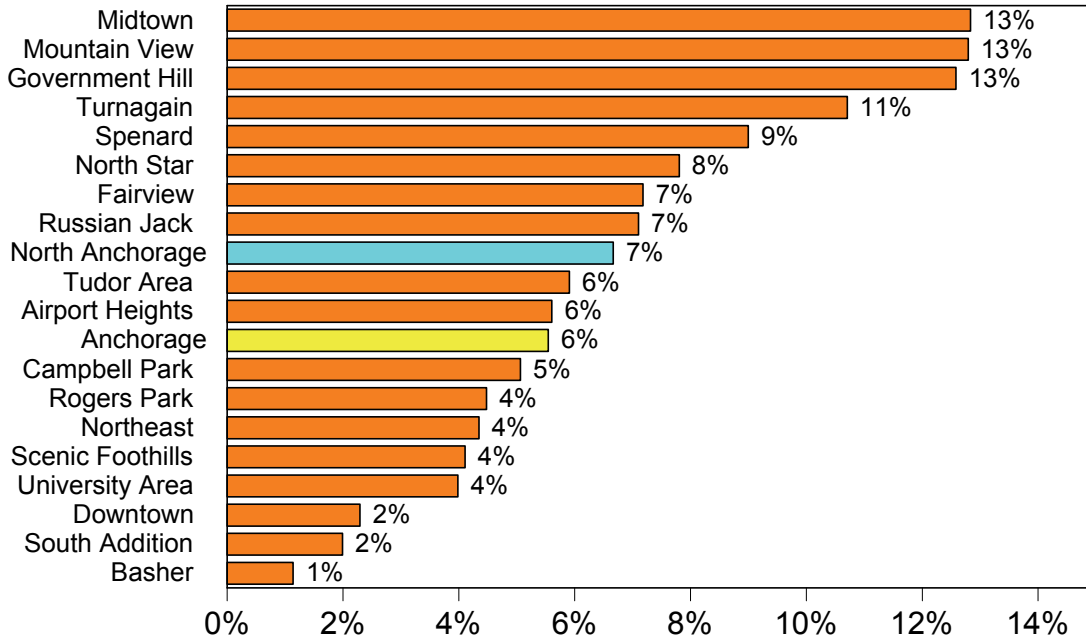

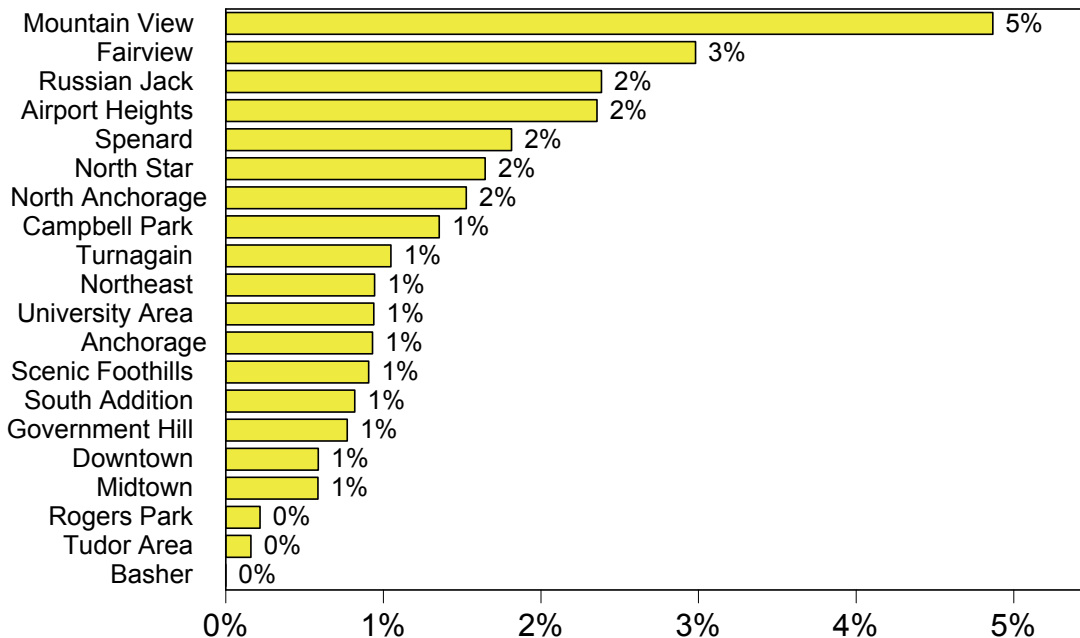

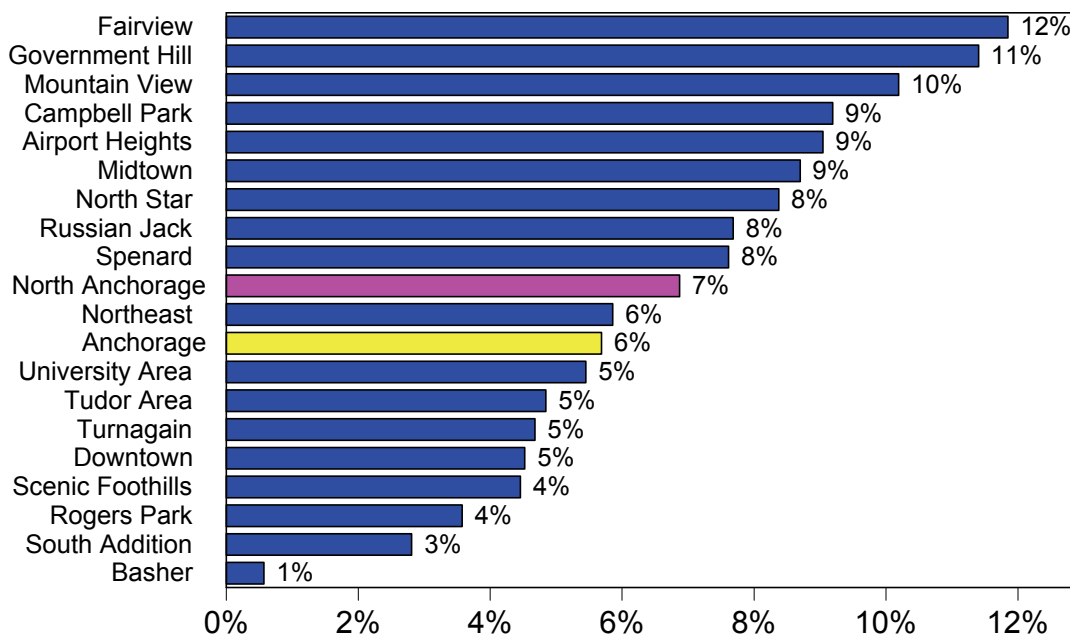

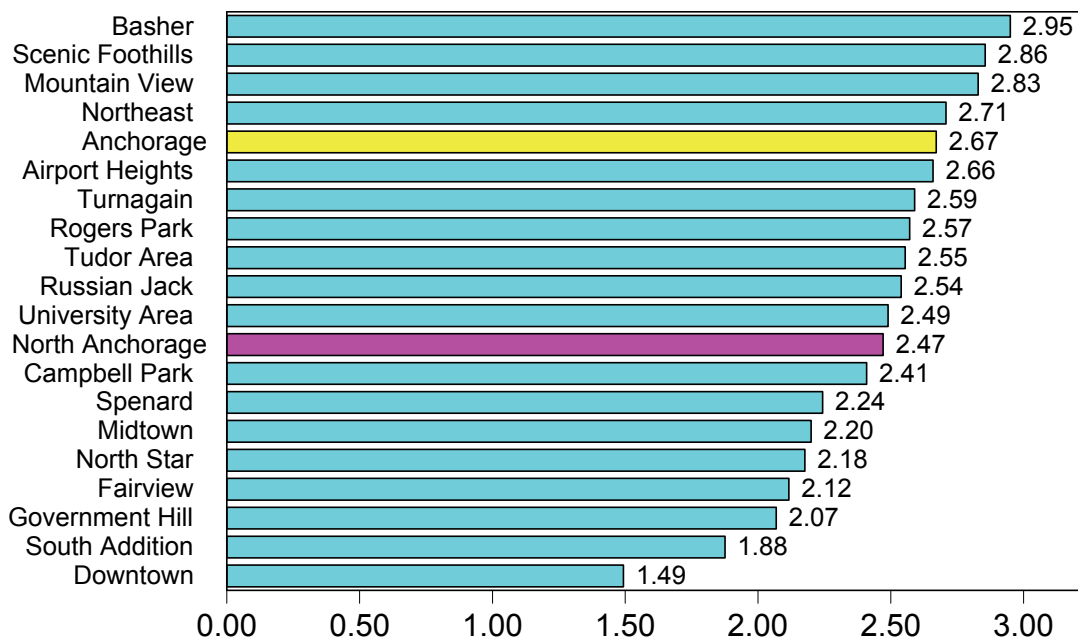

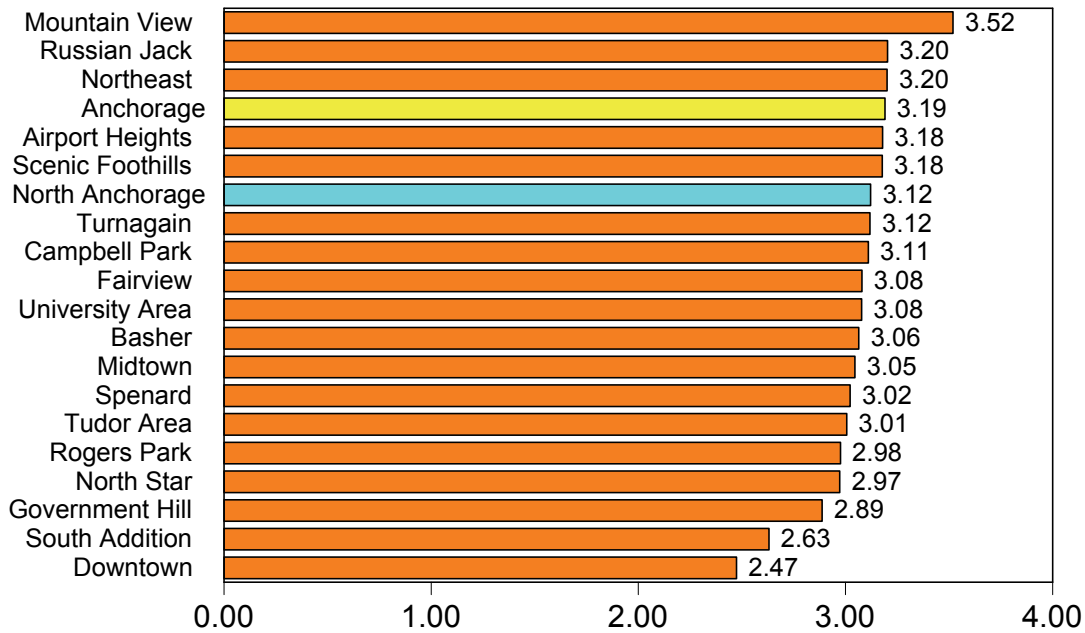

# Average Family Size

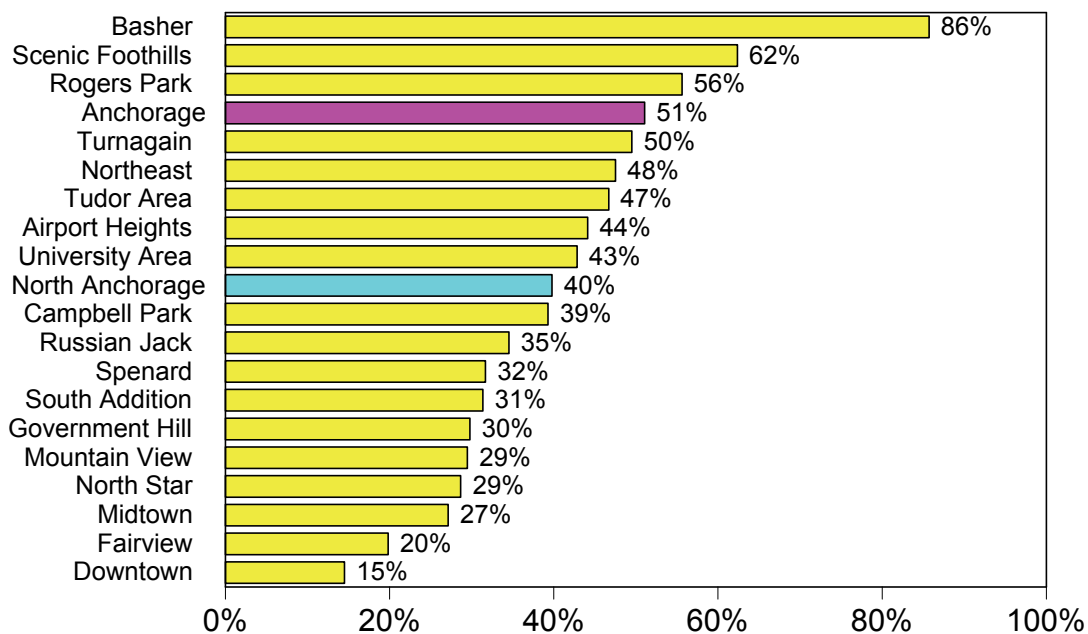

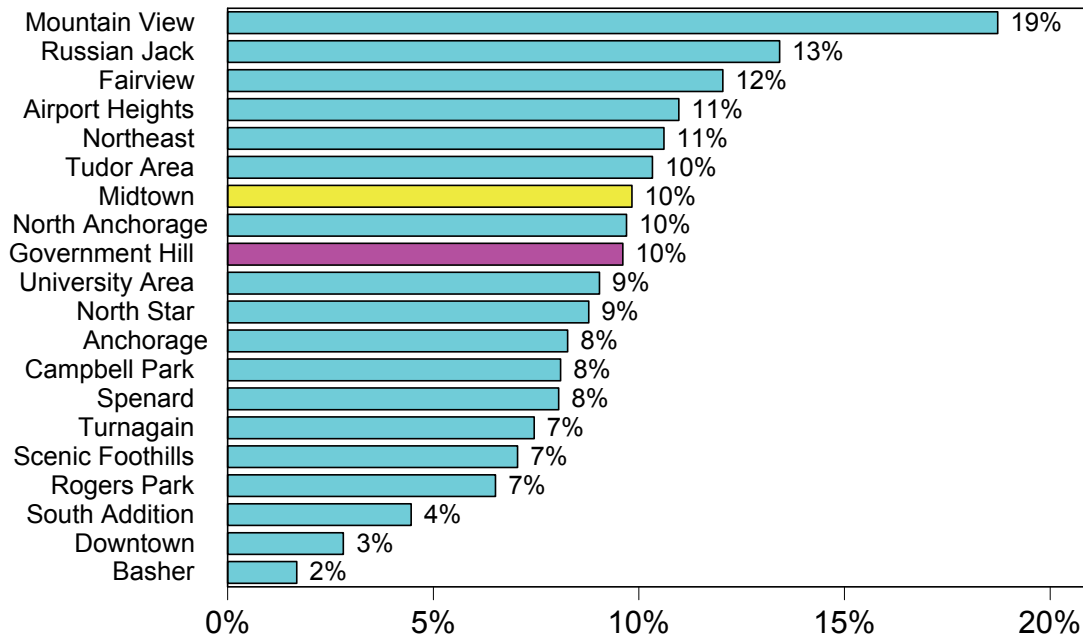

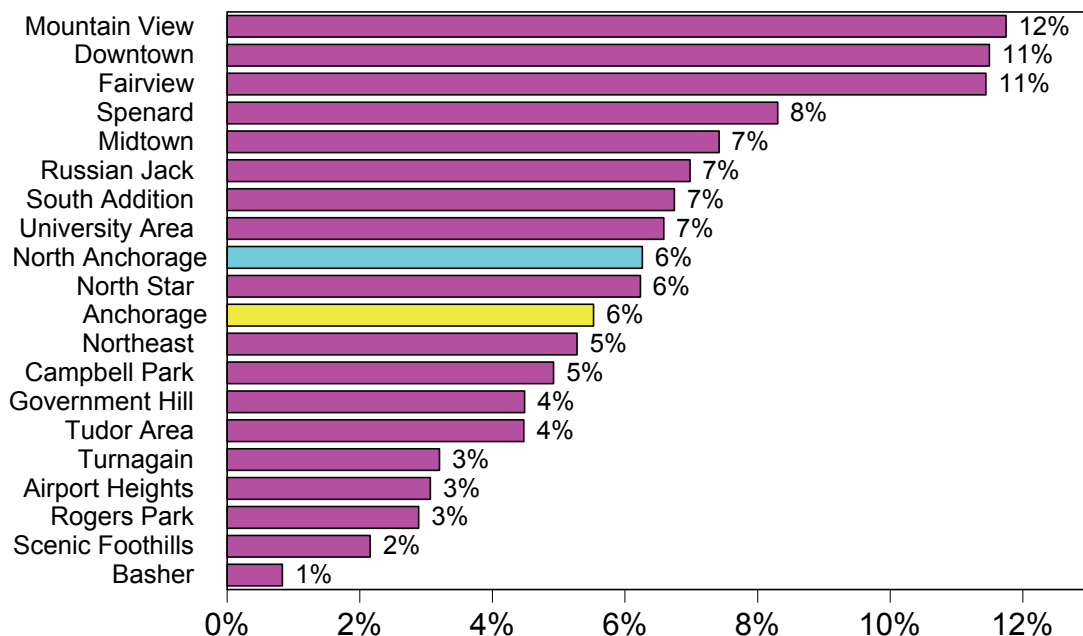

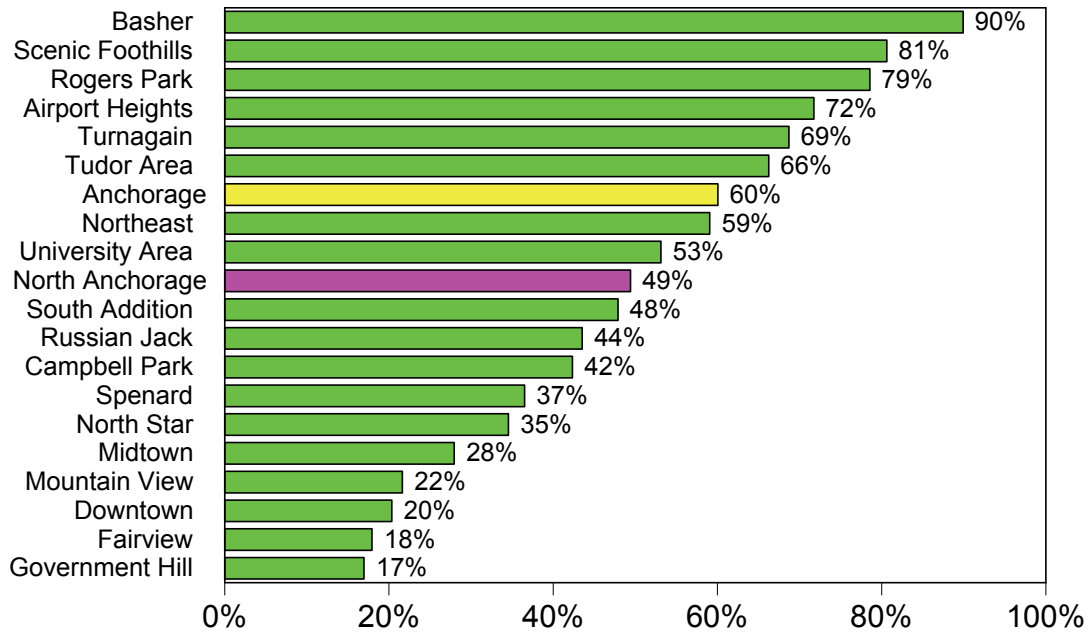

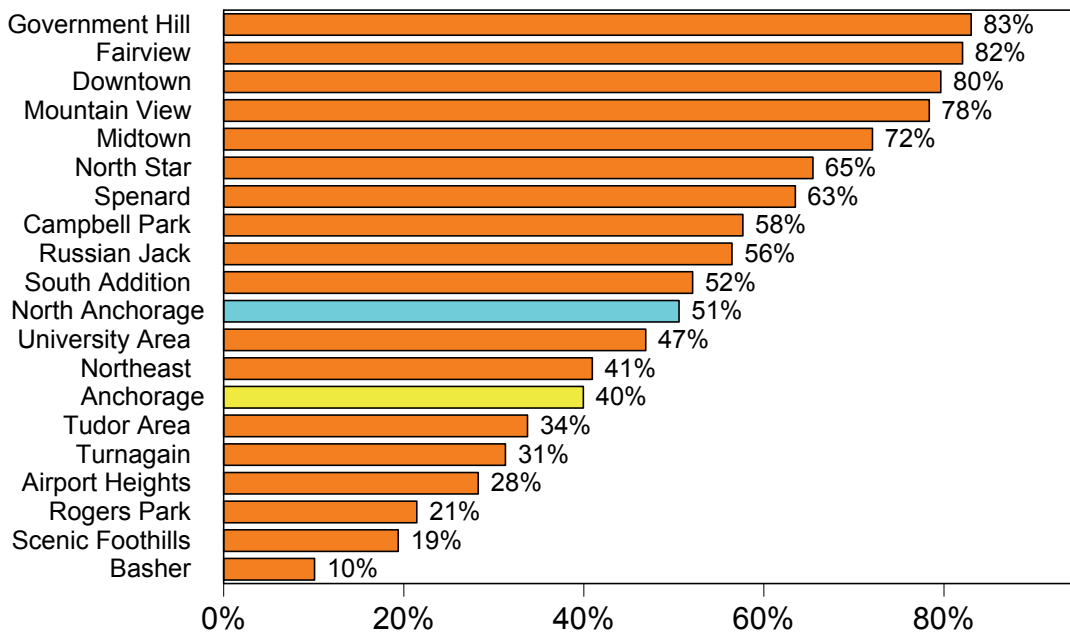

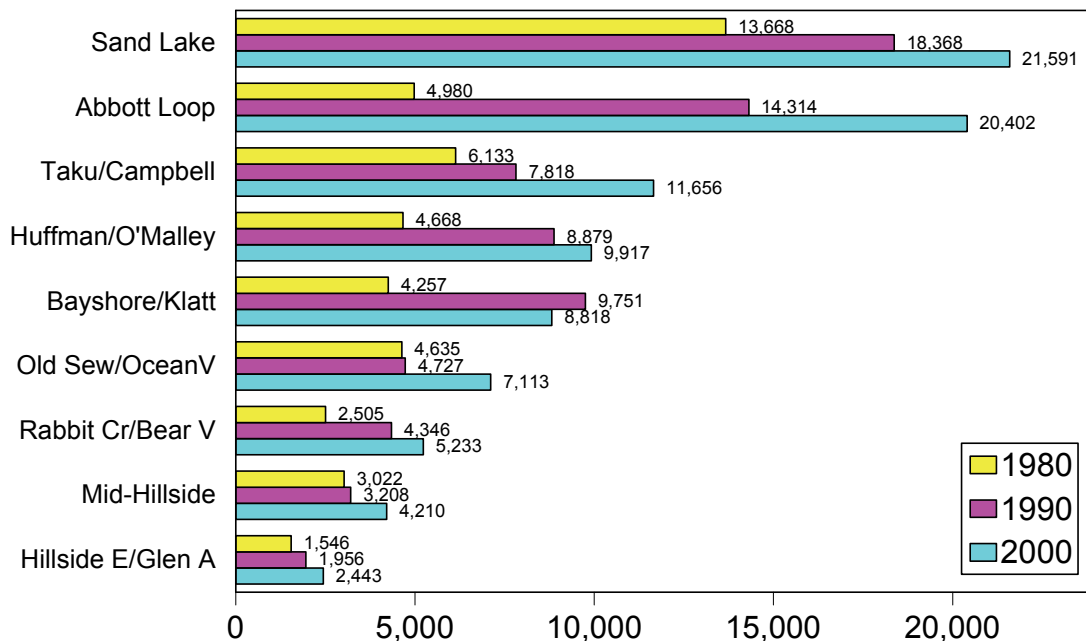

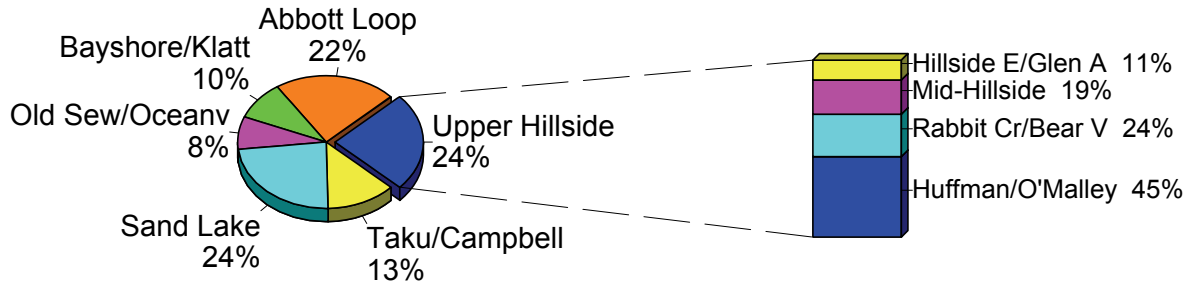
#### South Anchorage Community Councils - 1980-2000\*

## South Anchorage - 2000

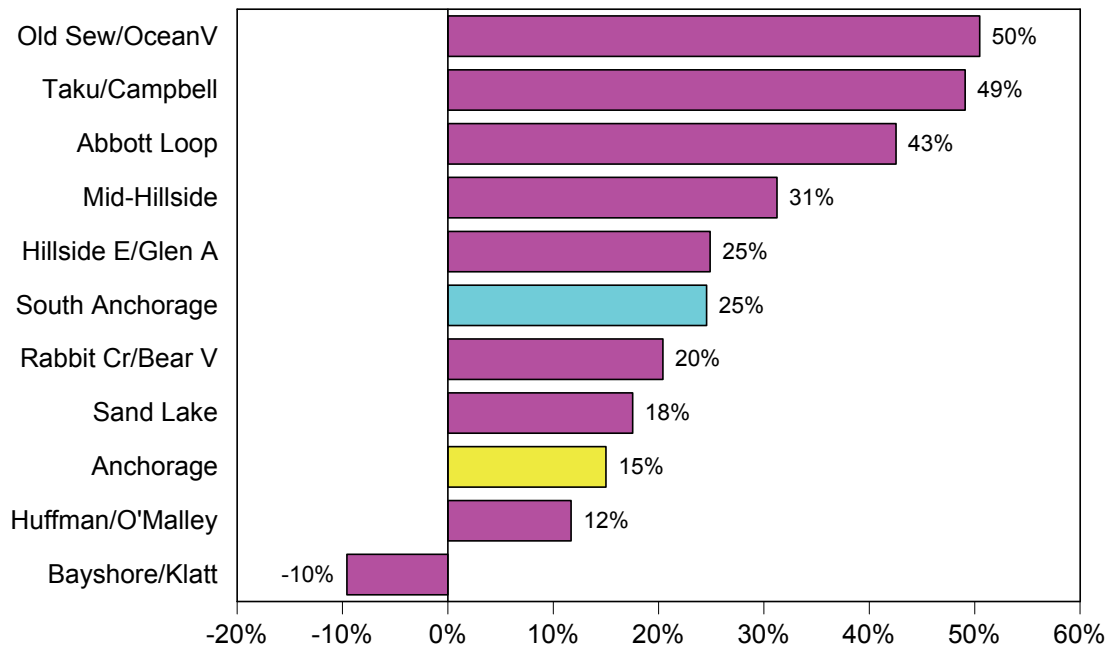

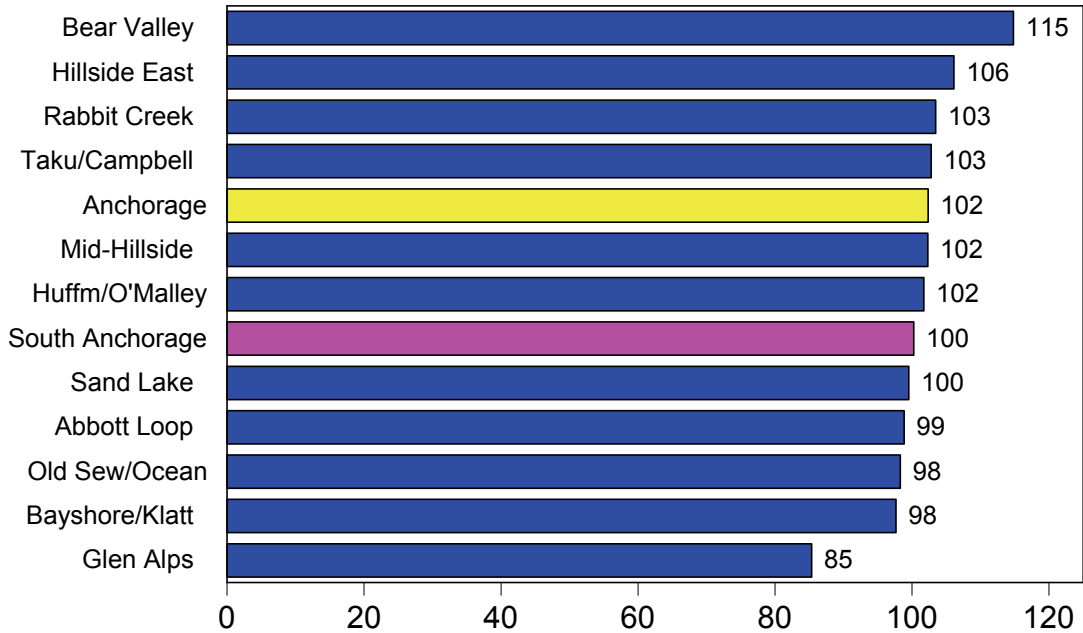
## South Anchorage - 1990-2000\*

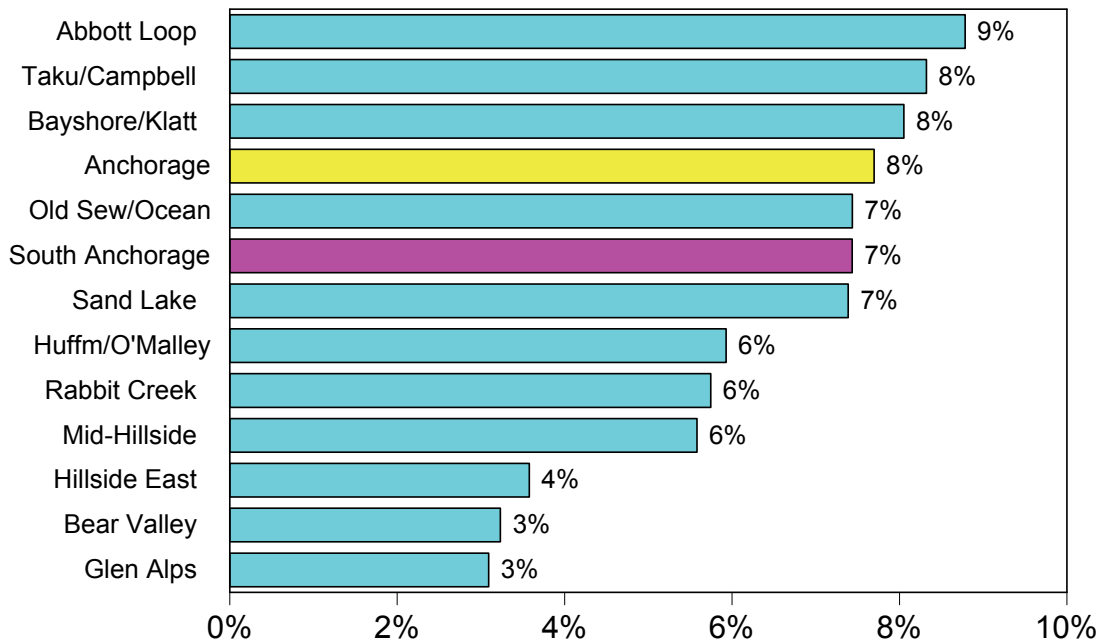

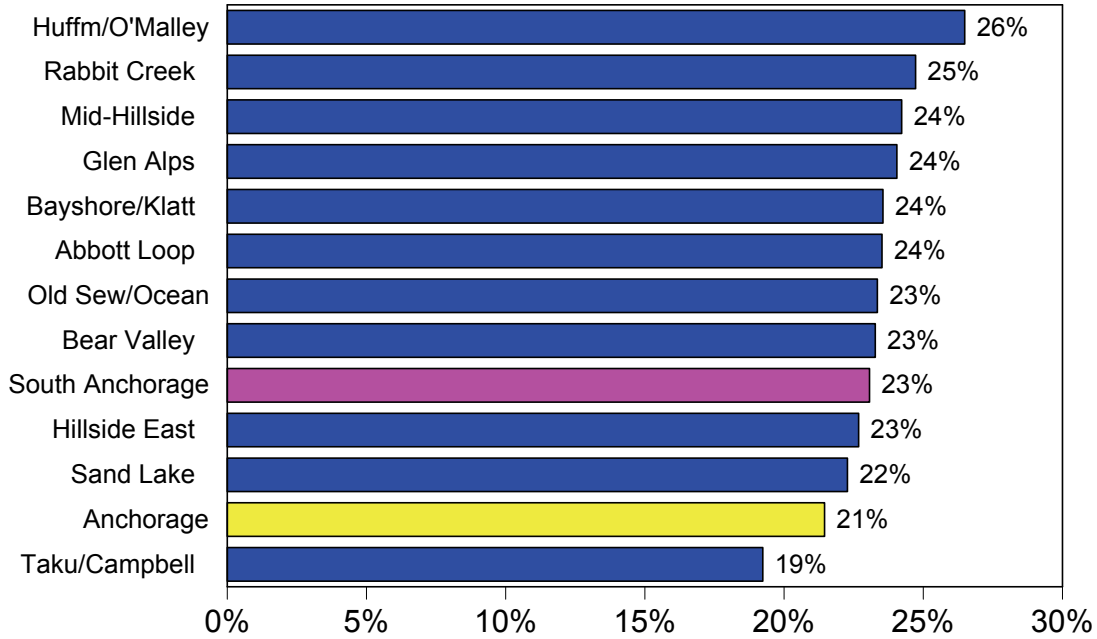

# % School Age (5-17 Years)

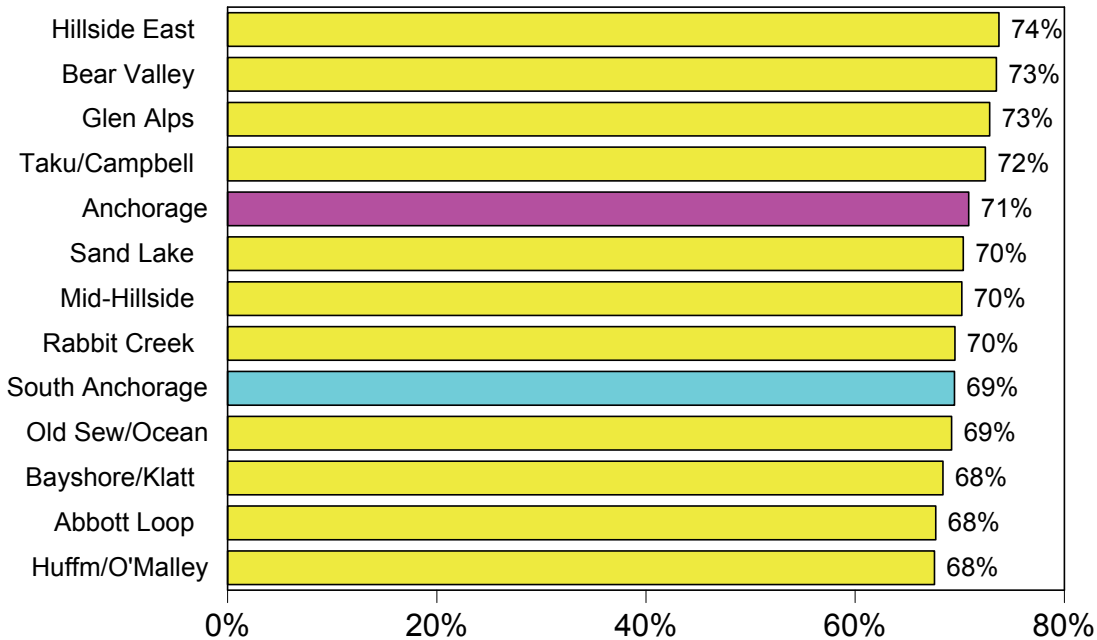

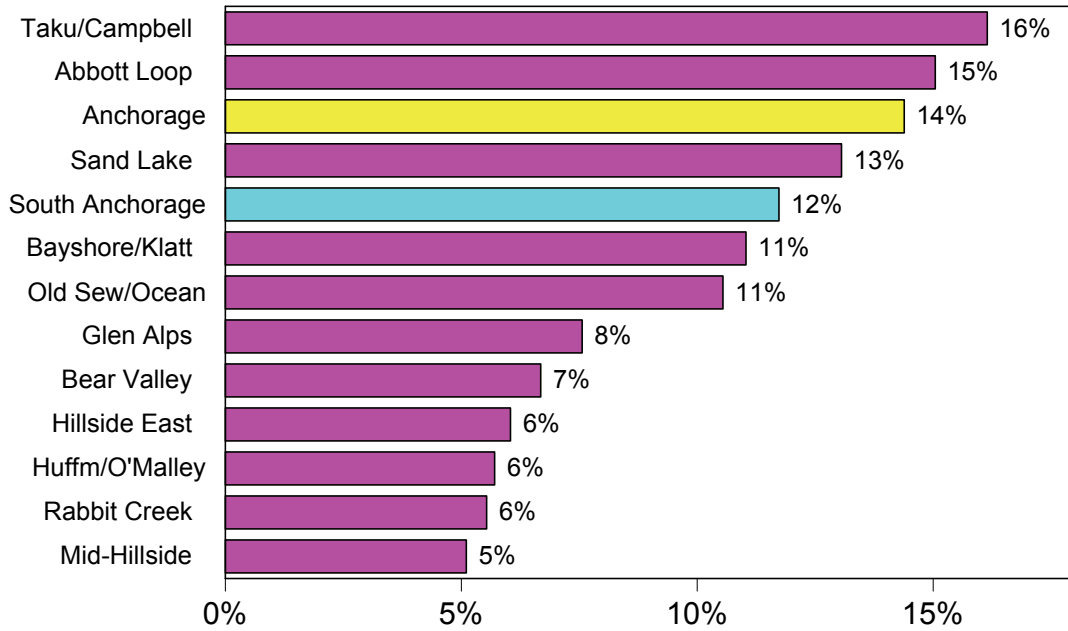

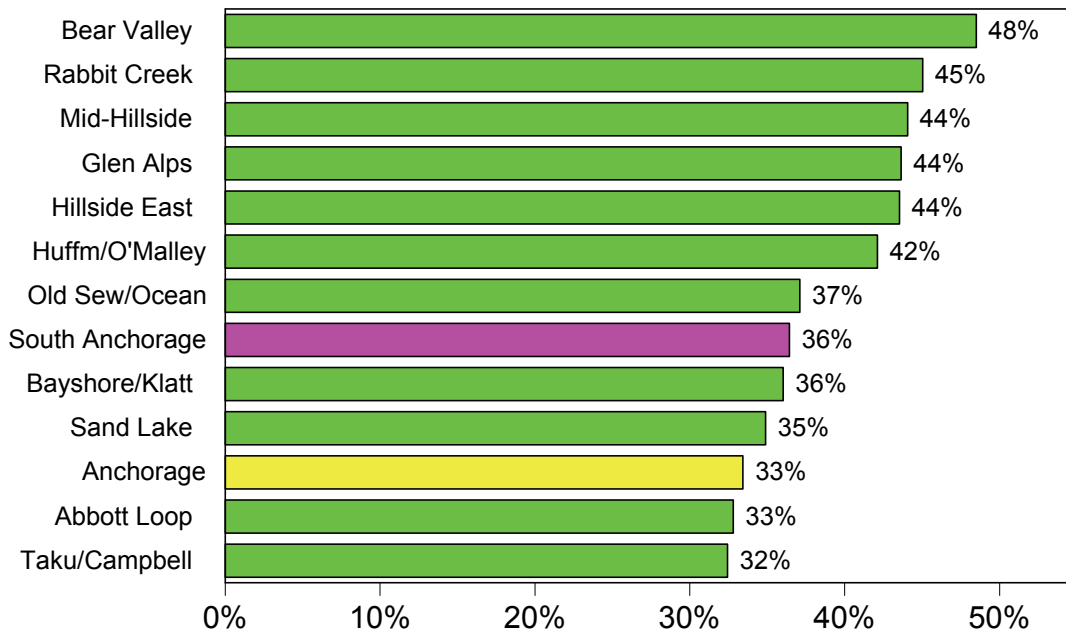

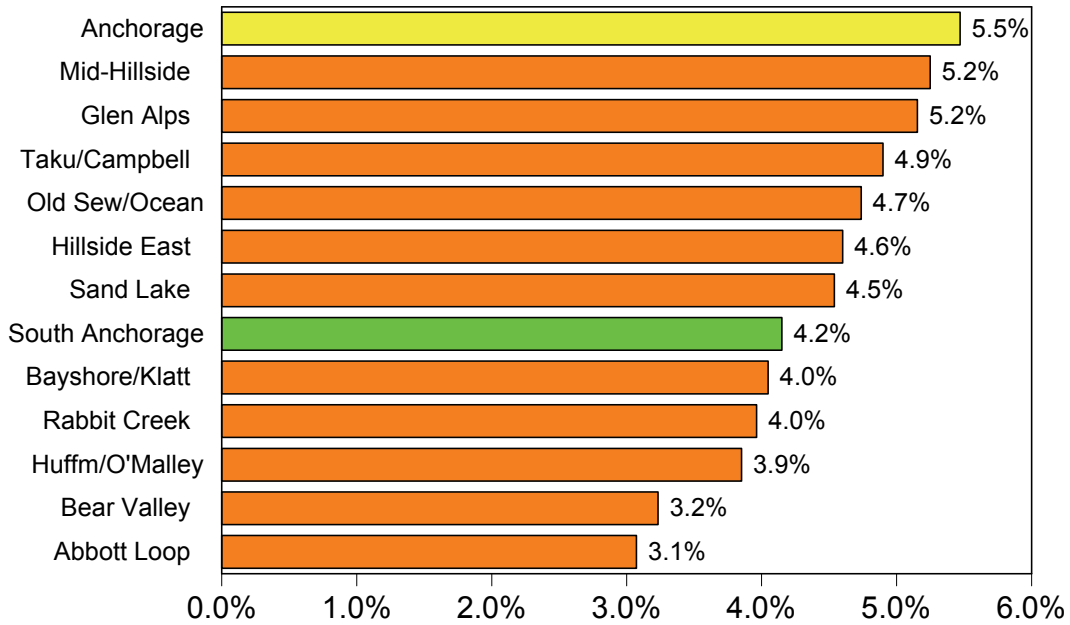

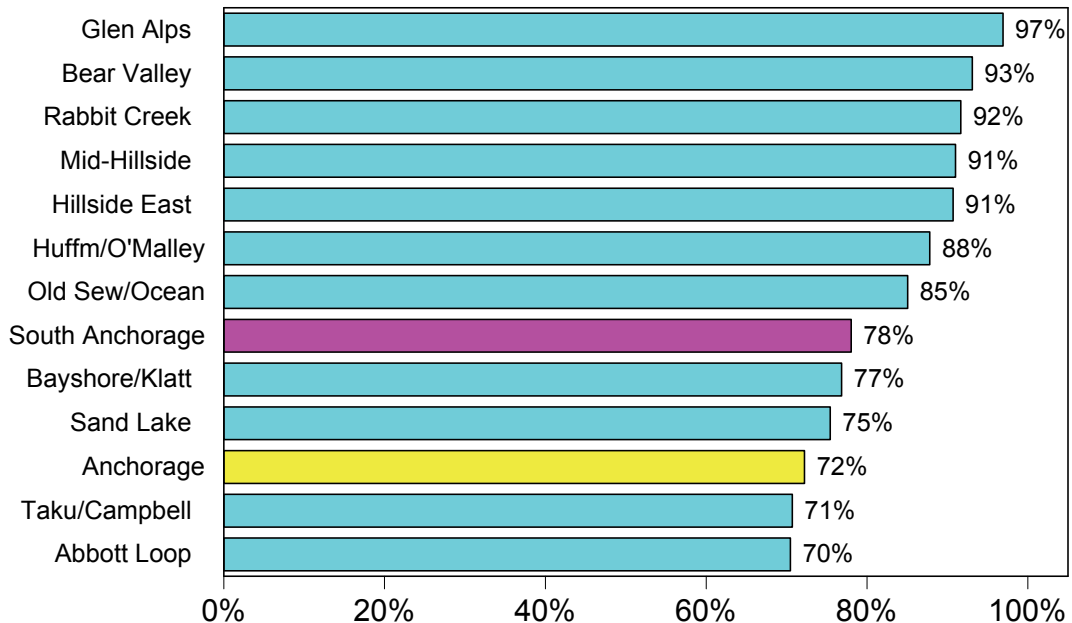

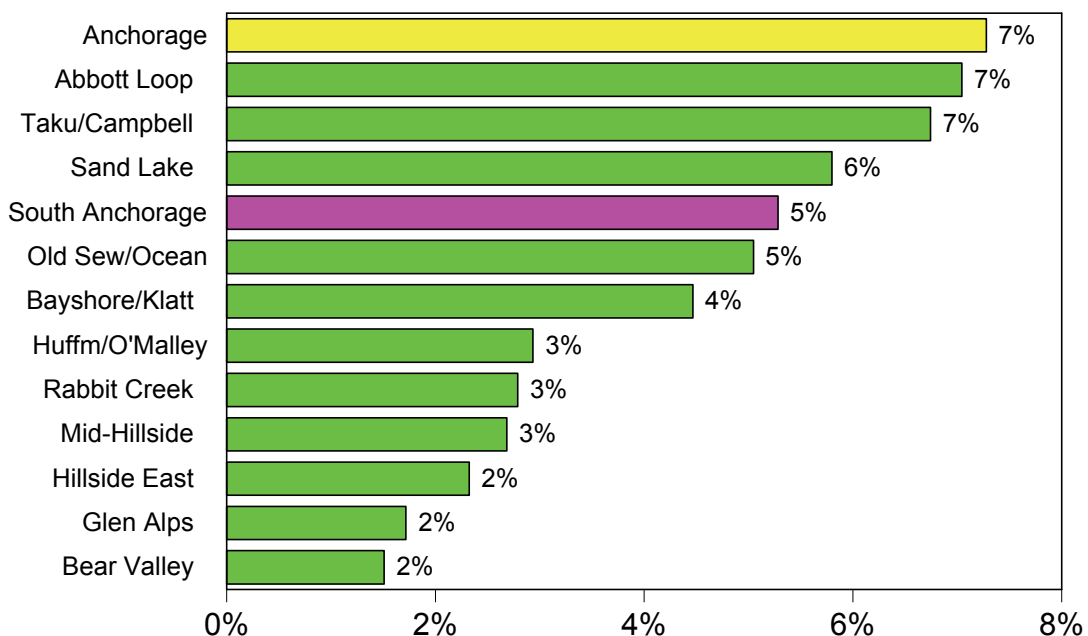

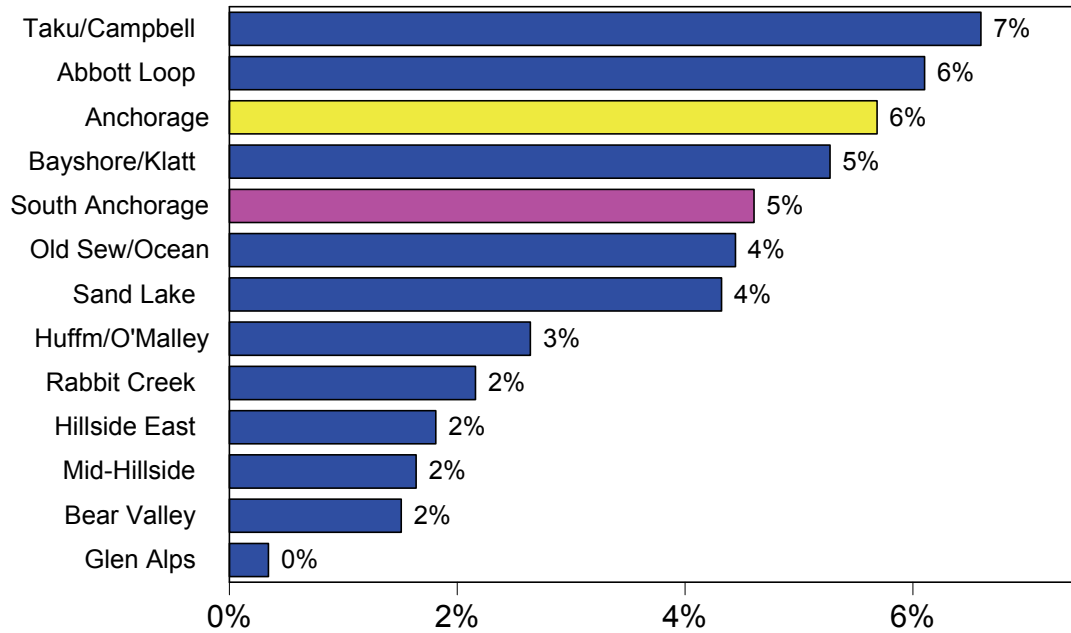

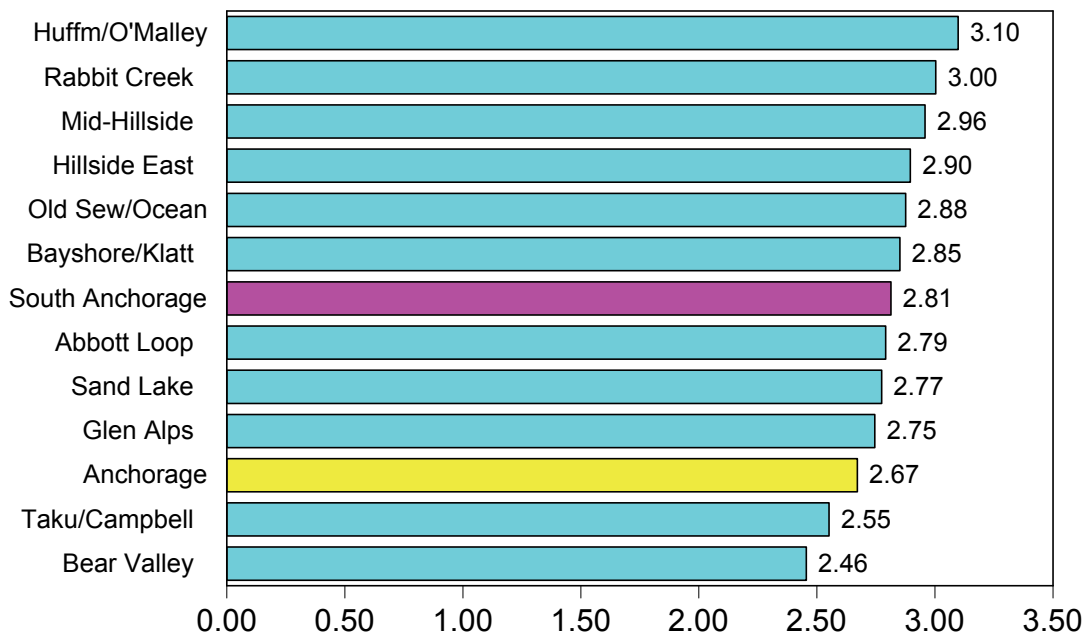

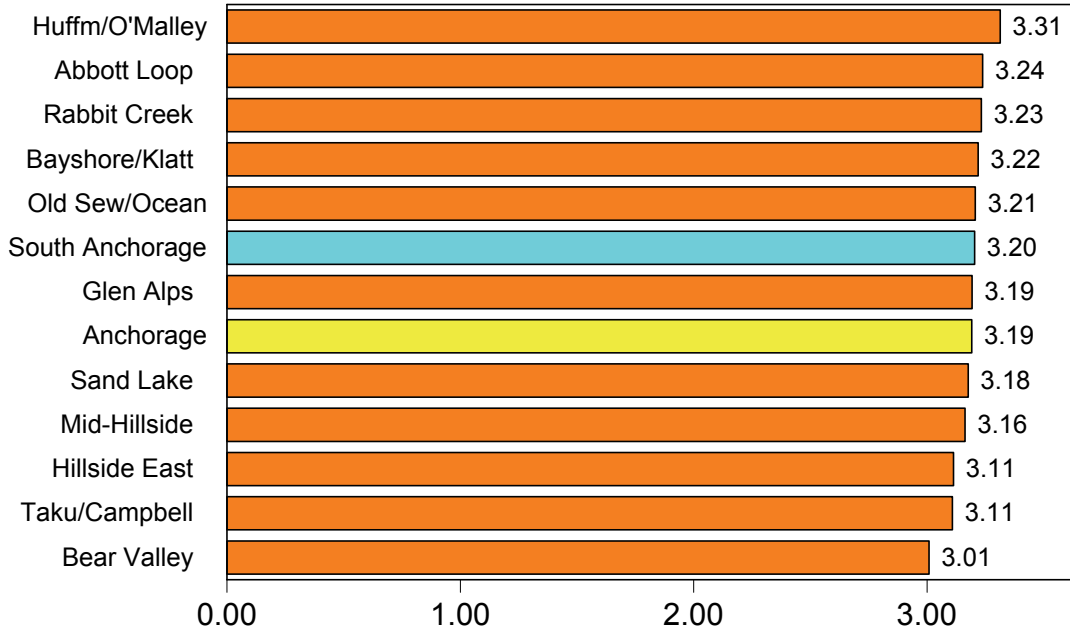

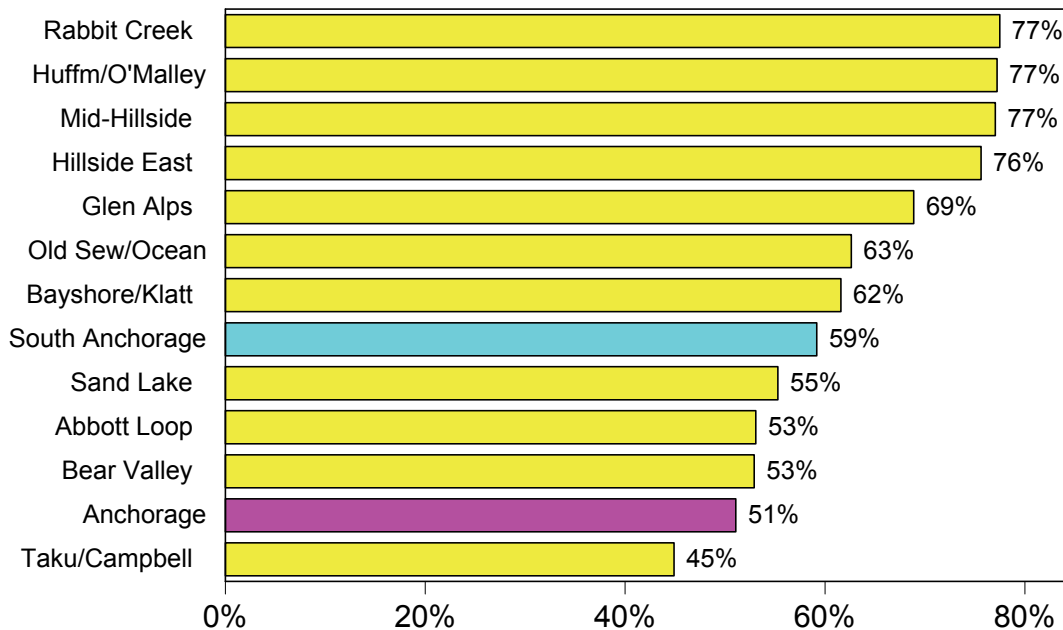

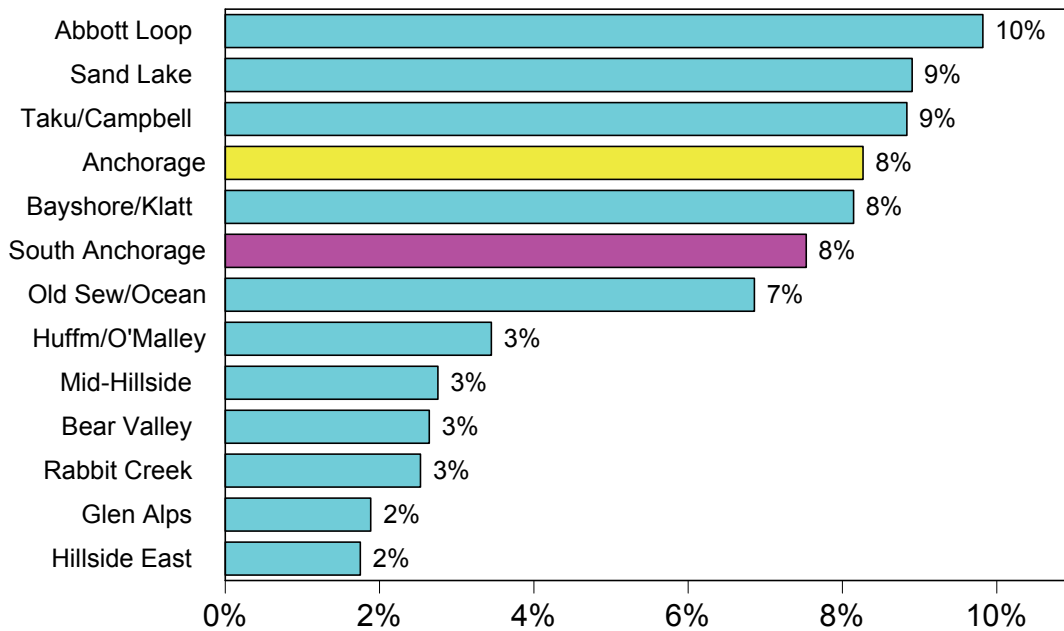

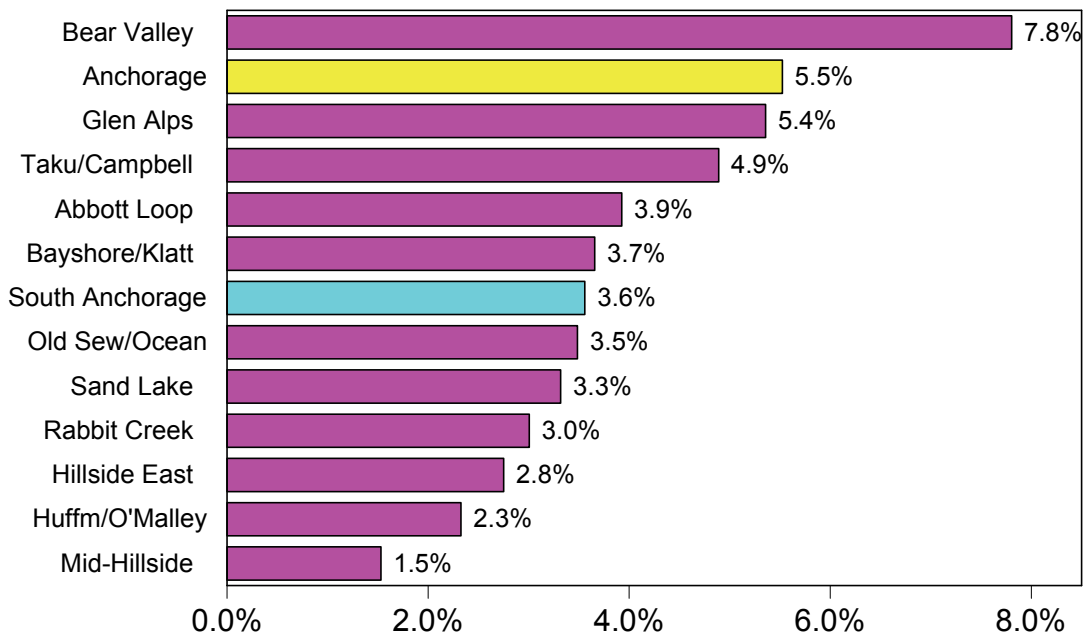

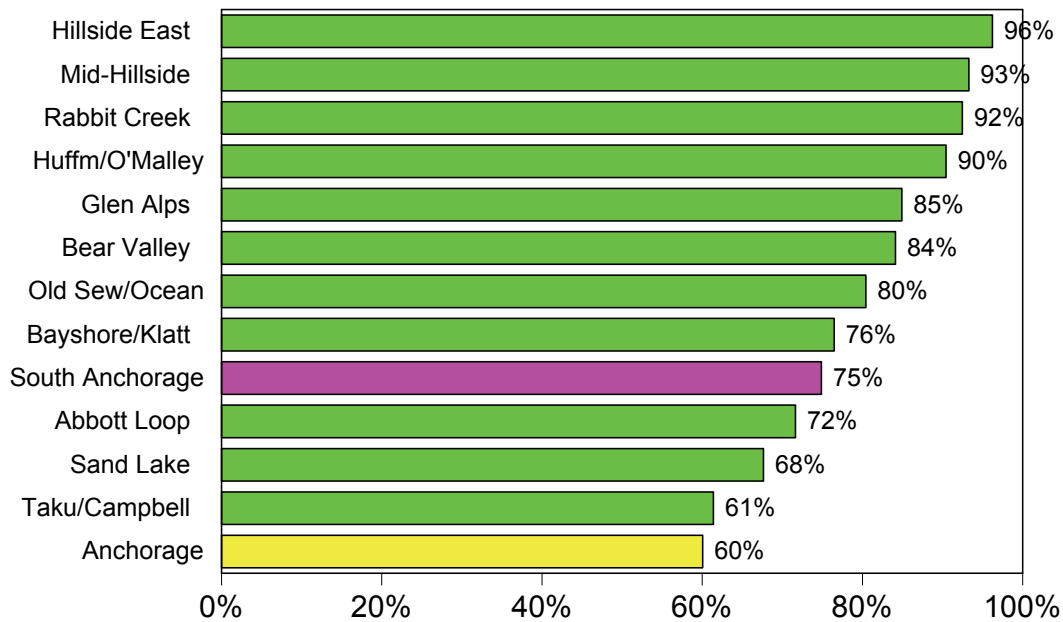

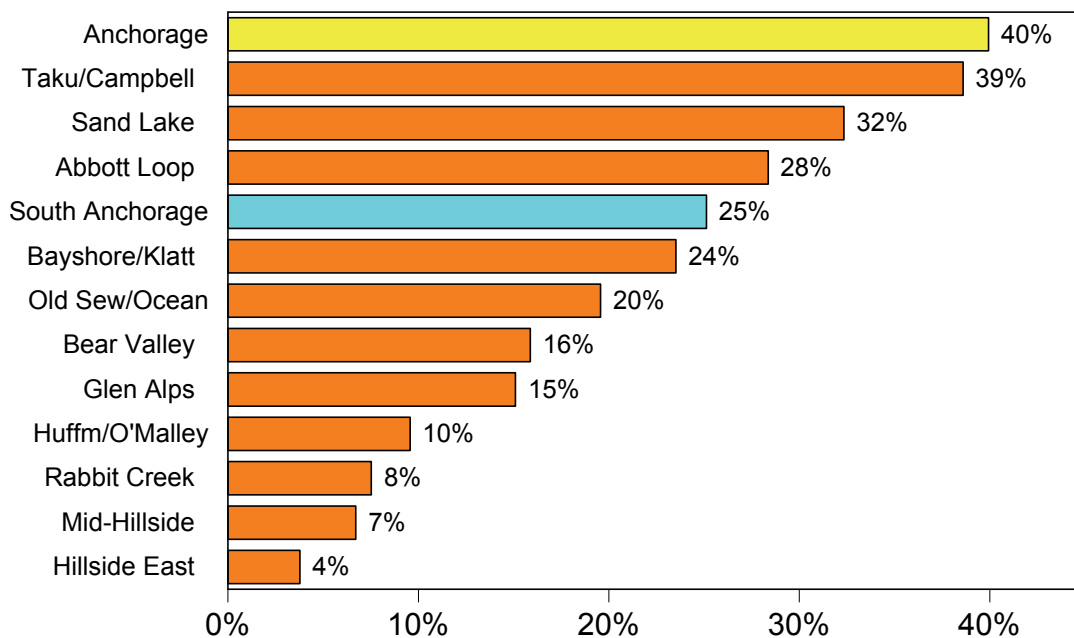
